The GIM Mission

To educate managers with the knowledge, skills, and creativity to manage our nation's enterprise competently and confidently, with personal integrity and social responsibility, and so to provide value to and for the organisations for which they work.

To discover, share, and apply management knowledge in every field of human endeavour, to enhance the learning of students, colleagues, and practicing managers, and to improve the effectiveness of organisations through research, teaching, and the practice of management.

Eligibility Criteria

- Minimum 50% marks in a three-year Bachelors degree or equivalent in any discipline, recognised by the UGC/AICTE/AIU as eligible for Post Graduate Studies in Management; and
- Full time work experience of at least three years in an executive/ supervisory position after graduation

Program Design

- For the first two years, classes are held on weekends
- All classes are held at the GIM Ribandar Campus
- Classes are normally scheduled on Saturdays between 2:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., and on Sundays between 8:30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.
- During the third year students work independently on project work and do not have to attend classes

Pedagogy

The pedagogy used is a healthy blend of theory and practice. Case studies, role plays, simulations and live projects ensure that skills and attitudes essential for effective managers are developed through the programme.

Extensive use of information technology and ready access to several academic and professional databases facilitates the learning process at GIM. A business simulation game 'Capstone' is run to develop the ability of students to take 'integrated' decisions affecting marketing, finance, operations, human resource, TQM and R&D and to evaluate their team performance on parameters like profit, return on equity, return on sales and asset turnover.

Curriculum

The curriculum is designed to develop both conceptual and skill based competencies. It broadly follows the pattern proposed by the AICTE. It consists of core courses offered in the first year, elective courses offered in the second year, and project work in the third year. In the first year, the core curriculum consists of courses that comprise the common body of knowledge of business management and are compulsory for all students.

In the second year, the core curriculum includes two courses - Strategic Management & Capstone. The elective curriculum allows students to select those courses that meet their professional needs. The students can select, in consultation with the faculty, specialization in any area or combination of area that will facilitate their career growth and development.

In the third year, students do not attend classes but work on workplace improvement projects, dissertations, and case studies under the guidance of the faculty. This component requires students to work extensively and develop expertise in their chosen areas of study.

Infrastructure

The library subscribes to over 10,000 online international journals.

The Institute subscribes to a variety of electronic databases including CMIE (which provides access to CMIE's research and compilations on Mergers and Acquisitions, Business Beacon, Industry Analysis Service, Economic Intelligence Service, Prowess, CapEx, India Trades, Indian Harvest, Alpha, International Economic Statistics) PROQUEST, EBSCO, India Business Insight Database (IBID), MICA, CAPITALINE PLUS- Corporate Database, CRIS INFAC Research Pro.

All GIM classrooms are provided with audio-visual equipment (LCD overhead projectors, OHP, and video sets) to enhance the presentation of classroom sessions and student project presentations. Equipment is also available for the video recording and playback of student classroom presentations to facilitate learning. GIM classrooms are air-conditioned and Wi-Fi (wireless internet) enabled.

Admission Process

Candidates seeking admission to the PGDM Part Time Programme are required to:

- Answer an entrance examination as mandated by the AICTE. Applicants can take either the XLRI Admissions Test- XAT 2013 or the AICTE admission test- CMAT 2013-14 (First or Second Test)
- 2. Submit the completed GIM application form along with their XAT or CMAT registration number/ID/Roll Number and application-processing fee.
- **3.** Shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview/group discussion at the institute. Applicants invited for interview shall carry with them the originals of academic and work experience certificates and other testimonials for verification

Selection Criteria

The intake capacity for PGDM Part time course is 60. Students are selected based on the nature of their work experience, performance in the interview/group discussion, academic achievements, and performance in the entrance test.

Notification of Selected Candidates

Candidates who are selected for admission will be informed by email.

Acceptance of Admission Offer

Selected candidates should indicate their acceptance of the admission offer by paying the first term fees on or before the stipulated date.





Fees

Rupees Two lakhs twenty five thousand and seven hundred only (Rs. 2, 25,700/-) for the whole course, payable over two years.
