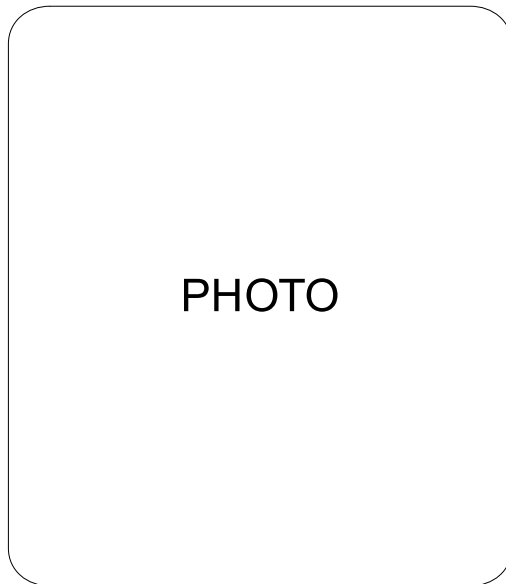

The modern information, communication and audio-visual facilities and curriculum for facilitating the learning of these business and computing skills in the students at IIS are truly contemporary, innovative and state-of-the-art... backed by experienced teachers and technical staff.

Students at a young age are trained in Professional Management Education, Business Management and Information Technology... while adhering to Islamic guidelines of the Qur'an and authentic Hadith too.

Our objective is to provide children Islamic knowledge and wisdom alongside modern worldly education.

Islamic ethos, etiquettes and behaviour as per the Qur'an and authentic Sunnah guidelines are encouraged in students at IIS.

The girls and boys are segregated, and have separate but equal facilities and classes, from 1st Std. onwards.

The IIS School Uniform adheres to the Islamic dress code and Hijab.

Congregational Prayers are offered daily in the school by students.

Much rejoicing and merrymaking is seen in students at the 'Eid-ul-Fitr and Eid-ul-Adha Parties' organized by IIS.

The girls adhere to the Islamic Hijab while being trained for Martial Arts and Swimming. The boys adhere to the Islamic dress code while being trained in Swimming and playing Football.

In Ramadhaan, the Taraweeh Salaah is led by IIS students in more than 10 batches, separately for girls and boys, to train the Huffaz of IIS in leading Taraweeh Salaah and rehearsing the glorious Qur'an.

The true understanding, motivation about and practice of Islamic guidelines are inculcated in the students by well versed and 'modern youth' oriented teachers. The Character, Courage and Confidence of the students are strengthened in their personality trait, coaxingly.

Students from Jr. KG onwards are trained in Public Speaking skills and techniques, in English as well as in Arabic. Healthy and Nutritious Mid-day meals are provided during the short break to upkeep the health of the students.

Compulsory Martial Arts, Swimming and other sport activities at IIS help the students to enhance their physical fitness and health.

Air-conditioned, well-designed and well-equipped Classrooms at the School facilitate the students' learning in a silent, comfortable and attentive ambience.

To learn about 'the world around us', students are taken on monthly educational excursions to places of public or social importance to see and learn about that place and activity.

As-Salaamu Alaikum Warahmatullahi Wabarakatuhu.

We thank you for choosing the Islamic International School to mould your child's character and personality. We welcome you and your child to the IIS family. We wish to inform you regarding the following rules of the school and request your complete compliance and adherence to these rules:-

1. School Timings:

Nursery	- 8:00 am to 11:30 am
Jr KG	- 8:00 am to 1:20 pm
Sr KG	- 8:00 am to 3:40 pm
Grade 1 to Grade 12	- 8:00 am to 4:30 pm

2. Weekly Holidays: The school will be closed on Fridays and Sundays.

3. The School will remain closed on the following days in the year 2012-13.

Independence Day	—	Wednesday, 15th Aug. 2012
Ramadaan and Eid-ul-Fitr Vacations	—	Tuesday, 7th Aug. to Sunday, 26th Aug. 2012
Eid-ul Adha Vacations	—	Monday, 22nd Oct. to Monday, 29th Nov. 2012
Muharram (Aashura)	—	Sunday, 25th Nov. 2012
Republic Day	—	Saturday, 26th Jan. 2013
Summer Vacations	—	Tuesday, 30th Apr. to Sunday, 9th Jun. 2013

4. Being absent on school days is discouraged. If your child is absent due to an emergency, you should fill the absence record in the calender stating reason and only signed by you. Attending the 1st day of school after the vacations is compulsory. If any unavoidable absence from school is

planned it should be sanctioned by the school management well in advance.

5. Parents should not send their child to school if he/she is suffering from contagious diseases like conjunctivitis, chicken pox, mumps, Swine Flu, etc. till he/she is certified by the doctor as “fit to attend school and non infectious”.
6. Insha’Allah the PTA meetings will be held for both fathers and mothers twice a year 1st-PTA would be after 1st term exam & 2nd-PTA would be after 2nd term exam to discuss the child’s performance in the first and second term exams respectively. Both the parents’ attendance is compulsory. Date would be informed to you by way of a circular for new academic year.
7. Monthly school fees should be paid on or before the 10th of each month. School fees for the months of March April and May should be paid by 10th March, due to the summer vacations. The 1st term & June fees should be paid by 10th April and 2nd term fees should be paid by 10th December. If the monthly school fees are not paid by the due date, then your child will not be allowed to attend the school.
8. School fee booklet is provided to you. please deposit the fee alongwith fee slip duly filled at DCB Bank, M.M.O. Branch, Dongri, before the due date.
9. Any enquiry related to your child or the school should only be made with the class teacher of your child during the appointed day of the week, within 25 minutes after the school ends, and not at any other time of the day. Parents should not approach teachers before or during school hours.
10. No enquiry of any sort should be made at the reception or with anyone else besides the class teacher. The Management is not responsible for any information given to you except that given by the class teacher and the Principal/Management by way of a circular.

11. Please take note that no enquiries should be made on the telephone / mobile phone of the staff or with security guards or helpers. The management is not responsible for any such information requested on the telephone or through other employees, besides the teachers.
12. The student should reach the respective class latest by 7.45 a.m. (but not before 7.30 a.m.).
13. If the student arrives later than 7.45 a.m. on more than one occasion in a month, a fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged.
14. The Students of Nursery to 2nd std. will only be given to the person who shows the Pick-up card. Without the Pick-up card these students will not be allowed to leave the school.
15. Parents who are dropping their child by Car/Taxi at the Mazgaon are requested to drop their child at the Junction of Hussain Patel Marg and Belvedre Road, and not take the vehicle near the school gate to avoid traffic congestion and cause inconvenience to the nearby building residents.
16. The student should be picked up within 20 minutes from the time the school ends from the respective class.
17. Many parents pick up their children late on several occasions. As a deterrent, a fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged if the child is picked up 25 minutes or later after the school ends. An additional Rs. 50/- will be charged extra for every additional half an hour that the child is picked up late.
18. Please ensure that your child's nails are cut once a week. The boys hair should always be short. There will be an inspection of the same every Monday.
19. Whenever the parents attend the Islamic programs or the PTA meetings they should ensure that they should scan their finger in biometric

attendance machine. All new parents are requested to get their name registered for biometric attendance system with admin department.

20. Parents should not be accompanied by their children when they attend the Islamic programs and the PTA meetings.
21. Please send a bottle of water with your child's name and class mentioned on it along with your child daily. The quantity should be such that it suffices for the entire schooling hours for your child.
22. The audio CD of the recitation of the Qur'an by Shaikh Abdul Rahman As-Sudais should be heard at home as often as possible and preferably daily.
23. Parents should ensure that their child wears the school uniform from the first day of school (Only late new admissions will be excused for the 1st week of school). The school uniform worn should be according to the specifications laid down by the school. If it deviates from the specifications, the child will not be allowed to attend school the next day unless it is rectified.
24. Please ensure that your child carries only those books required for the day as per the schedule in the time table.
25. If the required books are not brought as per the time table on more than two occasions in a month, then a fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged on every occasion the child doesn't get the books in that month.
26. Please ensure that your child carries his/her complete Martial Arts uniform and Swimming costume on the days specified in the time table. Parents whose children do not bring their uniform will be charged a fine of Rs. 100/-. Moreover, the child will not be permitted to participate in Martial Arts activity or Swimming on such days.
27. Parents should check their children's school diary daily and duly acknowledge with their signature any circular or note from the school.
28. Please ensure that the lunch you provide to your child is nutritious and

does not contain any processed foods like potato chips, wafers, fried snacks, etc.

29. Your child will be Insha'Allah taken for an educational excursion once a month. The same will Insha'Allah be informed to you by way of a circular.
30. Students newly admitted to the school in this academic year in the 1st to 12th std. and those admitted in the last few academic years (and have been informed to attend extra classes) will have to attend extra classes for Arabic language and Tajweed/Hifz on Sundays and during the summer vacations to catch up with what they have missed as compared to their classmates. If they do not attend extra class on Sunday or any other day during the vacation Rs.100/- will be fined for each absenteeism.
31. The timings for the first day of school will be from 8.00 am to 1.30 pm.
32. Thereafter the timings will be from 8.00 am to 4.30 pm.
33. The school timings for the students of the 3rd to 12th Std. who have been selected for Hifz of the Qur'an will be 6.30 am to 4.30 pm.

May Allah (swt) bless all of us and give us the strength and courage to strive in His Way and Cause, as we ought to strive in His Way and Cause. Aameen.

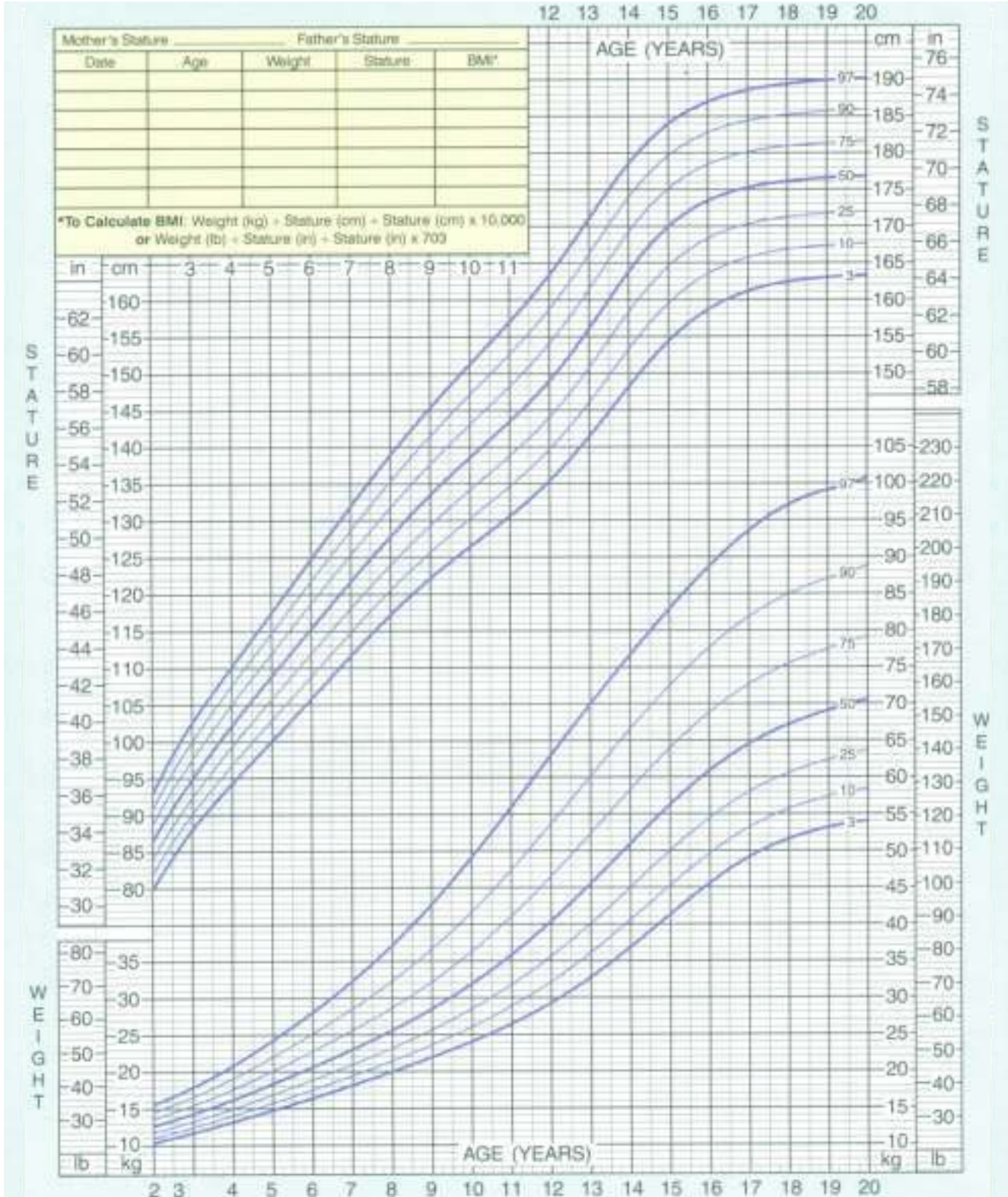

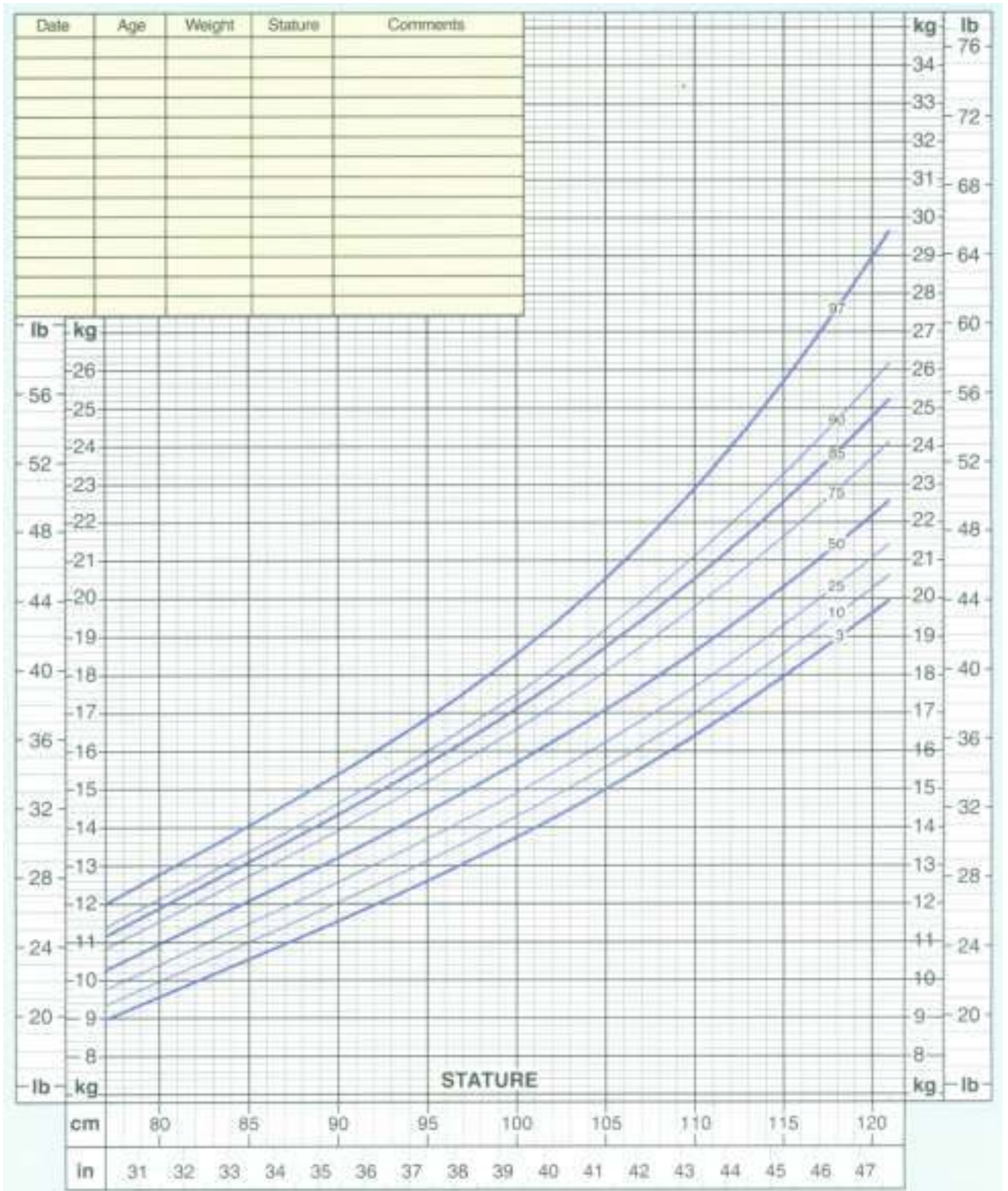

Stature-for age and weight-for -age percentiles



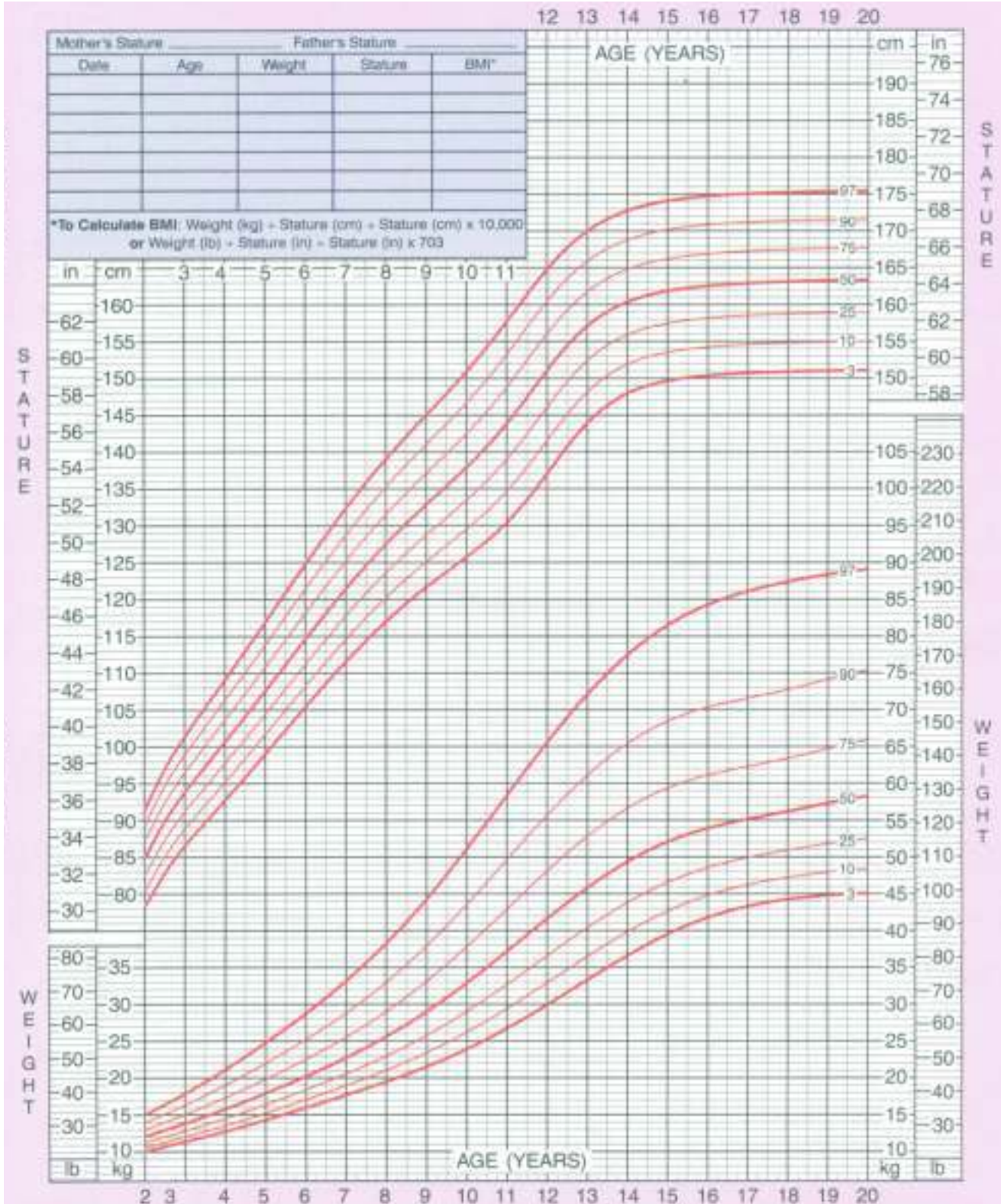

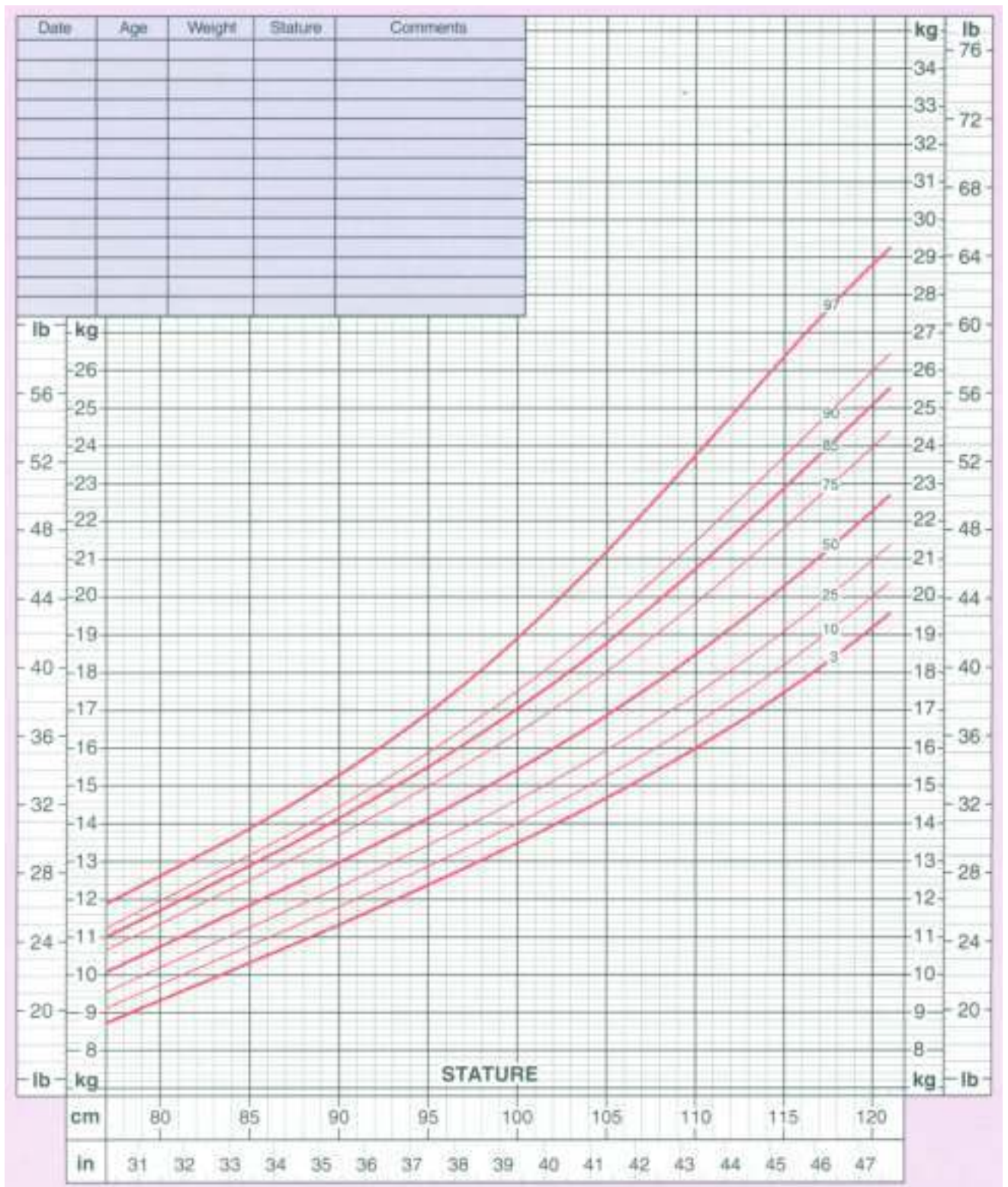
