Entry Requirements and Application

HOW TO APPLY: The application form can be downloaded from the Institute website and completed application be sent along with attachments and a DD of Rs. 1050.00 (Rs. 450.00 for SC/ST/PWD) drawn in favour of 'National Institute of Technology Durgapur' to be payable at State Bank of India (R. E. College Durgapur branch; code - 2108).

ELIGIBILITY: Graduates in any discipline with minimum 55% marks in Graduation (5% relaxation for SC & ST) & valid CAT score. Mere fulfilment of the eligibility criteria does not ensure call for GD & PI. Short-listing for GD-PI will be based on valid CAT score. Merit list for admission will be made based on valid CAT score (weightage- 75%), GD (weightage- 10%) and PI (weightage- 15%).

The students getting provisional admission to the MBA course 2014-2016 will have to submit the photocopy of final mark sheet and original migration certificate within one month from the commencement of classes. Failure of which will result in cancellation of the students' provisional admission. Prospective students from the waiting list will be called for admission.
