ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

FACULTY OF HUMANITIES & EDUCATION (EDUCATION-BASED) (B.Ed.)

Three Years (without Teacher Training) Full-Time

(Limited options: History, English Language, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies/Geography, Language Education: Literacy Studies).

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) including English Language **AND** two double Units Cape subjects or 2 GCE A-Level subjects in relevant area

Two Years Full-Time or Three Years Part-Time (Teacher Trained)

- Teachers' College Certificate in relevant area + Four GCE (Grades A-C)/CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) including English Language **OR**
- Three years Secondary Teachers' College Diploma in relevant area + English Language.

FACULTY OF HUMANITIES & EDUCATION (HUMANITIES-BASED) (B.A.)

Three Years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level / BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) including English Language. Strongly recommended: Geography, Foreign Language, Mathematics (or a laboratory science subject), History, Literature **AND** two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A-Level subjects (one of which must be a Humanities subject for which courses are taught at the University)
- Individuals without a foreign language pass, at least at CXC CSEC, will be required to take a least one of the basic foreign languages courses.
- Applicants for the Entertainment and Cultural Enterprise Management programme must have CSEC/BGCSE Mathematics

Four Years Part-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) including English Language. Strongly recommended: Geography, a Foreign Language, Mathematics (or a laboratory science subject), History, Literature
- Individuals without a foreign language pass, at least at CXC CSEC, will be required to take a least one of the basic foreign languages courses

FACULTY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES

A.Sc. Child Development Therapy - Two years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Levels/ BGCSE (Grades A-C) in English Language, Mathematics, Biology

NOTE: Departmental requirements (2 references)

Mature entry (applicants must be over 21 years) with recognition of experience in the field will be considered.

Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (M.B.B.S.)

/ Doctor of Dental Surgery (D.D.S.)/ Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M)

Five years Full-Time

(applicants must be at least 18 years old in year of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Levels/ BGCSE (Grades A-C) in English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics **AND** three double Units CAPE subjects or 3 A-Level subjects including Chemistry, Biology and any other subject

NOTE: Physics and Mathematics are compulsory at the CSEC/BGCSE level, whereas Biology and Chemistry are compulsory at CAPE/A-Levels

- OR**
- UWI Preliminary and/or Introductory years in Science and Technology courses in Biology, Chemistry and one other **OR**
- Triple major Associate degree majoring in Biology, Chemistry and one other subject from approved Community Colleges with GPA greater than 3.5 **OR**

- Equivalent qualifications (as determined from transcripts)

Non-Academic Considerations

- All candidates are required to submit a short autobiographic sketch outlining the reasons for their career choice (300 words or less)
- Candidates must also produce evidence of their involvement in relevant extra-curricular/co-curricular activities, socially-oriented projects and voluntary community service in the year prior to their application

B.Sc. Diagnostic Imaging (Radiography) - Three years Full-Time

- Six CSEC subjects, (General Proficiency Grades I-III) in English Language, Mathematics or Physics, Biology or Human and Social Biology, one other science subject in addition to two other subjects
- Applicants must attend an interview

B.Sc. Nursing - Four Years Full-Time

(applicants should be at least 17 years old at the time of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Biology/Integrated Science/Human and Social Biology, Mathematics and two other approved subjects **AND** two double Units at CAPE (one subject from Mathematics, Physics, Biology, and one subject from any of the other subject areas, as specified by the Nursing Council of Jamaica)
- Applicants may be required to attend an interview

B.Sc. Physical Therapy - Three Years Full-Time

(applicants should be at least 18 years old at time of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Mathematics and Biology **AND** two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 A- Level subjects, chosen from Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology
- Complete 60 voluntary hours in a Physical Therapy facility at the time of admission, of which at least 30 must be spent in a general hospital. Candidates must make own arrangements for doing voluntary hours
- Applicants must attend an interview

Bachelor of Basic Medical Sciences (BBMedSci) - Three years Full-Time

(Options: Anatomy, Biochemistry, Physiology and Pharmacology)

- Five CSEC (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) in English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics **AND** two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 A- Level subjects chosen from Chemistry, Biology/Zoology, Physics/Mathematics **OR**
- UWI Preliminary Science & Technology courses – Chemistry, Life Sciences, Physics, Mathematics **OR**
- Equivalent qualifications (as determined from transcripts)

NOTE: Students registered in the Bachelor of Basic Medical Sciences Programme **cannot transfer to the MB,BS Programme**. However, on completion can apply to the MB, BS Programme where credits may be granted.

FACULTY OF LAW

Bachelor of Laws (LL.B) - Three years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language **AND** Two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A-Level (passes with highly competitive grades) **OR**
- An Associate Degree from an approved tertiary level institution with a GPA of 2.5 and above [3.5 for St. Augustine] **OR**
- A Bachelors or Masters degree from an approved university



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS continued:

FACULTY OF ENGINEERING (B.Sc.)

Bachelor of Science Engineering - Three years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics **AND** two double Units CAPE or 2 GCE A-Level passes in Pure/Pure & Applied Mathematics and Physics **OR**
- Equivalent qualifications from approved tertiary institution

NOTE: Holders of Associate degrees or diplomas from approved Caribbean tertiary level institutions must possess a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.5 or 65% and above.

Special Departmental Requirements (in addition to requirements above) For Civil, Electrical & Computer, Industrial and Mechanical Engineering

- Two double Units CAPE or 2 GCE A Level passes in Pure/Pure & Applied Mathematics and Physics and CSEC or GCE O-Level /BGCSE Chemistry

For Chemical and Process Engineering

- Three double Units CAPE or GCE A-Level passes in Chemistry, Pure/Pure & Applied Mathematics and Physics.

For Petroleum Geoscience

- Three double Units CAPE or GCE A Level in Mathematics, Physics/Chemistry and Geography

Bachelor of Science Geomatics (formerly Surveying and Land Information (B.Sc.) - Three years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Physics and Mathematics **AND** two double Units CAPE or 2 GCE A-Level passes in Pure/Pure & Applied Mathematics and any one of the following: Chemistry, Physics, Physical Science, Geography, Engineering Science, Economics, Technical Drawing or equivalent subject

Bachelor of Science Land Management (Valuation) (B.Sc.) - Three years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language and Mathematics **AND** two double Units CAPE or GCE A-Level in Accounting, Geography, Economics, Business Studies, Pure/Pure & Applied Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Physical Science, Technical Drawing, Engineering Science, or other relevant subject

FACULTY OF SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY (B.Sc.) (formerly Faculty of Pure & Applied Sciences)

Three Years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Mathematics, and at least two approved laboratory science subjects **AND** two double Units CAPE or 2 GCE A- Level subjects chosen from Biology, Chemistry, Geography, Mathematics, Physics

Four Years Full-Time (Preliminary Level)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Levels/BGCSE (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Mathematics, and at least two approved laboratory science subjects

Special Departmental Requirements (in addition to requirements above) Bachelor of Science Horticulture

- Applicants must have passes at the CSEC level in the following: English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Geography, Chemistry **AND** passes at the CAPE Level in Biology, Geography or Chemistry **OR** an Associate Degree in an appropriate discipline

Bachelor of Science Actuarial Science

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Mathematics **AND** two double Units CAPE Mathematics OR GCE A/Level Mathematics and one other subject with highly competitive grades.

FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES (B.Sc.)

Three Years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language and Mathematics **AND** two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A-Level subjects

NOTE: Special departmental requirements apply for B.Sc. Social Work (2 references, personal statement, co-curricular form and/or interview).

Four Years Part-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) or GCE O'Level / BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) with compulsory English Language and Mathematics.

INSTITUTE FOR GENDER & DEVELOPMENT STUDIES (B.Sc.)

Three Years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language **AND** two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A-Level subjects

Four Years Part-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) or GCE O'Level / BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) with compulsory English Language and Mathematics.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY TEST: English Language is compulsory for admission to all programmes of The University of the West Indies. Candidates who do not possess a Grade 1 in CSEC English A, a Grade A in GCE O'Level / BGCSE English Language, Grade 1 or 2 in CAPE Communication Studies or a Grade A in the GCE General Paper, are required to take an English Language Proficiency Test on entry.

Applicants whose first language is not English must perform satisfactorily in an approved English Language Test, such as the Test of English for Foreign Language (TOEFL). For information on TOEFL please visit www.toefl.org

OTHER ACCEPTABLE QUALIFICATIONS

Associate degrees from approved Caribbean tertiary level institutions with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and above are considered as having satisfied normal matriculation requirements for entry to certain Faculties. In specific instances, credit/exemptions may be given in respect of Level 1 courses – (for St. Augustine, a higher GPA is required in order to obtain CR/Exemption based on A.Sc. degrees)
