ADMISSION NOTICE

ADMISSION INTO MBBS/BDS COURSES IN THE MEDICAL COLLEGES OF ASSAM AND REGIONAL DENTAL COLLEGE, GUWAHATI FOR THE SESSION, 2013

This is for general information for all that there shall be a single Entrance Examination called National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET-13) for admission into MBBS/BDS courses against both All India Quota and State Quota Seats for the Session 2013-14. The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi has already been entrusted the responsibility of conducting the NEET-13 and Admission Notice has already been published in the News Papers regarding online submission of the Application Forms for the same.

NEET-13 will be held on 5th May, 2013 and result will be declared by 1st week of June,2013. Henceforth, there shall be no Combined Entrance Examination at the State Level for selection of Candidates for MBBS/BDS Courses as was done earlier. The candidates who are permanent resident of Assam and desirous for getting admission into the State Quota seats of MBBS/BDS course are hereby informed the following few important information for future follow up action.

- 1. Candidates are required to go through information bulletin published by CBSE carefully and acquaint themselves.
- 2. Candidates to apply for NEET,2013 only on "Online".
- 3. Information bulletin can be downloaded from the website www.cbseneet.nic.in.
- 4. **Eligibility Criteria** for appearing in NEET-2013: The eligibility criteria to appear in the NEET -2013 will be as per the criteria prescribed by the Board.
- 5. Reservation Policy for State Quota Candidate: Admission under 85% State Quota seats in State Government Medical/Dental Colleges shall be subject to reservation policy and Eligibility Criteria prevailing in the State as notified by the respective State from time to time.
- 6. **Merit List for seats under State Quota-** CBSE will prepare a separate merit list along with waiting list based on the score obtained by the students belonging to each state in the NEET Examination.
- 7. Provided if sufficient number of candidates in the respective categories fail to secure minimum 50th percentile in case of U/R and 40th percentile in case of Reserve category as prescribed, the Central Government in consultation with MCI may at their discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission into MBBS Course as per their Gazette Notification. (*The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in All-India common merit list in "National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test for admission to MBBS Course"*).

- 8. Counselling for the 85% State Quota seats- For admission in to state quota seats the candidates who's names/ Roll Nos. appear in the State Merit List published by CBSE shall have to obtain a separate application form in the form of "FORM-A" and "FORM-B" from the Director of Medical Education, Assam. The State Admission Rules will also be made available along with above application forms. The Application Form-A shall obtain information regarding the various categories like SC/STP/STH/OBC/MOBC/MORAN/ MOTAK/PH/TGL/EX.TGL/RURAL AREA/CHAR AREA/ FREEDOM FIGHTER/ EX.SERVICEMEN/ MARTYR's/ EXTRIMIST VIOLENCE etc. against which the candidates would like to claim their seats in the MBBS/BDS Courses.
 - Advertisement for issue and submission of these Application Forms (Form "A" & "B") will be published in due course of time.
 - "Form-A" is to be submitted within 7 days of publication of NEET-13 result by the CBSE.
 - The "Form-B" indicating other eligibility criteria for the State Quota seats, will have to be submitted at the time of counseling for state quota seats.
 - The Director of Medical Education, Assam shall prepare Category-wise Select Lists for both Unreserved and various Reserved Category candidates in order of merit from the Merit List of State Quota Seats received from the CBSE after declaration of the NEET-13 Result.
 - The candidates will be called for counseling through a separate advertisement stating the date, time and venue.
 - During counseling a Candidate may not be allotted any seat if he/she fails to fulfill the norms laid down by the State Admission Rules e.g. a) PRC of the State b) Proof of Residency c) Minimum 4 years of schooling in the State of Assam by the candidate or his/her parents etc.
- 12. Students and Guardians are requested to go through the website of CBSE, New Delhi (www.cbseneet.nic.in) and Official website of Directorate of Medical Education, Assam (www.dmeassam.gov.in) for latest information/Notification in this regard.
