Examination of the year and who offers the Science Group of subject at the examination. The scholar shall prosecute a course of Studies for the B.Sc. Examination in a college connected with Nagpur University and shall select Mathematics as one of his subjects for the Examination. The scholarship shall be tenable for a period of two years.

30. **RADHABAI PAONASKAR SCHOLARSHIP AND MEDALS FUND. :-** One Scholarship, of Rs. 800/- p. m. one Gold and two Silver Medals. **Eligibility** : A Scholarship of the value of Rs.800/- per month shall be awarded to the student who secures highest number of marks among the successful female candidate at the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (XII Standard) of the Maharashtra board of Secondary Education (Vidarbha Division). The recipient shall be called the Radhabai Paonaskar Scholar.

7. i) **The holder of the “studentship” shall forthwith refund to the University all money received by him/her in respect of studentship in cases of his/her discontinuing the research work before the completion of the prescribed period of two years without the approval in writing of the University.**
8. ii) **The Academic Council may terminate the tenure of the Studentship at any time on ground of unsatisfactory work for conduct.**
9. **All matters not otherwise provided for in this Scholarship shall be determined by he Academic Council and its decision shall be final.**

- I) The endowment shall be called the “Morris Memorial Fellowship Fund”.
- II) The Executive Council of Nagpur University shall be the body acting in the Administration of the said fund
- III)** III] The net income accruing from the fund shall be applied in accordance with the provisions to the award of a fellowship and Post-graduate scholarship to be called
- IV)** the “Morris Memorial Fellowship” and the “Morris Memorial Postgraduate Scholarship.”

V) A. Morris Memorial Fellowship

1. The Fellowship shall be of the value of Rs. 350/- per mensem payable quarterly in arrears and it shall be awarded every year or at longer intervals accordingly as may be decided by Academic Council. It shall be awarded by the Academic Council with the approval of the State Government for a period of two years in the first instance, but it shall be within its dissertations. With like approval, to extend the tenure thereafter for a further period of one years.
2. The Fellowship shall be open to bonafide residents of Vidharba who have received the whole of their University education in one of the College maintained by or admitted to the privileges of the University and except in special cases to the determined
3. by the Academic Council of Nagpur University, with the approval of the State Government it shall be awarded only two Candidates who have Passed in the First division the Examination for the degree of M.A or M. Sc. part I and II together of Nagpur University.
4. The condition of tenure are :- (a) that the fellowship follow on trade or profession, nor prosecute any their study than that of his special subject, (b) that at end of each six months during which he holds the Fellowship he shall submit to the Academic Council of Nagpur University through the Principal of the College to which he is attached a report of the work done by him in his study or research during that period.
5. A candidate shall forward his application for the fellowship to the Academic Council of Nagpur University together with a full a statement of the line of study or research he intends to fellow. The Academic Council of Nagpur University, with the approval of the State Government. Shall select the fellow from among the applicants after consideration of the individual qualification for the particular line of study or research and the facilities for prosecuting the same that can be made available.
6. The fellowship selected shall prosecute his study or research at one of the Colleges in Vidarbha approved by the Academic Council of Nagpur University and shall be given every reasonable facility, help and guidance by the Principal and staff of a College. In return his service shall be at the disposal of the College for tutorial work, provided that the subject in which the work is preformed and the time occupied in it are approved by the Academic council of Nagpur University.

B. The Morris Memorial Post-Graduate Scholarshi

1. The Scholarship shall be for the value of Rs. 300/- per mensem, paid every month in arrears and it shall be awarded every year or at longer intervals according as any be decided by the Academic Council.

The Scholarship shall be open to confide residents of Vidarbha who have received the whole their University education, in one of colleges maintained by or admitted to the privileges of the University and shall be awarded only to graduates who have attained the degree of B.A. or B. Candidates for the Scholarship shall forward their application to the Academic Council of Nagpur University through the Principal of the college in which they are studying stating the course of study which they intend to pursue. The Academic Council of Nagpur University with the approval of State Government shall selected the scholarship holder from among the applicants after consideration of their individual qualifications.
5. It shall be within the power of the Academic Council of Nagpur University of Nagpur University with the approval of the State Government at any time to withdraw the fellowship or Scholarship if it has reason tonbe dissatisfied with the conduct or work of the fellow or scholar.
6. All matters no otherwise provided for in this scheduled shall be determined ` by the Academic Council of Nagpur University with the approval of the State Government and its decision 4 thereon shall be final.
