C. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The admission shall be made only within the sanctioned strength.

2. The rules of admission of students, issued from the University, should be strictly followed in making admissions.

A copy of the 1st list is to be sent to the Registrar, University of Calicut, by Registered Post on 3. the date of publication of the same.

A copy of the 2nd list is to be sent to the Registrar, University of Calicut, by Registered Post on 4.

the day of publication of the same.

A copy of the final list of admitted students showing categories and reservation quota 5. should be sent to the University by Registered Post as soon as the interview is over, and acknowledgement obtained. The failure to present such a list may result in the candidates inability to take University examinations.

Rules regarding reservation of seats for SC/ST and other eligible categories should be 6. followed strictly. (applicable to unaided colleges also)

- 7. Candidates qualified in the annual examination held during April - May 2012 or in an examination held prior to April 2012 alone are qualified for admission.
- Candidates who have passed the HSE and VHSE of Government of Kerala under 'SAY' 8. scheme and Compartmental Examination of CBSE are also eligible for admission to first semester degree courses in the same academic year itself.

Candidates who have passed the HSE of Tamil Nadu (Private Study) shall not be eligible for 9. admission to the above degree courses under this University

No admission shall be made over and above the sanctioned strength in anticipation of 10. sanction of marginal increase or adjustment at the end of the year.

11. Application forms for admission shall not be issued beyond the last date fixed for issuance.

12. Two seats in each undergraduate course will be reserved for candidates with outstanding records in sports & games. Candidates who seek admission under sports quota should also apply within the last date scheduled, with necessary certificates, superscribing on the application form as "for admission in the sports quota".

If the Principals of any college make any irregular admission a fine of Rs.10,000/- for each 13. admission will be imposed as per the Syndicate decision dated 07.01.2006 (U.O. No.

GA1/A2/4394/2004 dated 04.02.2006).
