High School Preparation: Applicants are expected to have completed the college preparatory courses outlined below or complete the requirements during the first 30 semester hours of study at USU.

Admissions Standard: To be admitted in good standing, applicants are expected to have graduated from a regionally accredited high school with a minimum 2.5 GPA, a minimum ACT score of 17, and a minimum 90 Admissions Index score. All three requirements must be met. For more information on the Admissions Index, go to www.usu.edu/admissions. Applicants whose scores do not meet the standard will be considered on an individual basis. Applicants who have not graduated from high school may apply with a GED. A minimum total GED of 656 is required (550 Battery Average required prior to 2014).
