Academics

Life long learning is the corner stone of all the academic planning and activities at TJIS, Bilaspur. Teaching, learning and assessment are all intertwined and focus on learning in various settings, in and outside the classrooms. At TJIS, there is a strong belief that learning takes place best when the learner discovers facts and ideas rather than being taught. This being the information era, and the highway to a revolution of knowledge is self - learning. To this end a lot of emphasis is placed on enquiry training across all stages in the school as well as across the curriculum. Our evaluation system is also broad based. We understand that examinations are not the only way to assess a student. Formative assessment is the norm. Assignments, projects, worksheets, presentations, collaborative activities, unit tests and end of term exams are the tools through which the performance of a student is analyzed. What makes TJIS different from other schools is the courage to experiment and innovate.

Boarding & Day Boarding is a unique concept in School born of present day realities. In today's progressive societies, where both the parents are employed and often reach home only late in the evenings after a hard days grind, it is not possible for them to keep track of the work of their children.

The Jain International School, Bilaspur ensures that children take home the minimum load of work to enable the family to spend quality time together. This in turn will help parents bond more with their

children and feel energized to provide the necessary support their children require. This in turn will make learning a collaborative endeavor and the homework will reinforce learning besides providing pointers to the parents about the learning and teaching at the school.

Life Skill Education

We demonstrate our commitment to each student's social, physical and emotional growth through our Life Skills programme, an age-appropriate and developmentally focused sequence for Kindergarten classes through class 12. The Primary Kingdom nurtures the skills already developed in the nursery kingdom. The main focus at this level is to inculcate in students good study habits. The students are encouraged to learn through collaboration with the teachers acting as mere facilitators.

Secondary Kingdom

Young boys and girls emerge from The Jain International School as well-groomed, highly educated students who are more than ready to handle any challenge they may meet in college and beyond. They are curious, capable, and innovative thinkers who masterfully express their own ideas. They are ready to take up any challenge that higher education may offer.



Teaching Methodology

Teaching at TJIS, aims at concept and skill development rather than mere acquisition of knowledge. Our system makes the student central to the learning structure. They are supported by teachers and a strong peer group. Support from parents completes this idea. In this scheme of things, inquiry learning is the main goal where students discover concepts, explore concepts and apply them in the real world. This brings about collaboration between the teachers and students. Listening and presentation skills are developed among students to ensure holistic learning. Our methodologies include inspiring a competitive and challenging environment for youngsters, with a supportive base, to get rid of their pre-conceived notions of success and failure, to encourage the mastery of new skills and concepts so as to make learning more effective and to make learning value based, rather than text-book based.

Creativity is the corner stone of teaching at TJIS which ensures freedom to teachers and students to explore, experiment and innovate. Be it Science, Mathematics, Humanities or Languages, the spirit

of enquiry and zest for knowledge are evident from the way students deal with class room activities.

In an era of IT revolution, teaching cannot stay far behind. Teaching at TJIS is a fine blend of latest multimedia technology coupled with the quintessential creativity of the teachers. Every class room is equipped with facilities for computer connectivity and the use of OHPs is a regular feature here. Our class rooms are also, equipped with Educomp Smart classes. Each one of the teachers is skilled in the use of computers and latest electronic teaching aids. Web based assignments are part of regular academic activity.

Young Engineers Programme

Young Engineers Programme is an on and off campus programme that strengthens students' intellectual capabilities and develops real life skill applications. The programme includes participation in small groups, field visits, demonstrations, hands-on activities, design analysis and presentations.



Features of TJIS

Continuous comprehensive evaluation

This scheme is a comprehensive assessment that is continuous and recognizes and respects learning outcomes from all possible sources. This is based on the belief that learning takes place all the time, within and without the classroom. It recognizes an ability to regulate oneself, exhibiting creativity, courage to initiate and attempts to better a performance as at least as important as the content of the formal academics. Continuous comprehensive assessment caters to different learning styles and acknowledges different intelligence levels while aiming at assessing the holistic human individual. CCA aims at assessing the concept and content, attitude, skills, leadership and capacity to innovate. Such a comprehensive evaluation demands appropriate tools to assess, document and provide necessary evidence to show the growth of a student. Two important tools used are:

Grading system

The grading system followed till Class X, ensures that a conducive learning environment devoid of stressful competition is established to facilitate the learning at individual's pace. Assessment in Class XI & XII is focused on preparing the students to excel in the examinations conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and other competitive examinations conducted at the National level e.g. IIT-JEE, AIEEE, AIPMT, etc.

Assessment Criteria

It is a combination of formal testing and observation of all formal and informal engagements of children in and out of school. Different criteria are adopted in assessing children at different levels : classes 1 to 4 form level 1, 5 to 8 form level 2, 9 & 10 form level 3 and 11 & 12 form level 4 The formal assessment has certain mandatory items of assessment for children in level 2.

The School is just as good as the quality of teachers. TJIS boasts of the finest set of facilitators who would make learning a joy and not a burden to be grudgingly carried. Each one of them is hand picked for their versatility and commitment. They are highly qualified and thoroughly trained. The prestigious International Academy for Creative Teaching (IACT) at Bangalore provides regular training to our teachers. The special emphasis on their training has been in the area of creative teaching, mentoring and developing soft skills. Regular work shops ensure that the teachers always update their knowledge and skills in their subjects.

The Teaching Learning Committee

The teachers at TJIS are life long learners. They realize that knowledge is like an ocean and they know only a few drops of it. The Teaching Learning Committee of the school offers time bound

learning activities for teachers to help them in upgrading their skills and enhancing their know how in the subjects of their choice. Staff lectures are an occasion for sharing the stories of difficulty and success in their attempts at innovative practices. Each teacher identifies an area for continuous professional development.

Mentoring

Mentoring is an essential aspect of school life. Effective mentoring by the teachers is one of the finest ways of realizing the potential of a child. Every teacher in TJIS is trained in the art of Mentoring and Counseling. Mentors receive ongoing training in listening techniques, learn about important developmental issues for their mentees age group, and learn about group facilitation and crisis intervention. For every 10 to 12 students one teacher is designated as the mentor, who takes care of the physical, academic and psychological needs of his or her wards. Students have a new mentor each year, usually a faculty member who teaches at their level. Mentoring at TJIS combines structured group activities and one-on-one advising in the academic as well as in the social and emotional realm. The coordinators and school counselor oversee the mentoring program and serve as resources to the teachers and psychological needs of his or her wards. Students have a new mentor each year, usually a faculty member who teaches at their level. Mentoring at TJIS combines structured group activities and one-on-one advising in the academic as well as in the social and emotional realm.

Micro Teaching (MT) : A Unique Remedial Measure

Each child has a learning style of its own. All children do not learn at the same pace. For those who require additional support, we have remedial classes. Children are given additional inputs. Drilling of the concepts learnt is done wherever needed. The process of remedial teaching also includes Micro Teaching (MT) in which a group of 6 to 8 children is allotted to each teacher to guide them. Here intensive coaching is provided keeping the test/examination in mind. One to one interaction during M.T. results in reinforcing the concepts and practice in subject skills thereby enhancing the confidence of the students leading to improvement in their performance.

CCE

CBSE has Introduced the CCE Grading System In 2009-10 to reduce the unnecessary pressure on the board examinees & provide a holistic environment to learners in schools. At TJIS we have been the trail blazers, this grading system has been an integral part of our assessment since the inception of the school. A five point scale grading system ensures continuity in evaluation and assessment of broad based learning and behavioral outcomes. TJIS has been ahead of the time in popularizing these tools and techniques for evaluation like Interviews, Projects (group/individual), Quiz, Experiments, Research Work (group) apart from the traditional class work & homework.



Infrastructure

First we designed the curriculum, then we built the school.

So many schools do it the other way round! They construct an attractive building and find out too late that the rooms are too small or of the wrong shape. Cramped classrooms may be appropriate to old fashioned schools, where the students too frequently sit passively in rows and listen to lectures. Modern learning demands generous spaces in which furniture can be rearranged to reflect different methodologies: groups for project works, circles for discussions, and so on. The teacher has room to support, facilitate, stimulate and direct. TJIS, Bilaspur campus has an optimum space for student - centered learning.

Facilities are also purpose - designed for the curriculum.

Language Lab and Language Development Programme - English is a window to the outside world. To make the students gain expertise in both written and spoken English, TJIS has developed a state-of-the-art language laboratory where children use the modern techniques and Lingua phone equipments to sharpen their language skills.

English is used as a language of communication. We understand that English occupies a position of prime importance in today's world. The students at The Jain international School are trained to become fluent in spoken and written English.

The students are provided multi-cuisine meals, which consists of Continental, Chinese, Oriental & Indian delicacies. The kitchen is extensively spread-out with separate arrangements for preparation of all kind of vegetarian meals, a tandoor section, cold storage, and other well-defined areas equipped with modern equipment.

The catering staff are experts from a hotel management background and the Manager- Food & Beverage is from a reputed five star hotel of the country. Hence the children are made aware of the different types of food, its accompaniments and table manners. Each student is given personal attention. The meals are nutritionally planned by dieticians so that the children have a well balanced nutritious diet.

BOYS HOSTEL - Home away from Home

Each of the multistoried International Boarding Houses accommodates Boys from Class IV onwards and can hold 60 students, on each floor. They are designed as homes, not hostels. Each storey has its own comfortably furnished common rooms with entertainment facilities and ample space for socializing. There are no old fashioned dormitories. Each fully air conditioned study bedroom is occupied by four students. Both the bedrooms and common rooms can be personalized with favourite material by the students. The International Boarding House is supervised by an experienced Warden and residential Senior teachers. All students, whether boarders or day boarders belong to a small Mentor Group led by a Faculty Mentor who has responsibility for their personal welfare and academic progress. The professional counsellor complete the pastoral team.

Religious Life

Though The Jain International School, Bilaspur is a nonsectarian school we regard each student's spiritual growth as being of equal importance with his intellectual, emotional, physical and social development. Each individual has the freedom to practice his religion within the framework of understanding, respect and tolerance for the beliefs of others.

Facilities

Medical Care

Prompt medical facility is a very important aspect of the boarding life that cannot be overlooked. TJIS gives priority to the medical care with modern amenities, providing round the clock medical attention. A panel of qualified and experienced doctors conducts medical checkups. Apart from this, TJIS has tie-ups with the Apollo Group of Hospitals and other local speciality hospitals to provide immediate medical attention whenever required. The school Doctor is a well-known pediatrician of the town who visits the school every day from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm.

Laundry Services

Students' clothes are steam-washed, dried and pressed in a sanitary environment using the latest state-of-the-art automated washing machines.

Water Purifier

Water supplied at TJIS is highly safe and free from bacterial contamination. Water is drawn from the school bore wells and passes through a purifier and softener and again back to the purifier before finally being kept in a cooler for drinking or used in the kitchen for cooking purposes.

Security and Safety

As critical as any other aspect of life on the campus, is the safety and security of the children. Professionally trained security personnels watch over the totally fenced campus round-the-clock with dogs on guard as well. At no point in time are visitors allowed into the campus without prior appointment and proper identification. The security personnel maintains a continuous vigil on the movement of visitors and materials in and out of all installations and buildings with special attention on vital areas like the student homes and academic blocks where the dog squad is on patrol to augment the security force.

Uninterrupted Power Supply

Power supply from the government-owned Chhattisgarh State Electricity Board (CSEB) is backed up by modern diesel generator sets within the school campus.

The use of plastic carry bags and other non-biodegradable materials is discouraged in the campus. The school is in the process of installing an in house effluent treatment plant for wastes which will then be recycled for use in the school gardens.

About Bilaspur

Bilaspur city is approximately 400 years old and the name "Bilaspur" originated from the Fisher-woman named "Bilasa". Over the years Bilaspur has developed a lot, despite several natural calamities.

Bilaspur district is located in eastern part of Chhattisgarh and lies within 21'47" to 23'8" E/W (latitude) and between 81'14" to 83'15" N/S (longitude). Bilaspur district is surrounded by Koriya district in the North, Shahdol district of Madhya Pradesh in the South, Raipur district in the East and Korba, Janjgir-Champa districts in the West. The total area of Bilaspur is approximately 6,377 Sq Km, after the bifurcation of old Bilaspur district in three districts (New Bilaspur, Korba and Janjgir-Champa District).

Bilaspur is the second biggest city of the region and a fast developing important industrial centre. The city lies on the Mumbai - Nagpur Howrah mainline, and is well connected by air (Raipur Airport), rail and road. It is a good base to visit the tourist centers of the region.

Admission Procedure

TJIS welcomes enquiry from the parents (s) and guardian (s) from the month of December/January every year and admissions are granted for different classes subject to availability of seats.

A certain level of academic achievement is expected for admission to the school so that the child can cope up with and enjoy his/her stay at this International School.
