#### 3. PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES: -

Pay Scale - Pay Band 2, Rs. 9300 - 34800+ Grade Pay of Rs. 4600.

Other allowances:- The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Kit Maintenance Allowance as admissible from time to time, Special Compensatory Allowance while posted in specified border areas, free uniform, free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free leave pass and any other allowance as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. They will be covered under new Restructured Defined contribution Pension scheme.

4. A candidate applying/appearing for the post should mention in application form, if any criminal case(s) is/are pending/lodged against him/her in any police station/Hon'ble court/ any criminal case decided against by court of law.

#### 5. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**-

(i) <u>AGE</u>: - Upto 30 Years. (i.e., not born before 24/10/1985).

#### (ii) **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS**:

Master's Degree from a recognised university in Hindi or English with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or as the medium of examination at the degree level.

OR

Master's Degree from a recognised university in any subject other than Hindi and English with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or either of the two as the medium of examination and the other as a compulsory or elective subject at the degree level.

OR

Master's Degree from a recognised university in any subject other than Hindi and English with Hindi or English as the medium of examination and English or Hindi as a compulsory or elective subjects or as medium of examination at the degree level.

OR

Bachelor's Degree from a recognised University with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or either of the two as the medium of examination and the other as compulsory or elective subject plus a recognised Diploma or Certificate course in Translation from Hindi to English and vice versa or two years experience of translation work from Hindi to English and vice versa in Central or State Government Department including Government of India Undertakings and working knowledge of computer application or equivalent.

# 6. <u>CUT OFF DATE FOR AGE AND RELAXATION IN UPPER AGE LIMIT</u>: Cutoff date for determining the age will be <u>23<sup>rd</sup> October</u>, <u>2015</u> (<u>23/10/2015</u>). Note:-

- i) The upper age limit is relaxable for SC, ST and OBC (NCL) persons in accordance with the Government orders on the subject.
- ii) Candidates should note that only the Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation certificate available on the date of submission of application will be accepted for determining the age and no subsequent request for its change will be considered or granted.

- iii) Candidates claiming OBC status may note that certificate on non-creamy layer status should have been obtained within three years before the closing date i.e. 23.10.2015.
- iv) Candidates who wish to be considered against vacancies reserved or seek age relaxation must submit requisite certificate from the competent authority, in the prescribed format when such certificates are sought by the Recruitment Board. Otherwise, their claim for SC, ST and OBC (NCL) status will not be entertained and their candidature/applications will be considered under General (UR) category. (ii) The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

- (iii) A colour blind person will not be eligible for appointment. If at any stage of service career, person is found to be colour blind, he will be boarded out as per SHAPE policy in vogue.
- (iv) <u>Tattoos</u>: Tattoos depicting religious symbol or figure and the name on traditional sites of the body like inner aspect of forearm but only left forearm being non saluting limb or dorsum of the hands must be less than ¼ of the particular part (elbow or hand) of the body is permitted.

#### 10. APPLICATION FEE:

The candidates belonging to General and OBC category should pay the fee of Rs. 50/- (Fifty only) (non-refundable) as application fee by means of "Indian Postal Orders (IPO)" only. IPO should be drawn in the name of <u>INSPECTOR GENERAL</u> (Eastern) Frontier, ITB Police.

#### Note:

Those who do not qualify any stage will get eliminated from the process there only and will not be allowed to appear in further tests.

#### a) Merit List:

Merit lists for each category namely, Gen, SC, ST and OBC (NCL) will be drawn on the basis of combined marks obtained by the candidates in the Written test and Interview. The candidates shall be short listed for Detailed Medical Examination (DME) as per the category-wise vacancies on the basis of this merit list.

#### b) Resolution of Tie cases:

a) In case of tie in marks, the candidate with older age will be higher in merit.

c) If the tie still persists, it is finally resolved by referring to the alphabetical order of names i.e. a candidate whose name begins with the alphabet which comes first in the alphabetical order gets preference.

#### c) CHECKING OF DOCUMENTS:

Testimonials of the candidates will be checked at the time of Detailed Medical Examination (DME). Original documents will be returned on the spot after verification and self-attested photocopies of certificates will be retained with the application.

#### d) DETAILED MEDICAL EXAMINATION:

Candidates shortlisted in order of merit will be put through a detailed medical examination to assess their fitness as per medical policy issued by MHA.

## 13. <u>APPEAL IN CASE OF REJECTION IN DETAILED MEDICAL EXAMINATION:</u>

A candidate declared unfit in detailed medical examination if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an <u>application for his remedical examination with a duly filled Medical fitness certificate (at Annexure-VI) as a proof of evidence about the possibility of error of judgment on the part of Recruitment Medical Officer within 15 days from his date of rejection in DME.</u>

- i) The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment in ITBP by a Medical Officer.
- ii) The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains Medical Re-Examination Fee of Rs. 25/- in form of Indian Postal Order and Rejection Slip (original) issued by the Presiding Officer. RME fee in the form of IPO should be prepared in the name of INSPECTOR GENERAL (Eastern) Frontier, ITB Police.
- iii) The appeal complete in all respects should be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue Rejection Slip in which the finding of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate. ITBP will not be responsible for any postal delay. The application for re-medical examination shall be sent to THE INSPECTOR GENERAL (Eastern) Frontier, ITB Police, Sheela Complex, Vidhan Sabha Marg, Near Radio Station, Hazaratganj, Lucknow (UP) Pin code 226001. The decision of the re-medical board of ITBP shall be final and no 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal will be entertained, except in of rejection on grounds of visual acuity, as per Govt. instructions. No reply of the correspondence for second appeal will be considered/entertained.

- 14. Candidates who are already in Central/State Govt. service including departmental candidates should send their application through proper channel with "No Objection Certificate" (as given in the application form) from their employer. Application received without proper channel and "No Objection Certificate" will be rejected.
- 15. No correspondence will be entertained from ineligible candidates whose applications have been rejected.
- 16. Candidates belonging to physically challenged category are not eligible to apply for this post.
