



STUDENT EXCHANGE

Student exchange presents broad based benefits and outcomes for students keen to embark on the international academic adventure. International learning and knowledge propels students towards acceptance and understanding of an array of different academic, cultural and community perspectives.

In 2014-15, seven students from BIMTECH Bhubaneswar received offers for exchange programme from partners in Austria and France. Three students went ahead to pursue two trimesters of academic assignments of their interest at FH Joanneum Austria and ESSCA, Angers France. A report of their experience is shared below:

Exchange Programme in Graz, Austria

Studying in Austria has been the fulfilment of a dream. The chance to study in a foreign country as well as travel around a continent I have never been to before introduced me to ideas, concepts, places and people I would otherwise probably not have encountered anytime soon.

Austria is a small country with a population of 84,39,924. Eighty Five percent of its total land area is covered with snow-capped mountains called Austrian Alps. I have always been brought up in a noisy city atmosphere where I was not exposed to much of nature and mountains; but now this 6 months stay in Austria has given me a heavenly experience. I have experienced all the seasons in Europe in these six months from freezing snow to warmth of sun. Most importantly the language "German" which I learnt back in India, was very helpful which made me it easier in connecting and getting along with people and learn more about their culture.



The exchange programme allows students to take courses in different majors. The courses I studied here introduced me to Analytical Techniques, Emerging Markets and Global Business Programme. I was able to learn many new perspectives and concepts, thanks to the broad array of classes available to students on exchange programs.

My life has changed. I was an independent person before, but by managing to study abroad I have demonstrated that I am capable and mature enough take the initiative to relocate, adapt to a new environment, and learn from new resources.

Studying at ESSACA, Angers, France

One of the major reasons I decided to study abroad for 6 months is to gain maturity and social poise, fuelled by the necessity to confront challenges outside my comfort zone.

Favourable highlights of living with a French family included experiencing French culture and traditions, whilst having lots of fun and making great friends and living like a family. It was great sharing and experiencing all the cultural differences that make us all same yet very different simultaneously. It was much harder than I had expected it to be and the French can be rather complex when trying to understand them and their culture. However it was nice to live in France for a while, living the French/student lifestyle in a local manner and not being so exposed to the touristy elements and attractions. I made wonderful friends in my neighbourhood; I helped them



improve their English while they helped me with my basic French language skills.

ESSCA had organised an inauguration on the 13 January 2015 which included all the basic information of the rules and regulation of the campus and a brief explanation of how the country functions. We had a typical French lunch, a three course meal. I was lucky to be crowned queen and I bossed everybody around for the rest of the day. It was real fun that day.

Classes started the very next day. I chose to study: Business and Market Dynamics, Digital Marketing, Leadership and Strategy, Country Risk Analysis and French for Beginners. We had continuous assessment of grading where every project, every quiz, every assessment was taken into account. The classrooms were really lively and interactive where students from across the world were present. There were students from America, Hungary, China, Korea, Mexico, Japan, European Union etc. It was a very diverse study environment. It was also very competitive as the faculties made us have debates arguing about the highlights of our country's risks and resources. We learnt a lot about our country as well as that of others. We had a lot of business simulation games where we had to start a new company and take care of the all the accounts and promotions of that organization. My company (U'R Pool- a pool maintenance company) got the third place out of the other 11 companies. French have this concept of work while you play which lacks in India. We learnt marketing while marketing virtual products in group of 10 and we learnt accounting while making balance sheets for our imaginary company. It was a very fun and we learnt a lot in the process.

All in all I had a terrific experience away, What I learnt about myself, others and other countries and their cultures could never be taught. I know that I would recommend to anyone to take the opportunity of a lifetime to live and study in a non-English speaking country and embrace a country other than your own. I take this opportunity to thank everyone who made me realise this dream.

ACADEMICS LEARNING & PEDAGOGY

Team Learning

Learning starts with the formation of study-groups of the students for the duration of their stay on the campus. The groups are self-formed by the students on the basis of chemistry of social life, culture, academic background and work experience. Students share ideas, thoughts, culture and personal experience. Sharing of Industry Experience

CONFERENCES AND WORKSHOPS

International Conference On Multidisciplinary Approaches In Business Management And Sustainability (ICMABMS) 2014

BIMTECH Bhubaneswar organized its first International Conference on 28-29 November, 2014 on the theme **Multidisciplinary Approaches in Business Management & Sustainability,** in association with the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) and Global Business and Management Forum (GBMF), USA and several other national and global partners. The Advisory Committee was drawn from the top echelonts of the industry and academia, with Shri B.K. Birla as the Chief Patron. The conference was the first major students-driven initiative, inaugurated on 28 November 2014 by Dr. Subas Pani, IAS (Retd.), former Chief Secretary, Odisha and Dr. A K Mahapatra, Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar in the presence of Dr. Prithvi Yadav, Director, BIMTECH Bhubaneswar and Dr. B. POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN MANAGEMENT (PGDM) About the Programme


BIMTECH Bhubaneswar offers a two-year full-time residential Post Graduate Diploma Programme in Management which is approved by AICTE. The programme has the advantage of using a rich knowledge capital, developed by the G.Noida campus over the last 26 years.



Admission into the programme is screened based on qualifying any one of these competitive exams i.e. CAT/XAT/MAT/CMAT/GMAT. Thereafter, Written Essays / GD and Personal Interview process is conducted with the support of senior faculty / corporate to select students for the programmes. Final selection into the program involves suitable weightages allocated for Work Experience, Academic and Professional Qualifications, Regional background etc.

PGDM is conducted in close association with the industry. From the admission of the students to the designing of the curriculum and providing opportunities for short term projects, summer internship and final placement, they are our partners. The rigorous regime inculcates in the students the ability to work under pressure, multi-tasking besides giving them a strong academic base. Wading through classes, guest lectures, presentations and assignments, students also learn time management, which is an essential requirement for being a successful manager.

The PGDM programme is divided into six trimesters across two years. **Marketing, Finance, HR or Operations** is offered as a specialization from the **third trimester**. Students are also exposed to the corporate world through **industryacademia interface, special guest lectures, workshops, summer internship and short term projects**, all of which are a part of the course design and has to be compulsorily taken up by the students. **Live projects and industrial visits**, jointly guided by the industry managers and faculty, develop students' understanding of modern business processes and practices. 



Pan India spread of PGDM (2014-16)





INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO VISHAKAPATNAM



PGDM Batch (2014 – 16) visited Visakhapatnam, the largest city in the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh and the third largest city on the east coast of India (after Chennai and Kolkata). Visakhapatnam is the commercial hub and a financial capital of Andhra Pradesh, with a GDP of over \$26 Billion (USD). Many SEZ's & industrial corridors such as, VSEZ, APSEZ, APIIC, Aganumpudi Industrial Park, Visakha Dairy, JNPC, Brandix Apparel City etc., are located in and around the city.

The main motto behind this trip was to visit organizations in person to understand the working environment and their behaviour. This practical exposure helped gain insight into the internal activities of a company and how business is run and learn the managerial aspects of a business house. It was a great experience for to visit industries like Visakhapatnam Steel Plant, Hindustan Shipping Yard and Coca Cola bottling plant which helped develop an understanding of the real difference between a process line and a job shop which was classroom learning until then. Each organization was different from the other in its nature and operation, both in process and business perspective. Being a management student, this visit provided a great opportunity to understand the differences and similarities between these organizations environment and behaviour.



The five-day journey by road spanned from 6to 10 March 2015. The four days spent in Vizag left memorable moments which will be cherished forever. Two busloads left in a convoy in the evening with loads of expectations and high spirits. The dinner at Chilika Dhaba and the sleepless nights in the bus were worth every bit of the sacrifice. The south Indian food was delightful; this being a first journey to south for many of us, we were spell bound after tasting the south Indian delicacies. Few of us faced problems because of the spicy food but all settled well in few hours.

The visit to VSP was a memorable one, the kind of work environment and massive infrastructure of the plant was worth a visit. At Hindustan Shipping yard we saw the whole process of building a ship, from steel plate preparation, their movement from one workplace to another through polar and rail crane as well as the roller conveyer, the press and primary blocks workshop, how the hull and critical part of the ship are built. The visit to Coca cola bottling plant, which was small in size, hardly took half an hour to tour the whole plant. But here we were able to see the actual process line in action. The whole bottling process is a continuous process which focuses on the efficiency and productivity that emphasize on the profitability of the organization. In the end, we were served with cold drinks to quench our thirst.

The beauty of Vizag is treat to watch- the R.K beach, the live submarine turned museum and beach, Borra caves located in the Ananthagiri hills of the Araku valley, distinctly exhibiting a variety of impressive speleothems ranging from very small to big and irregularly shaped stalactites and stalagmites. (The Caves are basically caustic limestone structures extending to a depth of 262.5 ft.), Kailashgiri hills and the Simhachalan temple (a mini Tirupathi of Lord Narasimha) can be considered as marvels of nature and were delightful to visit. There were moments that were unique and different. We had problems, confusions, rifts among us, but at the end of the day when we returned, all of it left a sweet memory that will be in our hearts for years to come.

Before going to our industrial visit the class was divided into several groups. Each group consisting of 8 members (including the Team Leader and the Assistance Team Leader)

The main reasons for doing this division of groups was

- To check the team effort
- To check the individual effort in that concerned team
- To inculcate team spirit
 - To enhance the interpersonal communication amongst the member in a group as well as with the members of other groups.

STUDENT CONDUITS

Several Student Conduits and Committees have been formed under which different activities are carried out throughout the year by the students

CCR Conduit: is the student representative team for the Centre for Corporate Relations (CCR). This is the single-window for contacting Organisations to invite them to the campus for various activities like guest lectures, student interactions, projects, internships, final placements etc.

Discipline Conduit: Members of this conduit ensure that discipline is maintained on the Campus, in the hostel and in the mess. Any observations of deviations are dealt with deftly and differences resolved between differing individuals at the earliest.

Editorial Conduit: ensures that all events are recorded and reported; this is later brought out in the form of a Newsletter "Darpan". The student team of this conduit are responsible for writing, compiling and editing articles on the various activities that happen on the campus. It also highlights the laurels achieved by students, faculty and staff in various spheres.

Sports Conduit: Facilities are available on campus to engage students in several sporting activities throughout the year. There is also a State-of-the-Art Gym for use by students and faculty at dedicated times. The sports conduit organises various events both within the institute and also takes on the responsibility of forming teams for different competitions in intercollegiate events. The sports conduit is responsible for all the sports and gym equipment including for seeing new requirements according to the needs of the students. Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Badminton, Table tennis, carrom etc. are some of the popular games on the campus.

Cultural Conduit: The executive members organise various functions and festivals with the help of other student volunteers. To date, Fresher's party, Independence Day, Eid, Janmasthami, Ganesh Chaturti, Onam, Diwali, Christmas, New Year, Lohri, Saraswati Puja, Farewell Party etc. have been organised on the campus. Mess Conduit: In addition to 'food for thought' adequate importance is also given to "food for the stomach". Being a residential campus, food forms an important of the Life on the campus!
