CIRCULAR

All General Degree Colleges affiliated to the University of Gour Banga, Malda are requested to follow the guideline(s) as hereunder for **Online Admission Procedure** at UG Level of course of studies in different colleges under UGB in the 1st Year/1st Semester for Academic Session 2015-2016.

1. Schedule of Online Admission Procedure:

- Date of Issue of Online Form: 10.06.2015.
- Closing Date for Online Form Fill Up: 20.06.2015 (Midnight)
- Last Date of Submission of Fee(s) through Bank Challan : 24.06.2015
- Publication of Merit List (Hons. and/or General Course) : 26.06.2015
- Closing Date of the entire Online Admission Procedure : 25.07.2015

- The last date of submission of filled in Registration Form for the Academic Session 2015-2016 **shall be intimated later on.**
- Eligibility Criteria of admission for the Academic Session 2015-2016 for various U.G. courses of studies will be at par with the norms followed in Academic Session 2014-2015.
- Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the General Courses will be prepared on the basis of Grand Total of best five subjects including English but excluding Environmental Studies.
- Candidates qualifying in (10+2) Exam. with English as a Subject of the West Bengal State Council for Vocational Education & Training shall have to comply with Sl. No.: 6 and are eligible to get admission to B.A. and B.Com. General Course only.
- Only the State Level and National Level Boards in regular mode will be allowed to take admission in Hons. / General Course.
- The selection criteria and merit will be prepared as per the provisions of the University. The Merit Point Calculation will be done as follows:

a) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the Honours Courses will be prepared as:

Subject (opted for Honours) + Grand Total (as in clause 6 of this circular)

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b) In case any candidate opts for an Honours beyond his subject combination (Except linguistic subjects) at H.S. (10+2) Level, the merit lists for the Honours Courses will be prepared as:

0 (Zero) + Grand Total (as in clause 6 of this circular)

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- Only the state level Board in regular mode will be allowed to take admission in Hons. / General Course.
- 5% and 10% merit point will be deducted from total merit points credited to the students who have passed 12th Standard in 2014 and 2013 respectively.
- Registration Fee: Without Late Fine – RS. 200.00 (Rupees Two Hundred) and with Late Fine – RS. 300.00 (Rupees Three Hundred) and Sports Fee will be Rs. 20.00 (Rupees Twenty) and out of which 50% i.e. RS. 10.00 (Rupees Ten) per student to be deposited to the University as Sports Fees.
- In case of doubts / confusions in preparing the Merit Lists or in any other respect whatsoever, clarification may be obtained from the University.
- You are requested to maintain compulsorily their existing intake capacity as approved by the University. You are also requested to maintain compulsorily their existing intake capacity as approved by the University. The intake capacity will be in compliance with the additional Seats for OBC Category as specified by the Govt. of West Bengal.

CIRCULAR

Subject: Implementation of the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act, 2013 and the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Rules, 2014

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act, 2013, all the State Higher Educational Institutions coming under the purview of the aforesaid Act and the Rules are hereby advised that they shall continue to take steps in implementing the provisions of the Act and the Rules so that reservation of seats in all categories is continued for the academic session 2015-16 as specified in the Act and the Rules, i.e. ^① by increasing the number of seats, within the available infrastructure, and ^② without curtailing the number of un-reserved seats of the institution.

During allocation of seats to each reserved category as defined under the Act, it shall be kept in mind by every institution that the percentage of reservation applicable to each reserved category (SC-22%, ST-6%) under the Act, shall be in commensurate with the total number of seats being increased in each course/faculty. For OBC-A (10%) and OBC-B (7%) seats, implementation will be done over a six year period and the exercise has already commenced from the Academic year 2014-15. All institutions are accordingly advised to continue to increase seats in each subject/ Department/ Course/ Stream suitably, and to the extent practicable, so that the required increase of overall 17 % seats can be achieved within the Academic Year 2020-21. New State-aided institutions being set up shall endeavour to achieve the specified reservation of seats for SCs (22%), ST s (6%) and OBC s (10%+7%) at one go and not incrementally. All institutions shall take caution, while de-reserving the reserved category seats in the event of non availability of respective reserved category candidates, as per the due process prescribed in the Rules, and under guidance of respective Reservation Commissioners. All other instructions, given previously in this regard, shall be complied with *mutatis mutandis*.
