Special Recruitment of Lecturers in Tamil Nadu Collegiate Educational Service for SC/ST Candidates in Govt. Arts & Science Colleges - 2008

PROSPECTUS

1. The Government of Tamil Nadu, vide G.O.Ms.No.8, Higher Education (F2) Department, dated 14-1-2008 have permitted the TRB to recruit Lecturers in Tamil Nadu Collegiate Educational Service for appointment in Government Arts and Science Colleges as a Special Recruitment for SC/ST candidates for 522 shortfall vacancies.

The posts will be filled up on the basis of Weightage marks to be awarded for (a) Teaching experience, (b) Higher educational qualifications in the subject, (c) Books/Articles published and (d) marks to be awarded in the Interview. The whole recruitment is for the shortfall vacancies for SC/ST candidates, duly following 30% reservation for Women. 1% for Physically challenged, 1% for Visually impaired, and 1% for Hearing impaired as shown in the Annexure-I.

- 2. The estimated vacancies for Lecturers are given in Annexure -1.
- 3. Scale of Pay of the post: Rs. 8,000-275-13,500
- 4. Educational Qualifications:

A Degree and Postgraduate degree (with a minimum of 50% marks) in the relevant Subject and a pass in the NET examination conducted by UGC /CSIR/JRF, SLET examination conducted by the Universities in Tamil Nadu and the SLST conducted by the University of Madras in 1990 (OR)

Candidates with a Degree and **Postgraduate** degree (with a minimum of 50% marks) in the relevant Subject and **M.Phil** or **Ph.D** degree or both in the same and relevant subject, are eligible to apply.

All the Educational qualifications should have been obtained on or before 28-4-2008 the last date of submission of application form.

The application of a candidate is liable to be summarily rejected if he/she is not qualified in the relevant subject in degree and postgraduate degree levels.

*NET, SLET, SLST or an accredited Test shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer for those with post-graduate degree. However, the candidates having **Ph.D**. degree in the concerned subject are exempted from acquiring NET or SLET or an accredited Test for P.G. level and UG level teaching. The candidates having **M.Phil**. degree in the concerned subject are exempted from acquiring NET or SLET or an accredited Test conducted by UGC.

- 5. Age: Candidates should not be over 57 years as on 1-7-2008.
- 6. Candidates of Special categories (G.O.Ms.No.7, Higher Education (F2) Department dated 14-1-2008). Candidates claiming reservation under the following physically challenged categories (Ortho, Blind and Deaf) have to obtain relevant certificates from competent authority for their suitability for the post they have applied as per G.O.Ms.No.99, Personnel and Administrative Department, dt. 26-2-1988.
 - a) **Visually impaired candidates:** Candidates should possess a certificate in prescribed format from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon for one of the following:

- (i) Total absence of sight, or (ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses or (iii) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degrees or worse. (One-eyed blind persons cannot claim reservation against Blind or PHO category).
- *b)* **Hearing impaired candidates:** Candidates should possess certificate from the Civil Surgeon or the District Medical Officer for the hearing loss.
- c) **Physically challenged** candidates: Candidates should possess certificate in prescribed format from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon for at least 40% disability.
- 7. Availability and cost of Application form: The Intelligent Character Recognition Application forms along with Prospectus can be obtained in person from the Offices of the Colleges as shown in the <u>Annexure-II</u> from 28.3.2008 onwards, on payment of Rs.150/- by a Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Chairman, Teachers Recruitment Board, Chennai", from any one of the following branches of State Bank of India, Indian Bank and Indian Overseas Bank.

The candidate should write his/her name, Application number, Subject for which he/she applies, in English on the reverse of the Demand Draft.

- 8. **Submission of Application Form**: Candidates are advised to submit the filled-in forms in person in the same College where he/she obtained the application, on or before 28-4-2008, the last date for submission of the Application form, and obtain acknowledgement for the same. Applications received in any form other than the one issued by Teachers Recruitment Board shall be summarily rejected. Teachers Recruitment Board will not be responsible for any delay or lapses or non-receipt of filled-in applications sent by post/courier.
- 9. **Community Certificate**: Permanent Community Certificate Card obtained from the undermentioned authorities on or before the last date of submission of the Application form is necessary for candidates claiming communal reservation.
 - a) ST Revenue Divisional Officer, if issued after 11-11-1989
 - b) SC Tahsildar of the native taluk of the candidate

Married women should possess Community Certificate Card issued in father's name only. Community Certificate issued by the authorities of Tamil Nadu will alone be considered.

10. **Scheme of Selection**: Scheme of selection involves two stages

Marks will be awarded to all candidates based on the information given by them in their Application forms during the time of CV as per criteria and also the marks awarded during the time of Interview, as per G.O.Ms.No.306, Higher Education (F2) Department, dated 10.9.2007, as follows:

Stage-I: <u>Certificate Verification</u>: Candidates will be ranked Subject-wise based on the information given by them in respect of items 1-3 above, during the time of C.V. Thereafter, the rank-cum-communal roster will be prepared. Candidates may note that the <u>provisional ranking</u> will be done on the basis of information provided and documents submitted by them. If any information is found to be false or incorrect, such candidatures will be summarily rejected. Hence, candidates are required to fill in the forms with great care and without making any unsubstantiated claims. Regarding the award of weightage marks the decision of the Certificate Verification Board will be the final.

Stage-II: <u>Interview</u>: Based on the rank-cum-communal roster, candidates will be short-listed for interview in the ratio of 1: 10. Interview will be conducted by Interview Boards to be constituted by the Teachers Recruitment Board. At the time of interview, all original certificates in support of community, qualifications, experience, etc. will be verified and in case of any discrepancy between the certificates and information provided in the Application form and in the CV, the candidate will not be considered for selection. In addition to this, proof for publications of books/articles should also be produced by the candidates.

All candidates should have the ability to speak and write in Tamil. The Syllabi to be adopted for personal interview will be the latest UGC PG syllabus for each Subject.

- 11. **T.A./D.A**. will not be paid for attending CV and Interview. Candidates will have to bear their expenses to attend the interview at designated Centres, if called.
- 12. Reservation of Visually impaired, Hearing impaired and Physically challenged candidates

As per G.O.Ms.No.7, Higher Education (F2) Department dated 14-1-2008, recruitment of 1% Visually impaired, 1% Hearing impaired and 1% Physically challenged candidates will be recruited in the subjects noted in the Annexure-I

Special Instructions:

- a) The candidates who are applying for more than one subject has to submit separate application for each subject if he/she is qualified for more than one subject.
- b) The Application Forms should be carefully filled up after reading the Prospectus. The passport size photograph should be pasted in the space provided and should not be stapled. The photograph should not be attested and it should be free from any mark, as the same has to be used for printing the Call letter and Selection intimation letter.
- c) The candidate should write his/her Name, Subject, Application Form No. and the Post applied for, on reverse of the Demand Draft.
- d) The Application form should not be folded. The Application form should be submitted in the envelope issued by the TRB.
- e) The candidates are requested to draw the Demand Draft for Rs.150/- in favour of 'The Chairman, Teachers Recruitment Board, Chennai' payable to Chennai, from any one of the Banks mentioned in the Application form. The name of the Bank and Bank code are to be entered in the Application form as per the codes given in the form.
- f) List of offices of Colleges, both for sale of Applications and submission of filled-in Applications, are given in Annexure-II.

- g) The Subject code should be clearly filled up in the space allotted in the Application form.
- h) The Teaching Experience Certificate for those who worked/working in Government/ Aided/ Self-financing Arts & Science colleges should be countersigned by the Regional Joint Director of Collegiate Education, for those who worked/working in Govt./Aided/Self-financing Engineering colleges are to be countersigned by the Joint Director of Technical Education for those who worked/working in Universities/Deemed Universities should be countersigned by the concerned Registrar, for the period up to the last date for submission of application. In respect of Teaching Experience, the period to which the college was under the control of Director of Collegiate Education / Director of Technical Education have to be countersigned by Regional Joint Director of Collegiate Education / Director of Technical Education in the format shown in Annexure-III and for the period from the date of enjoying the status of Deemed University or University, the respective Registrar should countersign, in the format shown in the Annexure-IV prescribed by TRB only. The Teaching experience certificate for those who worked/working in Government/Aided/Self-financing Law / Medical colleges in the relevant subjects, should be countersigned by the Joint Director of the concerned Department and if Universities/Deemed Universities, by the Registrar of the concerned University. In respect of Teaching Experience, the period to which the college was under the control of the concerned department have to be countersigned by Director of the concerned Department in the format shown in Annexure-III and for the period from the date of enjoying the status of Deemed University or University, the respective Registrar should countersign, in the format shown in the Annexure-IV prescribed by TRB only. The Teaching experience in the subject for which they have applied alone will be considered.
- i) Books and Articles should have been published in the respective subjects. Books published up to the cut-off date will be considered and authorship should be established. The journals in which the articles published should be enclosed. Co-authorship will not be considered.
- j) Candidates with the Community Certificate issued other than authorities from Tamil Nadu will not be considered.
- k) Candidates should clearly mention the subject code.
- I) Candidates are informed to ascertain their full eligibility for the post to which they have applied. The onus proof of providing equivalence vested with the candidates only. TRB cannot take any responsibility, if their ineligibility detected at any stage during or after the recruitment and declaration of results.
- m) In the matter of recruitment, the decision of the TRB is final. Any representation for non-selection will not be entertained at any cost.
- n) Canvass in any form will lead to cancellation of their candidature.
