#### **Information to Applicants for Higher Degree Courses**

#### 1. ADMISSION

- (a) Candidates for admission to a higher degree programme shall normally be graduates of Babcock University or of other institutions recognized by Babcock University Senate
- (b) All candidates without previous higher degrees in the relevant discipline shall be admitted in the first instance to the Masters degree programme
- (c) Candidates who do not have a degree in the specific discipline for which admission may be required are to spend an extra semester to qualify for the Master's degree
- (d) Candidates who hold a higher degree of this and other recognized institutions may be considered for direct or provisional admission to the M.Phil/Ph.D programme provided in every case that the candidate's performance as attested by transcripts or other relevant evidence is of a high and acceptable standard.

#### 2. REFEREE'S REPORTS, TRANSCRIPT AND RESEARCH PROPOSALS

- (a) A candidate shall not be considered for admission to a higher degree course unless his application is supported by at least one confidential report from a former teacher at undergraduate level, and a transcript of his academic record forwarded directly by the authorities of his former University. The Transcript Label provided must accompany the transcript when sent. Copies of transcript not forwarded directly to the Secretary, School of Postgraduate Studies, would not be accepted.
- (b) Each candidate shall be responsible for ensuring that supporting documents are forwarded to the School of Postgraduate Studies
- (c) Candidates for research degree (M.Phil., PhD.) are required to submit a 200 word research proposal

#### 3. MINIMUM DURATION OF COURSES

- (a) Three semesters for the Masters Degree
- (b) M.Phil.: 2 semesters after the three (3) semesters Degree of Master for full-time students.
- (c) Ph.D.: 6 semesters from the date of first registration for full-time students.

#### 4. REGISTRATION

Registration must be completed within three weeks of the opening of each academic year.

#### 5. DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Candidates for higher degrees are required to take an approved combination of courses and to submit a project report, a dissertation or a thesis depending on the degree programme.

#### 6. CONVERSION TO M.Phil AND Ph.D. PROGRAMMES

Candidates for the Masters Degree who attain a specified level of performance at the end of their degree programme may be recommended to proceed to candidacy for the M.Phil., M.Phil/Ph.D. depending on the programme of study

#### 7. ACCEPTANCE OF OFFER OF ADMISSION

Offers of admission not accepted by the date specified in the letter of admission will automatically lapse.

#### 8. RETURN OF APPLICATION FORM

The completed application form must be submitted online or by hand or courier to the Secretary, School of Postgraduate Studies, Babcock University, P.M.B. 21244, Ikeja, Lagos

#### 9. MODULES/ADMISSION SESSIONS

Regular Session runs from September 1 – April 30 of Every Year containing two semesters Summer Session runs from May 1 – July 31 yearly and it is a stand alone semester.
