

Undergraduate Application Packet

The enclosed application packet is for all new freshmen, transfers, former transfers, transients, former transient students and veterans. Applicants are encouraged to apply online at www.ysu.edu/admissions. If you are a former student or veteran please follow the procedures below.

NEW APPLICANT—has a high school diploma or passed the General Education Development (GED) test and has not attended a college or university. Note: those applicants who have attended college while in high school are considered new students and must make arrangements to have official transcript(s) sent directly to the Office of Admissions.

TRANSFER APPLICANT—regardless of length of attendance, previously attended another college or university after graduating from high school or completing a GED.

TRANSIENT APPLICANT—currently enrolled at another college or university, is in **good academic standing**, is eligible to return to that college or university, and wishes to attend YSU for **one** semester only.

FORMER TRANSIENT APPLICANT—a former YSU student currently enrolled at another college or university, is in **good academic standing**, is eligible to return to that college or university, and wishes to return to YSU for an additional semester. **You do not need to pay the \$45 application fee.**

FORMER AND TRANSFER STUDENT—previously attended YSU for credit, attended another college or university before coming back to YSU, regardless of length of attendance. **You do not need to pay the \$45 application fee.**

FORMER STUDENT—previously attended YSU for credit and has not attended another college or university since leaving YSU. You must complete the **Undergraduate Admission Application for Re-Admission**, available by contacting the **Records Office at 330-941-3182 or print the application at <u>www.ysu.edu/records</u>, click on Admission Services. If you were academically suspended, you must be reinstated. Consult the dean's office of the college from which you were suspended to make an appointment to be reinstated**.

Freshman applicants must submit:

- Completed Undergraduate Admission Application
- Non-refundable \$45 application fee
- Official high school transcript
- Official copy of ACT or SAT exam results*
- Official copy of your General Education Development (GED) test results, if applicable
- Proof of passing all sections of the Ohio Graduation Test (OGT)—Ohio residents only
- * ACT or SAT is not required if applicant graduated from high school more than 2 years prior to enrollment unless participating in varsity sports

Transient applicants must submit:

- Completed Undergraduate Admission Application
- Non-refundable \$45 application fee
- Official letter from the Registrar's Office at current college/ university stating applicant is in good academic standing or
- Copy of transcript from current college/university

Former transient students must submit:

- Completed Undergraduate Admission Application
- Official letter from the Registrar's Office at current college/ university stating applicant is in good academic standing or
- · Copy of transcript from current college/university

(Transient students must re-apply each semester as acceptance is only valid for one academic semester)

Transfer/Post-Baccalaureate applicants must submit:

- Completed Undergraduate Admission Application
- Non-refundable \$45 application fee
- Official transcript from all colleges/universities attended
- Official high school transcript*
- Official copy of your General Education Development (GED) test results, if applicable*
- Proof of passing all sections of the Ohio Graduation Test (OGT)—Ohio residents only*

Former/Transfer students must submit:

- Completed Undergraduate Admission Application
- Official transcript from all colleges/universities attended since leaving YSU

Veterans and military personnel:

- Contact the Office of Veterans Affairs at 330-941-2503 regarding application process procedures before applying
- Completed Undergraduate Admissions Application
- Official high school transcript

- Former students to Youngstown State University do not need to pay the non-refundable application fee.
- If you apply and then postpone your enrollment for one academic year or more, you will need to re-apply and be assessed another non-refundable application fee.
