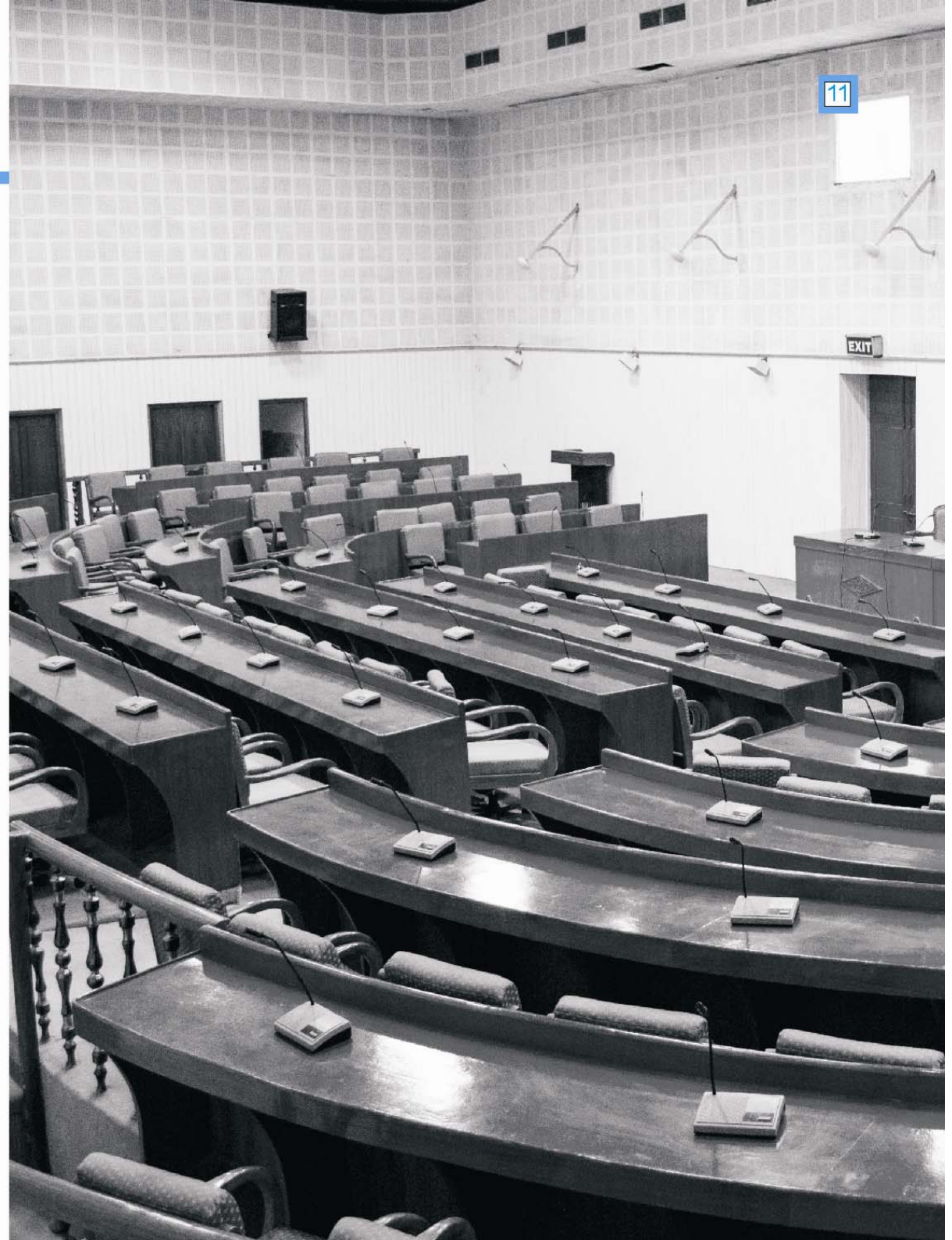

Life and Culture

The Institute Sports Council of IIT Roorkee boasts to provide one of the best facilities for sports and recreation in the country. The institute has professional coaches to teach the students about the intricacies of each sport. There is no doubt, IIT Roorkee outperforms other IITs at the Inter-IIT Sports Meet and has been the women's champion for the past 4 years.

The Student Affairs Council (SAC) is the chief student governing body responsible for taking care of the students' interests and making new policies and changing the existing ones depending on the changing needs of the students. Every academic year a new SAC is chosen through student elections.

All this haven't begun to cover even half of the activities that go on at Roorkee. The institute also has EDC-the Entrepreneurship Development Cell, HEC-The Himalayan Explorer's Club, BAJA SAE, Formula SAE, IMG- Information Management Group, GIL- Group for Interactive Learning etc.

Institute Festivals

Student festivals are times which are awaited with much zeal and enthusiasm among the student body at any college. IIT Roorkee also hosts two such student festivals, Cognizance and Thomso.

Thomso

Thomso, the cultural festival is the soul of campus culture at IIT Roorkee which bursts alive during the 3-day extravaganza in the month of October. At its core, Thomso embodies the spirit of life and gaiety. Recognising this event of gargantuan proportions, the Government of Uttarakhand proclaimed Thomso as the "Annual Youth Festival of Uttarakhand". The fest plays host to the most strikingly talented scholars and academicians from all over the country, attracts media moguls and celebrates the divine congregation of culture and intellect. With a behemoth footfall of more than 20,000 students, Thomso is one of the country's most extensive and profligate college festivals.

Cognizance

Come March, the campus is brimming with activities for the preparation of Cognizance, the technical festival of IIT Roorkee. It is the largest of its kind in North India with over 16 million web hits from 100,000 unique visitors from over a 100 different countries and participation of over 15,000 students and professionals' on-campus from institutes across India. Cognizance 2014 has a multitude of more than 180 events. With global participation from more than 1500 Technical & Management institutes reaching more than 200,000 students, professors & executives.

Training & Placement Office

The Training & Placement Office is responsible for all functions related to campus placements and internship. It is run and managed entirely by students, conforming to Placement Policy laid down by the Institute. The team works under the guidance of the Professor-in-Charge.

The team reaches out to companies, manages the online portal, conducts preparation activities and organizes the final placements season.

The team:

- Placement Managers overlook functioning of the team and ensure compliance with the Placement Policy.
- Company Coordinators send out invitations to companies and closely coordinate with their representatives.
- Support staff to help students and companies.

The Placement Office is well equipped with the facilities to carry out the placement processes in a smooth and efficient manner.

- An online portal for students for applications and accessing information on companies.
- Auditoriums to conduct workshops and pre-placement talks.
- Computer labs and halls to conduct online and written screening tests.
- Group discussion and interview rooms.
- Telephonic interview and video-conferencing facilities.

Placement Procedure

Placement Season 2014-15



1

The Training & Placement Office (TPO) reaches out to organizations to invite them for recruitment. The Placement Season commences in December, 2014.



2

Students are registered on the online portal for their use during recruitments after their resumes are duly verified.



3

Job Announcement Forms (JAF) are delivered to organizations via email, in which the companies are required to fill in the details such as the profile of job openings, location of posting, breakup of the compensation offered and the eligibility criteria.

Information on job openings is conveyed to the students by the portal, and applications of the interested candidates is sent back to the companies.



5

Organizations may visit our campus for an interactive session with the students. For conducting a Pre-Placement Talk (PPT) they can inform the TPO with their preferred dates.

Organizations may shortlist candidates for GD/Activity/PI, as per their recruitment processes, on the basis of resumes or through written or online tests. Organizations may conduct tests before December or on the day of campus recruitment.

Companies are also requested to maintain a waitlist in case of non-availability of some of the selected students.

Each organization is allotted a slot in December, which is arrived upon through various factors such as

- Students' preferences
- Work profile
- Compensation offered
- Career prospects

The entire process is governed by the Placement Policy and Rules which is available on the website of Training & Placement Office. Placement policy documents are shared with the recruiters in advance.

After the interviews, organizations submit a list of selected students. Upon receiving a job offer, the student is deregistered from the placement season, and the placement process is complete.
