Applications are invited from **Indian citizens (Male and Female)** for filling up following vacancies of General Central Service Group ‘B’ Non-Gazetted (Non Ministerial) on temporary basis likely to be permanent in the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force. The post has all India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by the ITBPF Act and Rules.

- a) Total vacancies includes Backlog vacancies and may vary due to administrative reasons.
 - b) 10% of the vacancies in UR category are reserved for Ex-Servicemen. In case vacancy reserved for Ex-servicemen remained unfilled due to non-availability of eligible or qualified candidates, the same shall be filled by candidates from non-ex-servicemen category.
2. The last date of receipt of applications is **23/10/2015** for all states except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir state, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which last date is **30/10/2015**.

3. **PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES: -**

Pay Scale – Pay Band 2, Rs. 9300 – 34800+ Grade Pay of Rs. 4600.

Other allowances:- The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Kit Maintenance Allowance as admissible from time to time, Special Compensatory Allowance while posted in specified border areas, free uniform, free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free leave pass and any other allowance as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. **They will be covered under new Restructured Defined contribution Pension scheme.**

4. A candidate applying/appearing for the post should mention in application form, if any criminal case(s) is/are pending/lodged against him/her in any police station/Hon'ble court/ any criminal case decided against by court of law.

5. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:-**

(i) **AGE:** – Upto 30 Years. (i.e., not born before 24/10/1985).

(ii) **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

Master's Degree from a recognised university in Hindi or English with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or as the medium of examination at the degree level.

OR

Master's Degree from a recognised university in any subject other than Hindi and English with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or either of the two as the medium of examination and the other as a compulsory or elective subject at the degree level.

OR

Master's Degree from a recognised university in any subject other than Hindi and English with Hindi or English as the medium of examination and English or Hindi as a compulsory or elective subjects or as medium of examination at the degree level.

OR

Bachelor's Degree from a recognised University with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or either of the two as the medium of examination and the other as compulsory or elective subject plus a recognised Diploma or Certificate course in Translation from Hindi to English and vice versa or two years experience of translation work from Hindi to English and vice versa in Central or State Government Department including Government of India Undertakings and working knowledge of computer application or equivalent.

Note: - It is important that the candidates applying for this recruitment check their eligibility, to avoid disappointment at later stage.

6. **CUT OFF DATE FOR AGE AND RELAXATION IN UPPER AGE LIMIT:**

Cutoff date for determining the age will be **23rd October, 2015 (23/10/2015).**

Note:-

- i) The upper age limit is relaxable for SC, ST and OBC (NCL) persons in accordance with the Government orders on the subject.
- ii) Candidates should note that only the Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation certificate available on the date of submission of application will be accepted for determining the age and no subsequent request for its change will be considered or granted.

- iii) Candidates claiming OBC status may note that certificate on non-creamy layer status should have been obtained within three years before the closing date i.e. 23.10.2015.
- iv) Candidates who wish to be considered against vacancies reserved or seek age relaxation must submit requisite certificate from the competent authority, in the prescribed format when such certificates are sought by the Recruitment Board. Otherwise, their claim for SC, ST and OBC (NCL) status will not be entertained and their candidature/applications will be considered under General (UR) category. The formats of the certificates are annexed. Certificates obtained in any other format will not be accepted.

- (ii) The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

(iii) A colour blind person will not be eligible for appointment. If at any stage of service career, person is found to be colour blind, he will be boarded out as per SHAPE policy in vogue.

(iv) **Tattoos:** - Tattoos depicting religious symbol or figure and the name on traditional sites of the body like inner aspect of forearm but only left forearm being non saluting limb or dorsum of the hands must be less than ¼ of the particular part (elbow or hand) of the body is permitted.

9. HOW TO APPLY AND BY WHICH DATE:

Eligible and interested candidates should send their Applications (duly filled in Hindi or English only) complete in all respects and Candidate's Admit Card duly filled, in the prescribed proforma as per **Annexure 'I'** and **Annexure 'II'** to be either type written or neatly hand written in blue or black ink/ball pen on one side of A4 size plain paper with passport size photographs affixed on application and self-attested. The application should be sent alongwith **application fee**, and enclosures as in para-12 to the **THE INSPECTOR GENERAL (Eastern) Frontier, ITB Police, Sheela Complex, Vidhan Sabha Marg, Near Radio Station, Hazaratganj, Lucknow (UP) Pin code – 226001** so as to reach on or before the prescribed last date i.e. **23.10.2015** for all States except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu & Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which last date is **30.10.2015**.

10. APPLICATION FEE:

The candidates belonging to General and OBC category should pay the fee of Rs. 50/- (Fifty only) (non-refundable) as application fee by means of **"Indian Postal Orders (IPO)" only**. IPO should be drawn in the name of **INSPECTOR GENERAL (Eastern) Frontier, ITB Police**.

Note: Application received with any other mode of fee payment will be summarily rejected. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, females and Ex-servicemen are exempted from paying fee.

11. ENCLOSURES REQUIRED TO BE ATTACHED WITH APPLICATION:

Self-attested copies of following documents/certificates are required to be attached with the application form:-

- a) Certificates about the educational qualifications, **clearly showing the subjects studied by the candidate and the medium of instruction at Graduation and Post-Graduation level.**
- b) Date of birth Certificate (Matriculation or 10th Class Certificate or Certificate issued by National Open School /National Institute of Open School as proof of date of birth).
- c) Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Certificate, as Annexure-III, OBC (NCL) certificate, as Annexure- 'IV' (if belonging to any of these categories) issued by an authority not lower than Tehsildar or SDM. Candidates claiming OBC status may note that certificate on creamy layer status should have been obtained within **three years** before the closing date i.e. **23.10.2015**;
Note: - SC/ST or OBC certificate must be in prescribed proforma as attached at Annexure –'III' and Annexure-'IV' respectively.
- d) Domicile Certificate issued by an authority not lower than Tehsildar or SDM **or PAN Card or Aadhaar Card or Driving License or Voter ID Card** etc for verification of citizenship.
- e) Height/ chest relaxation certificate as per annexure – V, if applicable.
- f) Discharge certificate in case of Ex-servicemen.
- g) Two latest passport size photographs. (One pasted on application form and another on admit card.
- h) Two self-addressed envelope of 4"x9" size with Rs. 5/- postage stamp affixed on the envelope.
- j) Envelope containing Application must be superscribed in bold letters "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF **INSPECTOR (HINDI TRANSLATOR)** IN ITBP".

Note: All the above relevant original documents/certificates are required to be brought at the time of recruitment test.

12. SELECTION PROCESS:

The candidates whose applications are found to be in order shall be issued Admit Cards to appear in recruitment test. The date and place of recruitment test will be indicated in Admit card. Candidates will have to undergo the following tests:

Note:

Those who do not qualify any stage will get eliminated from the process there only and will not be allowed to appear in further tests.

a) Merit List:

Merit lists for each category namely, Gen, SC, ST and OBC (NCL) will be drawn on the basis of combined marks obtained by the candidates in the Written test and Interview. The candidates shall be short listed for Detailed Medical Examination (DME) as per the category-wise vacancies on the basis of this merit list.

b) Resolution of Tie cases:

a) In case of tie in marks, the candidate with older age will be higher in merit.

- c) If the tie still persists, it is finally resolved by referring to the alphabetical order of names i.e. a candidate whose name begins with the alphabet which comes first in the alphabetical order gets preference.

c) **CHECKING OF DOCUMENTS:**

Testimonials of the candidates will be checked at the time of Detailed Medical Examination (DME). Original documents will be returned on the spot after verification and self-attested photocopies of certificates will be retained with the application.

d) **DETAILED MEDICAL EXAMINATION:**

Candidates shortlisted in order of merit will be put through a detailed medical examination to assess their fitness as per medical policy issued by MHA.

13. **APPEAL IN CASE OF REJECTION IN DETAILED MEDICAL EXAMINATION:**

A candidate declared unfit in detailed medical examination if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an application for his re-medical examination with a duly filled Medical fitness certificate (at Annexure-VI) as a proof of evidence about the possibility of error of judgment on the part of Recruitment Medical Officer within 15 days from his date of rejection in DME.

- i) The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment in ITBP by a Medical Officer.
- ii) The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains Medical Re-Examination Fee of Rs. 25/- in form of Indian Postal Order and Rejection Slip (original) issued by the Presiding Officer. RME fee in the form of IPO should be prepared in the name of **INSPECTOR GENERAL (Eastern) Frontier, ITB Police.**
- iii) The appeal complete in all respects should be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue Rejection Slip in which the finding of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate. ITBP will not be responsible for any postal delay. The application for re-medical examination shall be sent to **THE INSPECTOR GENERAL (Eastern) Frontier, ITB Police, Sheela Complex, Vidhan Sabha Marg, Near Radio Station, Hazaratganj, Lucknow (UP) Pin code – 226001.** The decision of the re-medical board of ITBP shall be final and no 2nd appeal will be entertained, except in of rejection on grounds of visual acuity, as per Govt. instructions. No reply of the correspondence for second appeal will be considered/entertained.

14. Candidates who are already in Central/State Govt. service including departmental candidates should send their application through proper channel with "No Objection Certificate" (as given in the application form) from their employer. Application received without proper channel and "No Objection Certificate" will be rejected.

15. No correspondence will be entertained from ineligible candidates whose applications have been rejected.

16. Candidates belonging to physically challenged category are not eligible to apply for this post.

17. All disputes and differences, if any, will be subject to jurisdiction of Delhi Courts only.

18. All eligible candidates will be duly informed about the date and venue of the recruitment tests through admit card. Candidates should come for the recruitment duly prepared for more than one day stay under their own arrangements. The Government shall not be responsible for damage/injury if any, to the individual sustained during the course of recruitment. **No TA/DA will be admissible. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected and no correspondence on this will be entertained. No application will be accepted after the last date of submission as mentioned above.**
