8.0 CORRECTION OF MARKS

In case of change in marks of a student in the qualifying examination, such student shall produce a letter to that effect of the corrected mark sheet issued by the Board, before the Admission Committee at least one day before the commencement of admission process but not later than seven days from the receipt of letter or corrected mark-sheet as the case may be. In such case, he shall be placed at an appropriate order in the merit list.

The student who was declared failed initially in the qualifying examination, but later on declared passed after rechecking of marks by the Board, such student shall, notwithstanding any time limit prescribed, be allowed to apply for the admission provided he produces a letter to that effect or the corrected mark sheet issued by the Board, within seven days of the receipt of letter, or as the case may be.

During verification of documents at reporting time at college, if the authority finds any certificate or testimony or information submitted by any candidate, incorrect or false

1. The candidature of such candidate shall be cancelled for that year and
2. Fees paid by the candidate shall be forfeited

14.0 GENERAL INFORMATION OF STUDY

1. The medium of instruction of education is English.
2. The detailed information with respect of study, examination system, academic regulations, course contents etc., will be available from the Principal of the concerned college. The academic regulations are subject to changes as approved by the competent authorities of the university from time to time. The universities impart residential instructions for the graduate programme at their constituent colleges with the eligibility and category wise minimum admission requirements. Under the Semester system of education, all student are compulsorily to stay in University hostels, except otherwise permitted or non availability of accommodation in the hostel.

15.0 REPORTING AT THE RESPECTIVE COLLEGE:	
Registration of Students at the Time of Admission	
A candidate selected for admission shall become an enrolled student of the University only after he shall report at the college on the date fixed by the central admission committee in person which consists of the following steps :-

	ix. Domicile Certificate of Gujarat to be produced, if required.
	x. Certificate of Physical Challenged, issued and duly signed by the Civil Surgeon/competent Medical Authority, in case the candidate is a Physically Handicapped.
	xi. Certificate of Ex-Serviceman, duly issued by the Director, Sainik Welfare Board, Gujarat State or by the District Sainik Welfare Officer.
	xii. A copy of certificate of Ex-Serviceman duly issued by the Commanding Officer of the respective unit in which he is serving.
	xiii. Certificate of physical fitness from Registered medical practitioner. The candidate may also be examined by the Medical Officer of the University, if required.
	xiv. Fisher men certificate from the Assistant Director of Fisheries.
	xv. Such other certificates as the Admission Committee deems necessary.
	xvi. Three passport size photographs.
	xvii. Orientation at the respective colleges
	xviii. Registration for courses at the respective colleges
15.3	Selected candidate shall report at the college for his first registration on the date mentioned in the admission memo.
15.4	The admission of any candidate who fails to report on the fixed date shall stand cancelled and another candidate on the waiting list may be admitted to the vacant seat so created. Provided that a candidate who is not in a position to report for the first registration, on the date fixed for him due to unavoidable circumstances may obtain provisional registration by paying fees by post or through messenger on or before the date fixed for his registration. Such a candidate shall be required to complete the remaining steps of registration within one week from the date of commencement of the semester, failing which his admission shall stand cancelled.
15.5	A student enrolled in the University will be given his registration number to be used along with his name in all the concerned academic documents.

16.0 ANTI-RAGGING

Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging

In view of the directions of the Honorable Supreme Court in SLP No. 24295 of 2006 dated 16-05- 2007 and in Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009, dated 08-05-2009 to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging including any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, in all higher education institutions in the country, and thereby, to provide for the healthy development, physically and psychologically, of all students.

16.1 What Constitutes Ragging

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

A	Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
B	Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
C	Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
D	Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
E	Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
F	Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
G	Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
H	Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student
I	Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

16.2	Mandatory Discloser :	
	A	Ragging is totally banned and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging is liable to be punished.
	B	The affidavit-I should be filled up and signed by the candidate to the effect that he / she is aware of the law regarding prohibition of ragging as well as the punishments, and that he/she, if found guilty of the offence of ragging and / or abetting ragging, is liable to be punished appropriately.
	C	The affidavit-II should be signed by the parent/guardian of the applicant to the effect that he/she is also aware of the law in this regard and agrees to abide by the punishment meted out to his/her ward in case the latter is found guilty of ragging and / or abetting ragging.
	D	A student seeking admission to the hostel shall have to submit another affidavit-III along with his/her application for hostel accommodation that he / she is also aware of the law in this regard and agrees to abide by the punishments meted out if he / she is found guilty of ragging and / or abetting ragging.
	E	The first year students should desist from doing anything against their will even if ordered by the seniors, and that they have nothing to fear as the institution cares for them and shall not tolerate any atrocities against them.
	F	A student securing admission to a particular institute shall have to submit concern affidavits to the principal of institute.
16.3	Actions to be taken against students for indulging and Abetting Ragging in SAUs.	
	A	The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.
	B	Every single incident of ragging a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.
	C	The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, with regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging.

16.4	Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following,	
	a	Cancellation of admission
	b	Suspension from attending classes
	c	Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits
	d	Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process
	e	Withholding results
	f	Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
	g	Suspension / expulsion from the hostel
	h	Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
	i	Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
	j	Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
An appeal against the order of punishment by the Anti-Ragging Committee shall lie,		
	A	In case of an order of an institution, affiliated to or constituent part, of the University, to the Vice-Chancellor of the University;
	B	In case of an order of a University, to its Chancellor.
	C	In case of an institution of national importance created by an Act of Parliament, to the Chairman or Chancellor of the institution, as the case may be
The institutional authorities shall intimate the incidents of ragging occurred in their premises along with actions taken to the Council from time to time.		

17.0 HARASSMENT TO GIRL / WOMAN STUDENTS

A women complaint mechanism cell is established for protection against harassment to girl/woman students. Anyone found guilty will be punished suitably.
