## **FOREWORD**

Let me take this opportunity to accord a warm welcome to Vidyasagar University. A young but promising and flourishing University, it was created as a state University in 1981, whose Post-Graduate departments started functioning from the session 1986-87. Starting with six Post-Graduate departments, the University now conducts studies in twenty six Post-Graduate departments, many of which are situated in the frontier and interdisciplinary areas of science and social science subjects. The University is proud of its highly qualified and dedicated faculty members, motivated students and research scholars and adequately equipped supporting and administrative staff, capable of assimilating the forces of modernization and globalization in the field of higher education.

Named after the legendary 19th century pioneering social reformer, social activist, litterateur, dedicated to the cause of the upliftment of women, Pandit Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar, Vidyasagar University, since its inception, has committed itself to the goal of teaching and learning in the higher education, ensuring quality education and providing research and extra-curricular activities in the best possible manner in order to spread the benefit of higher education in a location which is relatively backward but which has a glorious history of playing a pioneering role in the freedom struggle of India. The number of affiliated colleges is 47 and the subjects offered in the undergraduate colleges cover the traditional subjects as well as modern emerging ones. A few professional colleges providing management and social work education are also within the fold of this university.

Situated on the fringes of the historic city of Midnapore, the University, has a beautiful sprawling and eco-friendly plastic-free campus which houses administrative departments, Post-Graduate departments for teaching learning and research, the centre for distance education, the expanding hostel building for both male and female students, the residential accommodation for both teaching and administrative staff, the play ground, the student amenity centre, the extension centers. Much of these extension and developmental activities have taken place within the last decades of its existence in response to increasing demands of higher education in the locality.

This Postgraduate Prospectus provides you with useful information about Vidyasagar University's background, admission requirements, structure of its academic

programmes and general information on the services and facilities available in this University. ## **Post-Graduate and other Courses**

Vidyasagar University started its academic activities during 7<sup>th</sup> plan period(1985) from the session 1985-1986 following an Act of the State Assembly to cater to the needs of higher education with special emphasis on the all-round development of the rural areas of the agro-based districts of Midnapore. The geographical area covered by this University is quite under-developed and that demands special attention on human resource development to improve socio-economic condition of the people of this region and so course have been designed so as to be helpful for achieving this goal.

The University started with six Post-Graduate Departments under Arts & Commerce and Science Faculty for the session 1985-1986 and in each designed course special stress was given on regional needs. Subsequently in 1989 & 1990, nine more PG. Course were added and here also special attention and weightage were duly given to the need of the locality and so various environmental requirements like Forestry, Fisheries, Health and Nutritional needs of the people and the technological requirements for industrial developments of the region were largely incorporated in the syllabi. In addition to fifteen PG Courses, Masters degree in Geography in 1995, M.C.A. in 1998, Microbiology and Electronics in 2001, PGLDT (late MLT, now Bio-Medical Laboratory Science & Management) and Masters degree in Computer Science in 2002, Remote Sensing & GIS and Aquaculture Management & Technology (new named as Fisheries Science in 2014) in 2003 have been started. From 2005, Masters degree in Sanskrit, Sociology and Bio-Medical Laboratory Science & Management (a UGC innovative Programme) have been started. From 2006-2007, two-year M.B.A. Course has been started. All the above courses are running in Vidyasagar University Campus.

Post-Graduate Courses in Computer Science, Physics and Zoology were introduced at Panskura Banamali College, Midnapore College and Raja N.L. Khan Women's College respectively from the session 2004-05. Also M.A in Bengali at Khargapur College and M.Sc in Chemistry at Jhargram Raj College are running from the session 2005-2006. From the session 2006-2007 M.A. in Bengali at Tamralipta Mahavidyalaya, M.A. in Sanskrit Rabindra Satabarshiki Mahavidyalaya, Ghatal, M.Sc in Bio-Chemistry, M.Sc in Bio-Technology and M.Sc in Nutrition & Dietetics have been introduced off campus under VU. From the session 2006-2007, one-year PG. Diploma Course in Mass Communication & Videography was running(in campus)in collaboration with Ritwick Academy. From the session 2008-2009 it is running in collaboration with Kalyani Foundation for Media Science and Community Research. M.S.W Course and 1-year Diploma Course in Psychological Counselling are running at Vidyasagar School of Social Work, DD/18/4/1, Salt Lake City, Kolkata-700 064. from the academic year 1994-1995 and 2005-2006 respectively. 1-year Diploma Course in Office Automation and Internet Technologies has been started from the session 2008-09. M.S.W. course is also running at AMIK Institute of Management Science and Technology. 3&4 Kabiguru Sarani, City Centre, Durgapur. One year PG. Diploma Course in Applied Computer Science, Diploma Course in Advance Hardware and Networking Administration (6 months) and Certificate Course in Basic and Advanced Java (3 months) are running in V.U. in collaboration with CMC. One year Diploma Course in Office Automation and Internet Technologies is running in the University. M.A. in Santali and M.Sc in Nutrition & Dietetics have been started from the session 2009-2010 & 2010-11 respectively in the university. M.A in Hindi has been started from the session 2011-12. M.Sc in Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics and PG Diploma in Quality Control and Assurance in Microbial Technology have been started

from the session 2012-13. M.A. in Bengali in Midnapore College, Panskura Banamali College, Prabhat Kumar College, Vivekananda Mission Mahavidyalaya, Belda College and Egra Sarada Sashi Bhushan College, M.A. in English in Prabhat Kumar College, Belda College, M.A. in History in Panskura Banamali College, Tamralipta Mahavidyalaya, M.A. in Philosophy in Vivekananda Mission Mahavidyalaya, M.Sc. in Applied Mathematics in Midnapore College, Panskura Banamali College, M.Sc. in Chemistry in Mahishadal Raj College, Tamralipta Mahavidyalaya, M.Sc. in Zoology in Midnapore College, Tamralipta Mahavidyalaya, M.Sc. in Physics in Panskura Banamali College, M.A. / M.Sc. in Geography in Panskura Banamali College, M.A. in Sanskrit in Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya, M.A. in Education in Sevayatan Sikshan Mahavidyalaya have been started from the academic session 2013-2014. After successful submission of the form, applicant should send printed version of the application form, self attested photocopy of all testimonials and copy of Bank Challan (University copy) of Rs.100/- to the Office of the Secretary, Faculty Councils for PG Studies on or before the last date of submission(as mentioned in the Admission Notification) by post, courier or by hand. The amount of Rs.100/- may be deposited in any branch of UCO Bank through Challan (available in university website)

Filled in downloaded version of the application form should be submitted to the Office of the Secretary, Faculty Councils for PG Studies, Vidyasagar University along with the self attested photocopy of all testimonials and on or before the last date of submission(as mentioned in the Admission Notification) by **hand only**. The amount of Rs.100/- may be deposited in any branch of UCO Bank through Challan (available in university website)

- c. Self attested photo copy of SC/ ST/ Persons with Disability(PWD) certificate issued by the appropriate authority, if claimed quota.

- h. All candidates are required to produce all original Certificates, Mark Sheet and Registration Certificate for verification at the time of Counselling and admission. Candidate is to be present himself/ herself for proper verification of the photograph affixed with the application form.

***SELECTION PROCESS FOR ADMISSION***

***For the Students of V.U.***

- (a) As per the order No. 199(16) – Edn(U)/1U-83/12 dt. 17<sup>th</sup> February,2014 issued by the Department of Higher Education(University Branch), Govt. of West Bengal 60% of total seats in each department will be reserved for the students of V.U. and 40% seats will be available for Open Competition.
- (b) Selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit. Marks obtained in Honours will be the sole criteria. Honours candidates of the current session and the immediately preceding session will be considered equally. In the case of equal marks in Honours, total marks / percentage of marks of immediately preceding Examination are to be taken into account for ranking.
- (c) Quota for SC/ ST will be considered as per Govt. order 906 Edn / Estt dated 18.09.1997. Number of seats(SC-22% , ST-6%) will be calculated and considered separately for 60% seats of V.U. students and 40% seats for Open Competition. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to

the next whole number. In case of non-availability of students of SC / ST category, the seats reserved for SC / ST will be converted to General Category.

- (d) 3% of each category will be reserved for Persons with Disability(PWD) candidates. Merit list will be prepared on the percentage of PWD. In case of non-availability of PWD candidate, the seat reserved for PWD will be converted to General Category.
- (e) ) Prize holders at International/National/State representation in the last two years will be considered for sports quota provided that he/she participated in the Inter College Competition/ Inter College Athletic Meet organized by our university in his/her tenure in UG level. The sports events are Football, Volleyball, Athletic , Joga, Khoko, Kabadi, Chess, Table Tennis. A committee formed by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor will assess the performance of the applicants in the respective field.
- (f) 1% seats is reserved for the students of Vidyasagar University against Sports / cultural quota.
- (g) Prize holders in the International/National/State meet in the last two years will be considered for Cultural quota provided that he/she participated in the Inter College Cultural Competition organized by our university in his/her tenure in UG level. A committee formed by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor will assess the performance of the applicants in the respective field.
- (h) Normally 60% seats will be for the students of the Vidyasagar University and 40% seats for other Open Competition. This 60% and 40% may be relaxed in case of non-availability of the applicants in either category.

*For the Students of other universities*

- i. 40% Seats in each department will be for Open Competition.
- ii. The students of other universities will have to appear at Entrance Test. The minimum marks for appearing at Entrance Test is as follows:

- v. Questions will be set in English, except in Bengali, Hindi, Sanskrit and Santali

### ***Department of Business Administration***

Having realized the growing need for management experts, Vidyasagar University decided to launch its regular UGC approved MBA course in the year 2006 for initial nourishment with the cooperation from all other allied departments especially the Department of Commerce with Farm Management.

An ultra-modern course curriculum has been designed incorporating mainstream management courses and also including some aspects of public administration. That way it honours the recommendation of the NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) Peer Team on one hand and on the other pays due regard to the inherent nontraditional character of the University.

Having had success, in 2012, the University made a separate department called “The Department of Business Administration”. The department at present offers two-year full time UGC and AICTE approved MBA in Human Resource Management, Marketing, and Finance. It has also the vision of introducing other specializations such as Operations and Systems, Hospitality, Retail

and Supply Chain, Logistics, Pharmaceutical, etc. It also has a dream of offering executive MBA for the working professionals. The department has been successfully offering Ph. D. programmes in management and other allied areas and it continues to attract researchers of excellent calibre.

The department has faculties of academic and professional eminence. The faculty members author various books, produce academic papers, and write an array of articles for general business publications. Apart from the in-house faculties, sincere attempts are made to invite guest faculties from management and allied departments of other reputed universities and institutes to provide desired blend of input to the students. Students of the Department are getting placed in MNCs like Dr Reddy's Lab., Selvel, ICICI, Tata Steel, etc.

At present, the department intakes 60 students from various streams through CAT, CMAT, JEMAT, MAT, VUMAT and other recognized management aptitude tests. They are offered innovative yet globally accepted programs for their all round development. It encourages its students to be innovative so that they can start their own ventures. The department also conducts national and international seminars to provide forum for the exchange of ideas, knowledge and industry representatives in order to understand the advancement of management thoughts and practices.

The department is ambitious that over time it would be able to make tie-ups with reputed business schools abroad to have international exposure and global marketing of our academic products.

### ***National Service Scheme***

The National Service Scheme was stated to establish a meaningful linkage between the campus and the community. Mahatma Gandhi, the Father of the Nation, had recognized that the country could not progress in a desired direction until the student youth were motivated to work for the upliftment of the villages/community. For Gandhiji the villages, where majority of the population lived, represent the country i.e. India. Therefore, for the national reconstruction and national resurgence it was deemed fit that the students and teachers should be properly sensitized and utilized for strengthening the Indian society as a whole with particular emphasis on rural community. Therefore, student youth, teachers and the community are considered the three basic components of the National Service Scheme.

## ***OBJECTIVES***

The broad objectives of NSS are to:

- i. Understand the community in which they work;
- ii. Understand themselves in relation to their community;
- iii. Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving process;
- iv. Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility;
- v. Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solution to individual and community problems;
- vi. Develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities;
- vii. Gain skills in mobilizing community participation;
- viii. Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitude;
- ix. Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters and
- x. Practice national integration and social harmony.

## ***THE MOTTO***

The motto or watchword of the National Service Scheme is 'NOT ME BUT YOU'. This reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service and appreciation of the other person's point of view and also to show consideration for fellow human beings. It underlines that the welfare of an individual is ultimately dependent on the welfare of society on the whole. Therefore, it should be the aim of the NSS to demonstrate this motto in its day-to-day programme.

## ***Placement Activity***

Under the guidance of Dean of Students' Welfare, the placement cell consisting of different placement coordinators of respective departments invites various organizations to conduct campus recruitment for the interested students of VU. This cell facilitates all the interested students of VU to get employment through on campus or off campus. A partial list of the organizations who recruited our students are: Wipro, TCS, Pradan, Reliance, HDFC Bank, Limtex Co.Ltd., ICICI Bank, Allahabad Bank, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Kotak Finance, Metro Dairy, American Express, Limitex Infotech, IMOS Technologis Pvt. Ltd., Infoway IT Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Tata Consultancy Service(TCS), ISIS Design Service etc., SELVEL, Haldia Petro Chemicals, Future Group, Deson Steel, etc.

## ***Hostel Accommodation***

There are four hostels- two for girls and two for boys, in the University Campus. Total 609 students (307 in Girls' Hostel and 302 in Boys' Hostel) can be accommodated in these hostels. Hostel accommodation is provided to the selected students based on the distance between their place of residence and Vidyasagar University, parents' income and past academic results. Soon after the admission, interested bona-fide students of the University may submit their applications to the Dean of Students' Welfare, for the accommodation in hostels. The prescribed fees to be

deposited in the cash counter, by the shortlisted candidates after announcement of final list of the selected candidates.

### ***General Insurance***

To compensate the damage occurs from unforeseen events during study, the University is extending general insurance policy offered by one of the Govt. Insurance Agencies. To avail this facility the bona-fide students are to submit separate application forms to the Dean of Students' Welfare. The selected students will have to pay Rs. 299/ per annum and rest of the amount will be borne by the University.

### ***Multi-gym Facility***

To keep the students physically and mentally fit, the University is extending Multigym facility separately for boys and girls on payment basis. These two Multi-gyms are kept opened four hours in the morning and four hours in the evening. Interested bona-fide students can submit separate application to the Dean of Students' Welfare/ Sports Officer.

## **Certificate Course in Communicative English**

The Department of English offers a short-term course in Communicative English. The students from all the departments of our university are eligible to attend the course, subject to the availability of seats. Faculty members of the Department of English along with external skilled resource persons conduct interactive sessions with the students in the Language Laboratory. The course is designed to develop the writing, oral and aural skills of the participants.

## **Certificate Course in Human Rights**

An UGC sponsored Certificate Course in Human Rights of six months duration is being conducted in the Department of Political Science with Rural Administration since the academic session 2012-2013. 40 (forty) Post-graduate students of the department of Political Science with Rural Administration are enrolled in the course. Besides the Certificate Course, there are various topics on Human Rights in Indian Politics, International Relations, Public Governance in the syllabus of regular post-graduate course in Political Science. Seminars, Conferences are organized regularly for the benefit of the students.

## ***M.Phil Programme in Political Science***

M.Phil Programme (Regular Course) is conducted in the Department of Political Science with Rural Administration.

1. Total No. of seats – 15. Out of the total seats available in the department, 80 percent seats are reserved for the students of this university and the remaining seats for those of other universities.

Provided that the students of Vidyasagar University shall be admitted in case of non-availability of eligible students from other universities.

2. Seats are reserved for SC, ST & PH candidates as per norms. However, students from general category may be admitted if eligible candidates are not available from reserved category.

3. Admission will be made on the basis of the results of the admission test, which shall be conducted by the department. Students not obtaining 55% marks (for General students) and 50% (for SC/ST/PH candidates) at the concerned PG examination shall not be considered for admission test. The admission test shall be of 50 marks. The candidates obtaining fifty percent marks at the written test shall be qualified. The qualified candidates have to appear for the interview to be conducted by the M.Phil committee. The interview shall be held for 25 marks and the merit list shall be prepared taking into consideration only the scores at the interview.

Candidates qualified at the NET/GATE/SET/UGC (JRF)/CSIR (JRF) or any other examination that is considered equivalent by the BRS shall also be exempted from appearing at the Written Admission test and will have to appear at the interview only.

4. The programme shall be of two years' duration. First year (comprising First and Second Semesters) will be devoted to course work and related activities and after the completion of each semester there shall be an examination. Second year will be entirely devoted to dissertation work.

5. The students appearing at the final semester examination of post graduate course shall be eligible to sit for entrance examination

6. Total marks in M.Phil Programme is 500 marks .The division of marks will be as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> year: 1<sup>st</sup> semester: 200 marks      2<sup>nd</sup> semester: 200 marks  
2<sup>nd</sup> year: Dissertation: 100marks

## ***Women's Studies Centre***

### ***OBJECTIVES***

- ❖ Different members of Women's Studies Centre, VU have guided many **Dissertation Projects** gender-related issues facing society today.

### ***ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION***

(i) Counselling and admission will be held on the same day. On the date of Counselling the students /Parents/Guardians have to produce the original Certificates/testimonials for verification. Date, time, venue will be notified at the bottom of the Merit Lists.(ii) After the admission, the vacancy, if any, will be filled up from the Merit List through counselling. Date, time and venue will be notified later on the Notice Board. (iii) Admission to PG and other courses will be closed on the 15<sup>th</sup> effective teaching day with effect from the date

of commencement of classes. (iv) If any student remains absent from the classes for 10 (ten) consecutive teaching days without valid reasons and without prior intimation to the respective Head of the Department or the Secretary, Faculty Councils for PG. Studies, his/her admission will be treated as cancelled and the vacancy will be filled up from the Merit Listed candidates on merit. From the date of commencement of classes absence is counted.(v) The admitted students are to attend at least 75% of the total classes held in all Semesters; otherwise, he/she will not be allowed to fill up his/her form for examination.(vi) Applicants are to follow the notices all the time. No intimation of any kind will be sent to the individual at any stage.(vii) Hostel Accommodation : There are four Hostels – two for Boys and two for Girls- in the University campus. Boys' Hostel and Girls' Hostels accommodate 302 students and 307 students respectively. Hostel accommodation is provided to the selected students depending on the distance between their place of residence and Vidyasagar University. Preference is given to the students coming from other State or remote places .Admitted students soon after admission may apply to the Dean, Students' Welfare for the accommodation of Hostel.(viii) The student will not indulge in any act ragging. If he/she is found guilty of any aspect of ragging, he/she will be punished as per provisions of the UGC regulations and/or as per law in force.
