SCHEME: MHA CPMFS SCHOLARSHIP FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS OF GOVT. MEDICAL COLLEGES / INSTITUTIONS WILLING TO SERVE CENTRAL PARAMILITARY FORCES

GUIDELINES FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2010-11 AND ONWARDS

1. INTRODUCTION

Central Paramilitary Forces(CPMFs) offer an opportunity for talented and deserving medical students in India to earn their scholarship provided by the MHA to support, encourage and enabling them to achieve their professional ambitions by serving the nation in the organized and disciplined Medical Services of CPMFs. The new scholarship scheme will be applicable from the academic year 2010-11 onwards.

The sole purpose of this scheme is to get atleast 25 Medical Officers for CPMFs services on regular basis from fifth year onwards as there is acute shortage of MOs in CPMFs despite regular conduct of Medical Officers Selection Boards (MOSBs). The past experience with statistics of five years indicates that around 35 to 40 percent of vacancies of medical officers in CPMFs are continuing. And those who join the forces, around more than 10% resign during the initial years of service. Therefore, this scheme will provide CPMFs the continuous flow of medical officers for their future requirements.

2. NUMBER OF MEDICAL STUDENTS TO BE AWARDED SCHOLARSHIP

The number of scholarship will be variable according to the requirement of CPMFs Medical Services. However to begin with MHA has decided to award the scholarship to 25 Medical students for the academic year 2010-11. The scheme will be reviewed by MHA on year to year basis

3. RESERVATION

15% - SC, $7^{1}/_{2}$ %- ST, 27% -OBC & remaining for General Candidates as per GOI provision.

4. **ELIGIBILITY**

PERSONS ELIGIBLE FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- a) Students must be a bonafide domicile of India.
- b) Students pursuing full time MBBS course in Govt. Medical College in India. College as well as course should be duly recognized by Medical Council of India (MCI).
- c) The physical and medical standard should conform to required standards prescribed for CPMFs Medical Services(as per **Appendix** -'A'). Medical interrogation form for applicants(as per **Appendix** "B"), Medical examination report (as per **Appendix** 'C") & Prescribed standard for

average body weight in different age groups and heights - Male/ Female (as per Appendices 'D' & 'E').

- d) The applicant should be free from any disease or infirmity.
- e) The medical examination will be conducted by the medical board constituted at the respective Medical College Hospital/Institute.
- f) Selection will be based on percentage of marks obtained in All India Pre Medical Test (AIPMT) conducted by CBSE.
- g) Student should have confirmed admission in the first year MBBS Course.
- h) The application is to be forwarded through Principal/Dean of the respective Medical College by registered post and through website (on-line) for consideration of ADG(Medical) CPMFs MHA within three month of his/her admission.

For selection of candidates, a committee of the following will be constituted to recommend the successful candidates for scholarship for the approval of Home Secretary:-

Individual will also be responsible to provide his/her completion date of internship well in advance i.e. before two months of completion of internship period to ADG (Med), CPMFs, MHA as well as to provide authentic certificate of internship completion immediately after completion of internship to the same office of ADG (Med).

5. REQUIREMENT AT THE TIME OF ANNUAL RENEWAL

- (a) His/Her continuation in the course/training is necessary.
- (b) He/She will produce certificate of Medical fitness examination annually duly conducted by the medical board constituted at the respective Medical College Hospital/Institute, as per CPMFs criteria every year for the renewal of scholarship in the prescribed proforma for medical examination (**Appendix** 'C').

6. DURATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

j)

Scholarship will only be paid for the actual duration of MBBS Course i.e. 4¹/₂ years.

7. List of Medical colleges selected for scholarship is attached as per Appendix - 'F'.

8. AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Rs.10,000/- per month for the total duration of $4^{1}/_{2}$ years of MBBS Course only.

9. <u>FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS.</u> For <u>25</u> students for 4 ½ years @ <u>Rs.10.000/-</u> per month per student comes to **Rs. 1.35 Crores.**

10. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP

- a) Students having confirmed admission in the first year of full time MBBS course must submit application(Application Performa as per **Appendix 'G'**) within three months of his/her admission through Dean/Principal of Medical College for consideration by ADG(Medical), MHA by registered post and through website(online) alongwith proper agreement of Rs.50/-(as per Appendix 'H') on judicial paper stating that he/she is willing to serve the Paramilitary Forces in any part of the country /anywhere out side India for 10 years after completing his/her MBBS course as well as after completion of internship. If he/she fails to comply with the instructions/undertaking as specified in the agreement certificate (as per **Appendix** 'H') he/she will have to deposit the entire amount of scholarship paid to him/her together with normal interest and penal interest above the prevailing medium or long term bank rate of interest as specified in the relevant paras of the agreement.
- b) The scholarship will be provided through respective Medical College/Institute.
- c) Students taking benefit of reservation of any category will submit the authentic copy of the caste certificate as per prescribed Performa of Central Government / State Government.
- (d) Refund. Details of conditions to refund scholarship amount are as under :-
 - (i) Refund of scholarship amount with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest on following conditions:-
 - (aa) due to disease / circumstances beyond his / her control and who do not refuse treatment.
 - (ab) due to disease / circumstances which are attributable to the training curriculum of MBBS.
 - (ac) due to disease / circumstances necessitating withdrawal from college.
 - (ad) If a medical student after being appointed in CPMFs, applies for release from service within 10 years but after completion of five years of service, the government may permit his / her release as per the Rules, provided that he/she refunds the amount of scholarship money alongwith prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus the training charges or three months salary whichever is more.
 - (ii) Refund of scholarship amount with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest @ 2% on following conditions:-
 - (aa) declared medically unfit due to diseases / circumstances within their control like drug abuse, accidents and injury in brawls / fights.

- (ab) declared medically unfit due to diseases / circumstances beyond their control, but who refused to undergo treatment.
- (ac) Medical Students after being appointed in CPMFs applies for release from service before expiry of five years from the date of such appointment, his / her release may be permitted by the government as per the Rules provided that he/she refunds the scholarship money with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest of 2% plus the training charges or three months salary whichever is more.

(iii) Refund of scholarship amount with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest @ 4% on following conditions:-

- (aa) Medical Student once having joined the college, selected for the scholarship, signed this agreement and will not be permitted to withdraw from the college without paying scholarship amount received by him / her with penal interest.
- (ab) Medical Student decides not to continue his/her service liability or withdraws from the college at his / her own volition, he / she shall be liable to repay the scholarship money received with penal interest.
- (ac) Failing in attendance below 50% in any two consecutive terms for reasons other than medical, or
- (ad) Failing to qualify MBBS course within a total period of five years from the date of entry into college. In case a Medical Student has appeared for the final MBBS examination prior to completion of five years but the result thereof is declared subsequently, in which he / she has passed the final MBBS examination, the Medical student will not be declared unfit for appointment / Non-Service Liability (NSL) and will be eligible for appointment in CPMFs subject to meeting all other eligibility criteria.
- (ae) In case the Medical Student is withdrawn / removed from the roll of the medical college by the appropriate authority on the following conditions:-
 - (i) Unsatisfactory conduct(indiscipline) as determined by the college authorities and approved by the Principal of Medical college, whose decision will be binding, during the course of training at the College and till the date of appointment, or
 - (ii) Unsatisfactory academic progress as reported by the college authorities and approved by the Principal of Medical college whose decision will be binding during course / training, or

- (iii) Knowingly makes false declarations or furnishes false particulars for admission to the said college, or
- (iv) Failing to give correct medical history as required at the time of initial Medical Board at respective medical college.
- (af) Medical students immediately after graduation and completion of internship refusing to accept the offer of appointment may be released from Service Liability by the Government on full payment of total scholarship amount received by him/her with penal interest as stated at para 10 (d) (iii).
- (ag) Such medical students after having appointed in CPMFs discharged/removed from the service on administrative/disciplinary grounds before completing 10 years of service from the date of such appointment, his/her removal/discharge from service will be as per prevailing Govt. rules and payment of full scholarship received by him / her with penal interest.
- 11. <u>Placement</u>:- Beneficiaries of this scheme will be allotted any force as per requirement of CPMFs by ADG (Med), CPMFs, MHA

Now this deed witnesses and the Parties hereby agree as follows:-

1. That in consideration of the Medical Student having been selected by the Government for the aforesaid scholarship, the Medical student or his / her father/ guardian and the surety covenant with the Government.

(a) That the said Medical Student shall undergo all such courses and training as the respective Medical College may prescribe from time to time.

Attendance at all prescribed courses and training courses shall be compulsory and absence from which without prior permission from appropriate authority of Medical College will attract disciplinary action.

- (b) That the Medical Student after successful completion of MBBS Degree Course and internship Training on being found suitable in all respects, unless he / she is prevented from doing so by death or on account of ill health or by being removed from the college Roll on the grounds that he / she is considered by the appropriate authority to be unfit to continue as a Medical Student (of which the decision of Principal / Head of respective Medical College shall be final), once offered appointment as a Medical Officer(Assistant Commandant) in the CPMFs, he/she shall accept such appointment within one month.
- (d) That the Medical student will undergo a medical examination on entry and his selection for scholarship will also depend on his/her medical fitness as per CPMFs 'SHAPE 'System(Appendices 'A', 'B', 'C', 'D' & 'E'). Medical Student will also undergo annual (periodic) medical examination as well as at the time of appointment and entry into service, if found unfit, then scholarship will be discontinued and shall be recovered as per details mentioned in Para 3 and 4 of this Agreement.
- (e) That the Medical Student once having joined the college, selected for the scholarship, signed this Agreement and shall not be permitted to withdraw from the college without paying scholarship amount received by him / her with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest of 4%.

- (b) Unsatisfactory academic progress as reported by the college authorities and approved by the Principal of Medical college whose decision will be binding during course / training, or
- (c) Knowingly makes false declarations or furnishes false particulars for admission to the said college, or
- (d) Fails to give correct medical history as required at the time of initial Medical Board at respective medical college.
- 3. It is further agreed that grant of scholarship to the Medical Student implies service liability as a Medical Officer (Assistant Commandant) in CPMFs. In case the Medical Student decides not to continue his/her service liability or withdraws from the college at his / her own volition, he / she shall be liable to repay the scholarship money received with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest of 4%
- 4. The Medical student will be declared to have become Non Service Liability (NSL)on being rendered medically unfit by a Medical Board of Medical College Hospital for appointment due to any disease / disability detected at any stage during the course /Training or prior to his/her appointment, as under:-
 - (a) The Medical board of Medical College Hospital will express their opinion on the circumstances under which the Medical Student acquired the disease / disability and whether or not he / she had any control over those circumstances. The three categories of Medical students declared NSL on medical grounds, are as follows:-

Category I – declared medically unfit due to diseases / circumstances within their control like drug abuse, accidents and injury in brawls / fights.

Category II – declared medically unfit due to diseases / circumstances beyond their control, but who refused to undergo treatment.

Category III – declared medically unfit due to diseases / circumstances beyond their control and who do not refuse treatment.

- (b) Based on the above factors, the scholarship money shall be recovered in the following manner:-
 - (i) The medical students who are declared unfit for appointment / NSL on following medical grounds:-
 - (aa) due to disease / circumstances beyond his / her control and who do not refuse treatment (Category III).
 - (ab) due to disease / circumstances which are attributable to the training curriculum of MBBS.

(ac) due to disease / circumstances necessitating withdrawal from college.

In sub clause (aa), (ab) and (ac) above, scholarship will be discontinued and the amount of scholarship already paid will be recovered alongwith prevailing medium or long term normal bank rate of interest.

- (c) In case of Medical Students who are declared unfit for appointment in CPMFs / NSL on Medical grounds other than those mentioned at para 4 (b) (i) above, the scholarship paid to the students will be recovered with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest of 2%.
- (d) In case of death of medical student during the period of scholarship being paid to him/her or the one who dies after joining the CPMFs but before completing 10 years of service, no recovery of scholarship amount shall be made.
- (e) In case of medical students removed from Non Service Liability after passing final MBBS examination, the No Objection Certificate (NOC) for joining internship training by Principal of Medical College will only be issued after the scholarship money with penal interest has been paid in full.
- 5. The Medical Student will also be declared to have become unfit for appointment in CPMFs/ Non Service Liability(NSL) in the event of any of the following and liable for the recovery of scholarship amount paid to the student with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest of 4%:-
 - (a) Failing in attendance below 50% in any two consecutive terms for reasons other than medical, or
 - (b) Failing to qualify MBBS course within a total period of five years from the date of entry into college. In case a Medical Student has appeared for the final MBBS examination prior to completion of five years but the result thereof is declared subsequently, in which he / she has passed the final MBBS examination, the Medical student will not be declared unfit for appointment / NSL and will be eligible for appointment in CPMFs subject to meeting all other eligibility criteria. Medical student so declared as Non Service Liability shall thereafter be covered under clause six below.
- 6. In the event of any contingency arising from clauses 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 the party of the FIRST part shall be jointly and severally liable to pay forthwith to the Govt. the amount of scholarship received along with the prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal and prescribed penal interest as stated above in the relevant paras from the date of receiving 1st installment of scholarship amount. Provided however that amount stated above may be revised upward in respect of which decision of the Govt. of India shail be final and binding on the parties of first part.

- 7. In the event of a medical student after being appointed in CPMFs, discharged/removed from the service on administrative/disciplinary grounds as per rules before the completion of 10 years of service from the date of such appointment, he / she shall be liable to repay the scholarship money received with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest of 4%.
- 8. In the event of a medical student immediately after graduation and completion of internship refusing to accept the offer of appointment may be released from Service Liability by the Government on full payment of total scholarship amount received with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest of 4%. If a medical student after being appointed in CPMFs, applies for release from service within 10 years but after completion of five years of service, the government may permit his / her release as per the Rules, provided that he/she refunds the amount of scholarship money alongwith prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus the training charges or three months salary whichever is more. However, in case, where a medical student after being appointed in CPMFs applies for release from service before expiry of 5 years from the date of such appointment, his / her release may be permitted by the government as per the Rules provided that he/she refunds the scholarship money with prevailing medium or long term bank rate of normal interest plus penal interest of 2% plus the training charges or 03 months salary whichever is more.
- 9. That the liability of the father / guardian and the surety hereunder shall not be impaired or discharged by reason of time being granted or any forbearance, act or commission of the Government or any person authorized by them (whether with or without the knowledge of consent of the surety) nor shall it be necessary for the Government to sue the Medical student and or his / her father / guardian before suing the surety for the amount due hereafter.
- 10. And it is lastly agreed that if there is any dispute to the effect, meaning of these presents, or otherwise, however, except as to matters for which specific provision has been made in these presents, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the ADG(Medical), MHA or any person appointed by him whose decision shall be final and binding on the parties. There will be no objection if the arbitrator is a Government servant.

The provision of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 as amended from time to time, shall apply.
