Model Question Paper Instructions to Candidates

The entrance test for admission to Master of Business Administration (Hospital & Health Care Management) is conducted by the Convener, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University, Hyderabad on 15.06.2014 at Apollo Institute of Health Care Management, Apollo Medical College Building, Apollo Health City, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad.

The test is of 1½ hours (90 minutes) duration from 10.00 am to 11.30 am. It is assessed for 100 marks, as detailed below.
