QUALIFICATION:**1. ASSISTANT PROFESSOR:**

- i) Good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% of the marks or equivalent grade where grading system is practiced at the master's degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii) Holders of Ph.D. degree as on the date of Notification of UGC Regulations, alongwith those candidates who are awarded a Ph.D. degree through a process of admission, test registration, course work and external evaluation as laid down in the UGC (Minimum standards and procedures for award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Regulations, 2009 and so adopted by the University, shall be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.
- iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted subject to the conditions stipulated above.

2. ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR:

- i) Good academic record with a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and /or research in a academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University/ College or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications in the form of book and/or research/policy papers.

- iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology - mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- v) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in this Regulation in Tables to IX of Appendix III

3. PROFESSOR

- i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. (through course work) qualification in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers in indexed/ISBN/ISSN numbered journals and / or ISBN/ISSN numbered books and the University developed ISBN/ISSN numbered list of journals/books hosted in the website of the concerned University.
- ii) A minimum of 10 years of teaching experience in University/college, and / or experience in research at the University/national Level Institutions/ Industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology mediated teaching learning process.
- iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) developed by UGC in its Regulations.

OR

An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field who has made significant contribution to knowledge.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The candidates appointed shall be on tenure basis that is upto end of XI plan (upto 31.03.2012 from the date of appointment).
2. The candidates appointed shall be purely on temporary basis and terminated at any time without giving any notice, if his/her services are found to be not satisfactory. However their service shall cease to exist at the end of XI plan i.e. 31.3.2012.
3. The candidates appointed shall not have any rights over the post.
4. The candidates appointed shall not be eligible for any pensionary benefits and other benefits available to permanent staff.

APPLICATION FORM

1. The prescribed application form with copy of notification can be obtained from the undersigned on production of Bank Challan of Rs. 500/- (Rs. 250/- for SC/ST) in token of having paid the same in the University Branch of State Bank of Hyderabad, or Demand Draft. The SC/ST candidates need to produce Caste Certificate while obtaining application form. In addition to the application fee, a processing fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rs. 500/- for SC/ST candidates) needs to be paid in

- the form of Demand Draft/Bank Challan and the Demand Draft/Bank Challan therefor needs to be enclosed to the application while submitting application to the University. Out-Station candidates desirous of obtaining application forms by post should send a requisition with a DD for like amount drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, Gulbarga University, Gulbarga and payable at Gulbarga with a self addressed cover measuring 6" X 12" duly affixing postal stamp of Rs. 30/- Out-Station SC/ST candidates need to send Xerox Copy of Caste Certificate with the requisition in addition to DD for the purpose.
2. Candidates claiming benefit of reservation are required to produce caste certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the jurisdiction and it should not have been issued prior to one year as on the last date fixed for the receipt of applications. As prescribed in Government Order No. SWD 251 BCA 94 dated 31st January 1996, the candidates belonging to SC/ST, category I, IIA, IIB, IIIA and IIIB are required to produce the copy of declaration certificate in the prescribed form for employment purpose issued by the Competent Authority who are empowered to issue such certificates and the copy of School Leaving Certificate along with their application. They are required to produce caste certificate issued by the jurisdiction Tahsildar/Assistant Commissioner where the applicant is ordinarily resident.
 3. Others need not apply for the posts which are clearly earmarked in this notification as reserved for SC/ST.
 4. Applicants should be not below 18 years and should not have attained 62 year of age.
 5. Applicants when called for interview, if any, are required to attend the same at their cost.
 6. The selected candidates are liable for transfer to University's Post Graduate Centres.
 7. Canvassing in any manner will be a disqualification.

5. LAST DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications completed in all respects with the attested copies of Marks Cards, Certificates, Testimonials and Publications etc., should be submitted to the undersigned on or before 18.07.2011.
