Executive Summary

NPCIL is committed to economic and social development of the local community near all its units. There are three major areas namely - education, healthcare, and infrastructure development - in which CSR work has been done. Skill development projects were also initiated under education area. NPCIL aims to function as responsible corporate entity while discharging its social responsibilities towards all stakeholders including consumers, employees, local communities and society at large. Building on the foundation of good CSR work done in the FY 2011-12, there has been a quantum jump in all the parameters of CSR programme in the FY 2012-13. The number of CSR projects taken-up has increased from 116 to 306 and total annual monetary allocation has increased from ₹ 21.5 crore to ₹ 55 crore. Moreover, an additional CSR fund of ₹ 125 Crore was sanctioned on account of Silver Jubilee year of the company for initiating major CSR projects especially in the area of children's education and infrastructures. Using this fund, the CSR projects worth ₹ 1,238.32 lakh have been completed and remaining CSR projects are in progress. Site wise fund spent during the FY2012-13 is given below.

Major CSR projects completed are:

1. Installation of drinking water tank at Dhuandhoop village near Rawatbhata in Rajasthan for providing drinking water to villagers.
2. Organising school health programme for village schools near Tarapur in Maharashtra to ensure health of students.
3. Aids and appliances to differently-abled people near Kalpakkam in Tamil Nadu.
4. School boundary and toilet block in Government School, Udaigarh near Narora in Uttar Pradesh.
5. Primary school building at Unchamala village near Kakrapar in Gujarat to facilitate education of village students.
6. Augmentation of school teachers in government schools near Kaiga in Karnataka.
7. Development of numerous approach roads in the vicinity of Kudankulam in Tamil Nadu.

At Kudankulam in Tamil Nadu, ₹ 1.97 crores fund was deposited with the state government for taking up CSR projects under Self Sufficient Scheme (SSS) where one third fund is contributed by NPCIL and two thirds fund is provided by Tamil Nadu government. Out of these 125 projects, about 50% have been completed and the rest are in the advanced stages of completion by District Rural Development Agency (DRDA).

Several in-house and external training programmes were organised for the officials associated with the CSR programme of NPCIL. These programmes availed the faculty inputs from organisations and institutions with distinctly superior CSR capabilities. An internal audit of the CSR programme was also conducted to the satisfaction of the Social Audit Committee.



1 Introduction

Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL) is a Public Sector Enterprise under the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Government of India. It was incorporated on September 17, 1987 as a Public Limited Company under the Companies Act 1956, with the objective of operating the atomic power stations and implementing the atomic power projects for the generation of electricity, in pursuance of the schemes and programmes of Government of India under the Atomic Energy Act. Locations and power ratings of NPCIL's power stations and power projects are given in the following figure.

NPCIL aims to harmonize its core values and business operations to meet the realistic expectations of the local populations in the best possible manner. From the inception of nuclear power programme in the country, the units of NPCIL have been implementing numerous social welfare activities for benefit of local population. However, with issuance of DPE guidelines on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) for central public sector undertakings, NPCIL has re-invigorated the CSR programme in right earnestness.

Under CSR programme, NPCIL has identified the three key areas - education, healthcare, and infrastructure development for improving quality of life for local population near the units. Various projects like construction of school buildings, financial assistance to schools, scholarships to students and sponsorship for higher education, development of Aganwadis etc. are taken up under education. Under healthcare, the projects taken-up include running primary health centres, mobile medical van services, organising medical camps, funding extension of hospitals, medical treatment and medicines (OPD services) for villagers etc. Under infrastructure development, the projects like laying of approach roads, development of drinking water facility, construction of community hall, construction of bus stop sheds, installation of street lights, fishing facility etc. have been planned and implemented.

Approved CSR policy is available for uniform implementation by all the units. Additionally, a comprehensive guiding document, Headquarter Instruction (HQI) – 8501 on CSR and R&R is also available. This HQI brings out the purpose, governing principles, organisational set-up, decision rules, and activities to be included in CSR programme, funding, programme implementation, monitoring and control, etc.

2 CSR Organisation

The CSR programmes of different units of NPCIL are co-ordinated, monitored and controlled at Headquarters by the directorate of Rehabilitation and Resettlement. At each unit of NPCIL, a CSR committee consisting of senior executives is in place. This committee has representatives from Technical, HR, Finance and Medical functions.

3 CSR Planning

The CSR Committees at NPCIL sites assess the needs for CSR projects in conjunction with the local administration, surpanches, schools, etc. In addition to this, a comprehensive baseline survey is also being planned to be done at all the sites. The requests for CSR projects are received by the units. These requests and needs are physically verified by the unit CSR committees. Only selected projects, that meet the predefined criteria for CSR works and for which NOCs and no duplication certificate are available, are further developed in the form of a formal project report that usually includes the scope of work as well as financial estimates. The project reports are forwarded to Headquarters for further review and approval in directorate of Resettlement and Rehabilitation. After thorough scrutiny, the project proposals are approved and unique project codes with financial allocation are assigned to the projects at the Headquarters.

4 CSR Funds

Once the CSR projects are approved at Headquarters and assigned project codes with financial allocation, the same become ready for implementation at units. During the year, ₹ 55 crore was allocated for the CSR programme. This amount was about 3% of estimated profit after tax. An additional CSR fund of ₹ 125 crore was sanctioned on account of silver jubilee year of the company for initiating major CSR projects especially in the area of children's education. The non-lapsable balance fund of ₹ 3.99 lakh was also available from the previous year. So, the total fund allocated to CSR programme was ₹ 182.30 crore. The table below shows statement of account for non-lapsable CSR fund as on 31.03.2013.

5 Programme Implementation

Projects in the CSR programmes of the units largely fit into the three key areas of education, healthcare, and infrastructure development. The detailed list of projects taken-up for implementation during the year 2012-13 is available at Annexure 1. The number of projects taken up at each unit is shown in the table next.

As such, total 306 projects were taken up from the CSR fund during the year comprising 232 infrastructure projects, 19 health projects, 53 education projects and 2 others projects. In addition to this, some more CSR projects were taken up from the additional CSR fund. To be precise, total 50 projects were taken up using additional CSR fund during the year comprising 35 infrastructure projects, 3 health projects and 12 education projects. The detailed list of projects taken-up for implementation during the year from additional CSR fund is available at Annexure 2. The unit wise numbers of additional CSR projects are given in the table below.

Some projects started in FY 2011-12 spilled over in implementation to FY 2012-13. The status of projects initiated in FY 2011-12 is available at Annexure 3.

For the benefit of the units, the list of empanelled NGOs is available on the company intranet as well as on the public website (www.npcil.co.in and www.npcil.nic.in). The unit CSR committees can select the suitable agencies from this shortlist and assign them the work in their area of specialization. Training and seminars were also organised for executives in the unit CSR committees. Relevant senior executives at Headquarters were also sensitised to the CSR commitments, DPE guidelines and current status of CSR projects in the Corporation.

6 Unit CSR Reports

This section consists of unit CSR reports. Total 356 projects were taken up during the year which consisted of 267 infrastructure projects, 22 healthcare projects, 65 education projects and 2 other projects including projects under additional CSR fund for the year 2012-14. Some of the major CSR projects at different units are highlighted in the respective unit CSR reports given in this section.

6.1 CSR at Tarapur Maharashtra Site (TMS)

TMS was allocated ₹ 1,457 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 12-13. In addition to this, ₹ 1,970.54 lakh was allocated from additional CSR fund for FY 2012-14. Using these funds, TMS initiated several projects. Glimpses of some of the completed projects in 2012-13 are provided below.

6.1.1. Promote education in surrounding areas of TMS and thereby reduce school dropouts

This project is undertaken to promote education and thereby reduce the dropout rates in the neighbouring villages of TMS. Under this project, school aids like uniform, notebooks, school bags, and raincoat, and shoes etc. have been provided to Z.P School students as these students belong to economically weaker strata (tribal community) of the local population. Additionally, computers have also been provided to Z.P Schools as requested by B.D.O. and school authorities, as the grants received from state government towards purchase of computers were not sufficient for all the schools. It is observed that the project has helped in many ways including the following:

- Increase in the strength of students especially in remote tribal villages.
- Gradual decrease in school dropout rates in general and among girl students in particular.
- The overall pass result of the schools has improved over a time from 72% to 100%.
- Increase in the strength of the middle schools in all the area where the project is undertaken.

6.1.2. Organising local cultural and sports events and exhibition

To promote sports activities in the local population, a two-day Thane District Athletic Meet 2012 was conducted at TMS where 800 participants took part and the winners were awarded with medals and certificates. All the participants were provided lodging and boarding facility at TAPS colony free of charge.

6.1.3. Felicitation of village school teachers

Felicitation of village school teachers was done on Teachers Day. About 450 teachers from the neighbouring village educational Institutes (schools and colleges) who had contributed to the field of education, were felicitated with shawl, shripahal, and mementos.

6.1.4. Conducting school health program

A school health programme was conducted jointly with Dr M.L. Dhawale Hospital Trust. Under this project, the students of Shigav Ashram Shala, Delwadi Vibhag High School and Dr Homi Babha Vidyalaya were provided counselling in terms of life skill sessions, psychological and physical health checkups, behavioural issues, attitude problems, anger management, personality development, and sex education. The project was first started in FY 2011-12 and repeated this year as the benefits of project were highly appreciated by school management as well as the parents. The project has helped in improving the academic results as well as holistic health of students.

6.1.6. Needs assessment survey for construction of (10+2) English medium school

The empanelled NGOs were approached for conducting the baseline survey for opening school/ ITI in the neighbouring villages of TMS. Out of the four NGOs that participated with their expression of interest, M/s Ramky Foundation was awarded the work for baseline survey project. The survey of the intended area was conducted to collect the data, and a draft report was submitted by the NGO. The final survey report is under preparation by the NGO.

In addition to the above projects, some of the projects initiated in FY 2011-12 at TMS were also completed during the FY 2012-13. Glimpses of a few projects are given below.

6.1.5. Health services to 14 villages surrounding TMS

TMS is operating primary health centre at Pophran village. A mobile medical van service is also operated for 10 villages through Karuna Trust - an NGO. This facility provided health services to a population of about 20,000 local people in 14 neighbouring villages of TMS. Through this health service, school children health check-up was also carried out in various schools in the neighbourhood villages.

6.1.7. Construction of internal roads, bridge and drainage lines at village Ghivali

The work is executed through Grampanchayat Ghivali. Development of these roads will help improve connectivity of the village with the main stream society and uplift the socio-economic status of the village.

6.1.8. Widening and Strengthening of Panchmarg - Old Akkarpati - Unbhat - Uchelli - Dandi road

Widening and strengthening of 2.77km Panchmarg - Old Akkarpati - Unbhat - Uchelli - Dandi Road is taken up. This road would help in improving connectivity to help uplift the socio-economic status of the village population.

6.1.9. Distribution of aids and appliances to handicapped beneficiaries

Medical camp was organised for Handicapped persons jointly with District Rehabilitation Centre, Govt of Maharashtra. During the camp aids and appliances were prescribed to the needy handicapped persons. The aids and appliances were procured through District Rehabilitation Centre, Govt. of Maharashtra and distributed to 76 differently able persons, which included hearing aids, tricycle, wheelchair, walkers, blind stick, clutches etc.

6.2 CSR at Rawatbhata Rajasthan Site (RRS)

RRS was allocated ₹ 1,745 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 12-13. In addition to this, ₹ 925 lakh was allocated from the additional CSR fund. Using these funds, RRS prepared a CSR plan for the development of neighbourhood area within 16 km and executed number of activities in the areas of infrastructure, health and education under CSR programme. The projects/ CSR activities are finalised in such a fashion that these will fulfil the basic need of society in the long run and eventually contribute to the national development programme. Some major CSR projects implemented at RRS are given below.

6.2.1. Mobile Health Unit (MHU) operated for health support to villagers

To improve health and hygiene conditions of local villagers a Mobile Health Unit (MHU) was started through an NGO-Karuna Trust, Bengluru. The MHU regularly visited 12 nodal centers in the vicinity, namely - Thamlao, Eklingpura, Dhuandhoop, Renkhera, Jharjhani, Deepura, Chenpura, Luharia, Shripura, Charbhuja, Bhilbasti, Mandesara and Kundaliya covering around 64 villages. Total 8,337 patients (4,068 male and 4,269 female) were treated during the year.

6.2.2. Eye camp at RAPP hospital Rawatbhata

An eye camp was organized at RAPP hospital, RR Site in coordination with Andhata Nivaran Samiti, Chittorgarh and IMA Rawatbhata under CSR. The camp provided free treatment to 752 patients. These patients were identified with different eye related problems. Out of these 213 patients were operated successfully at RAPP hospital. The eye camp has benefitted the local people in 107 villages within 16 km radius of RRS.

6.2.3. PAHAL-Free computer education in nearby villages through NGO

Free computer education courses of three-month duration with 200 students each at three centres i.e., Bhensrorgarh, Mandeasra and Jharjhani, in first phase were conducted for preliminary education about computers. In the second phase, advanced computer course for 50 students each from the three centers is scheduled to be organised at Rawatbhata.

6.2.4. Distribution of learning aids to schools and students

With a view to facilitate education and reduce the school drop-out cases, various educational aids were provided to schools and students in the vicinity of RR Site, Rawatbhata.

Distributed school furniture (179 Dual desks, 09 big tables and 09 benches) to Govt. Upper Primary School Tamlao, Kundaliya, Baheliya, Chenpura, Jhalarbavri and Javrakalan. To provide 1,300 Dual Desks to schools, the process for purchase of Dual Desks from Khadi Ghar, Rawatbhata (Govt. Agency) is at an advanced stage of completion.

In order to increase computer literacy in the village schools, 16 nos. of computers have been distributed to Govt. Senior Secondary, Secondary and Upper Primary schools in the vicinity of RR Site, Rawatbhata.

Education kits (1,662 nos.) including school bag, notebook, pencil, sharpener, eraser, scale, PVC pouch and nail cutter were distributed in primary schools in ten villages around RRS.

Felicitation ceremony for school teachers was organized to honour Govt. school teachers of neighbouring villages. In these ceremonies the RRS CSR presented shawl, coconut executive diary and a Parker pen to the school teachers.

Under project Chirag, 1,000 nos of Solar Lanterns were provided to the students of schools in the neighbouring villages as learning aid so that they can continue to learn in the evenings even when the regular electricity supply was not available.

6.2.5. Construction of CC road in Rawatbhata

6.2.7. UJALA – The solar street lights

6.3 CSR at Madras Atomic Power Station (MAPS)

MAPS was allocated ₹ 109.55 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 2012-13. In additions to this, ₹ 1,350 lakh was allocated from the additional CSR fund. Using these funds MAPS initiated several CSR projects. Glimpses of some of the major CSR projects are given below.

6.3.1. Facilitating education and reducing school dropout rate

Note books were issued to the students of the 30 Government High Schools, Panchayat Middle Schools and Panchayat Union Primary Schools in 20 Panchayats in and around Kalpakkam, Tamilnadu benefitting about 5,000 children. Three new computers along with printers were issued to Government High School, Kuzhipanthandalam.

6.3.2. Teachers' day celebration

Teachers play a pivotal role in education of the children. With a view to recognise their contribution and as a part of Teacher's Day celebration during the month of September 2012, 500 teachers in 60 Government schools within 10 km range of MAPS were felicitated.

6.3.3. Construction of midday meals kitchen

A midday meals kitchen building was built by MAPS at Panchayat Union Middle School, Amoor. This will help in cooking and serving midday meals to the school children under hygienic conditions.

6.3.4. Installation of street light and Ultra Violet (UV) water purifiers

Street light fittings along with CFL bulbs (300 nos.) were installed in six panchayats in and around Kalpakkam, Tamilnadu. With a view to provide clean drinking water to students, Ultra Violet (UV) water purifiers were installed in eight Government Schools in and around Kalpakkam.

6.3.5. Medical camps

Medical camps (15 nos.) were conducted by a Medical Trust under the direct supervision of MAPS CSR team on weekly basis in 5 Villages. More than 2,500 patients were benefited in these 15 camps. In addition to this, 24 cataract surgeries were done to needy patients through reputed eye hospitals in Chennai and spectacles were distributed to more than 200 patients.

6.3.6. Aids to differently-abled persons

MAPS also carried out the assessment regarding aids required to differently abled person from the nearby villages with the help of Artificial Limb Manufacturing Company (ALIMCO), a Govt. of India Undertaking. The aids and appliances were issued to 44 differently-abled persons of various villages viz. Pudupattinam, Vasusvasamuthiram, Sooradimangalam, Nerumbur, Nallathur and Pattipulam.

6.3.7. Women empowerment

As part of women empowerment programme, a training programme of 5 months duration was conducted for second batch of 30 unemployed rural women through an NGO, Society for education and action, Mamallapuram. They have been trained in tailoring and handicrafts for increasing their employment potential.

6.3.8. Sanitation facilities for villagers

Another project to increase awareness towards better sanitation facilities among villagers is being implemented by MAPS in co-ordination with an NGO-Gandhi Rural Education and Development Society, Pondicherry (GREDS) that is specialist in this field. As part of the above project, with the aim of eradicating open defecation in a phased manner, 200 Indian Household Toilets are being constructed in 4 villages benefiting 200 families below BPL in the first phase. Fifty number of IHH Toilets have already been constructed in first phase at Ayappakkam village.

6.3.9. Community college for computer education

Under Skill Development programme, a community college to provide computer education to below poverty level children and provide them with employable certificate through IGNOU has been started in collaboration with NGO, DHAN People Academy. In the first batch, 46 children have been benefitted. The second batch of 100 children from the nearby villages is being trained.

6.3.10. Water supply projects

For supply of water, overhead water tanks were built and seven bore wells were drilled in four villages. Pumps and piping were also installed. The above project is expected to benefit more than 60,000 people residing in four villages.

6.3.11. Bus shelters

6.4 CSR at Narora Atomic Power Station (NAPS)

NAPS was allocated ₹ 130 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 2012-13. In addition to this, ₹ 170.58 lakh was allocated from the additional CSR fund. Using these funds, NAPS prepared a CSR plan for the development of neighbourhood area within 16 km and executed number of activities in the areas of infrastructure, health and education under CSR programme. Some major CSR projects implemented at NAPS are given below.

6.4.1. Construction of boundary wall and toilet at Primary School Udaigarhi

NAPS constructed boundary wall and toilet at Primary School in Udaigarhi village near Narora. This will help the students and teachers of the school.

6.4.2. Development of Infrastructure for supply of electricity to rural households

For supply of electricity to rural households, infrastructure was developed in villages under Debai Tehsil near NAPS through UPPCL. Similar work at Chandausi Tehsil is in progress.

6.4.3. Distribution of sweaters

During the winter season, NAPS distributed woollen sweaters to students of government primary school in Village Nityanandpur. This will help rural students to attend school during winters.

6.4.4. Free medical camps for villagers

Free medical camps were organized in nearby villages where the patients were examined free of cost by a team of doctors of NAPS Hospital and medicines were also provided free of cost. Medical camps were organized in Gokulpur Khadar, Maharajpur and Duptakalan villages.

6.4.5. Free eye camp for villagers

27th Free eye camp was organized in NAPS Hospital with support of Gandhi Eye Hospital, Aligarh (UP) between 15.03.2013 and 23.03.2013. Number of villagers registered for free eye checkup was 1027. Number of cataract operations performed in this camp was 134.

6.4.6. Free OPD dispensary facility for villagers at Community Centre in NAPS Township

Free OPD facility was provided to the villagers from nearby areas at Community Center Dispensary, NAPS Township on four days per week. Approximately 3,500–4,000 villagers per month are getting the benefitted by of this facility.

6.5 CSR at Kakrapara Gujarat Site (KAPS)

Kakrapara Gujarat Site was allocated ₹ 484.35 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 12-13. In addition to this, ₹ 65 lakh was allocated from the additional CSR fund. Using these funds, the site prepared a CSR plan for the development of neighbourhood area within 16 km and executed number of activities in the areas of infrastructure, health and education under CSR programme. Some prominent CSR projects implemented at Kakrapar Gujarat Site are given below.

6.5.1. Upgrading existing Eye Care setup by establishing Retina Clinic

To upgrade the existing eye care setup at Tejas Eye Hospital, Mandvi by establishing Retina Clinic, an MoU was signed between Divya Jyoti Trust and NPCIL Kakrapar Gujarat Site. For this purpose equipment such as Posterior Vitrectomy Machine, Laser Indirect Ophthalmoscope and Endolaser for Green Laser have been procured and commissioned at Tejas Eye Hospital, Mandvi. The Retina Clinic is expected to serve the needs of the local population around Kakrapar Gujarat Site without involving long distance travel.

6.5.2. Operating rural medical dispensaries in the nearby villages

This project consists of operation of Rural Medical Dispensaries at Unchamala and Kanza villages. In addition to this, Handicapped camp, Eye camp and school medical camps were also arranged during the year.

The medical services through Rural Dispensary continued to function during the year and provided medical services to patients from surrounding villages. Total 7,519 rural patients benefitted from the dispensary services during the year.

Over 500 school children of age group vary 5 yrs - 14 yrs from primary school and Aganwadis were examined in three school medical camps. These children were screened for dental hygiene, anaemia, sickle cell, skin, eye, ear, heart disease and growth disorders. The children were provided free treatment and medicines.

Out of these 70 patients were screened for cataract surgery with implantation of intraocular lenses and 15 patients had retinal and corneal problem. These patients were treated suitably.

6.5.3. Construction of primary school building at Unchamala village

Primary School building at Unchamala village has been constructed under the CSR programme. A part of this project was completed in FY 2011-12 and remaining construction has been completed in FY 2012-13. The newly constructed school building has two 12 rooms including classrooms, assembly hall and office room organised in two floors. Electrification and fitting of ceiling fans has been completed. The construction work of sanitation blocks is now in progress.

Over 100 students are studying in the primary school, Limbarda. Under CSR programme four class rooms were constructed in the school during FY 2011-12. But there were no playing facilities available to the students. So, the school was provided with the playing facilities during the FY 2012-13.

6.6 CSR at Kaiga Generating Station (KGS)

Kaiga Generating Station was allocated ₹ 489.72 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 12-13. Using this fund, the site prepared a CSR plan for the development of neighbourhood area within 16 km and executed number of activities in the areas of infrastructure, health and education. Some prominent CSR projects implemented at Kaiga Generating Station are given below.

6.6.1. Street lights in Mallapur

For ease of movement of local people during evenings, 55 nos. of street lights have been installed in the Rehabilitation area in Mallapur.

6.6.3. Health Centre at Mallapur

Kaiga Site is running a Health Centre at Mallapur village through Karuna Trust, Bangalore. This free of cost medical facility is well received by the people living in the surrounding villages. During the year 13,506 patients were treated by the Health Centre.

6.6.4. Free medical camps conducted in nearby villages.

Medical camps were conducted in villages called Basal, Anshi and Bankolli villages near Kaiga site.

6.6.5. Renovation of existing pathway leading to paddy fields of Mallapur

The paddy fields are located adjacent to the Kaiga Township boundary. The pathway leading to the paddy fields runs all along the boundary wall of the township on the bank of a fully flowing stream. This pathway is the only access to the paddy fields. It used to get eroded during monsoon due to the overflowing stream. The paddy farmers from Mallapur land affected families of Kaiga Project were badly affected due to this. This project was taken-up to give an all season access to the paddy fields to the villagers from the main road of Mallapur village. The improved access is expected to enhance agricultural activities resulting in better livelihood to the farmers.

6.6.6. Distribution of play items to Anganwadi Kendras

With a view to attract children to the Anganwadi Kendras, toys and play items were provided to 39 Anganwadi Kendra within 16 km radius of Kaiga Site.

6.6.7. Kaiga Shiksha Aadhar-2013

With a view to promote education and reduce school dropout cases, project Kaiga Shiksha Adhar 2013 was taken up on the eve of Republic Day - 2013. Under this project school bags, notebooks and dictionaries were distributed to the nearby Anganwadi Kendras, Primary and High School students. In all 550 children of Anganwadi Kendras and 1037 students of class 1st to 4th standard were given school bags. A dictionary and a set of 10 note books were distributed to 1,377 students of class 5th to 10th standard.

6.6.9. Augmentation of school teachers at government primary schools

To tide over the shortage of school teachers in government schools, 16 Nos. of school teachers from nearby villages were engaged for imparting education/overall child development in schools under CSR programme from 15th July 2012 to 31st March 2013 through an NGO - Karwar Rural Woman and Children Development Society (KRWCDs).



6.6.11. Construction of bridge across the river at Goyar village

A 65 M long bridge suitable for Light Motor Vehicle movement has been constructed and handed over to Grampanchayat Gotegali. During the rainy season that lasts for about six months, Goyar village used to get cut off from the mainland resulting into sufferings for villagers. This bridge would be very useful for the pedestrian and light motor vehicle movement. It would keep Goyar village connected to the mainland throughout the year.

6.7 CSR at KKNPP

Budget provision of ₹ 800 lakh was sanctioned for KKNPP CSR programme for the year 2012-13. Out of this, ₹ 593.25 lakh was sanctioned for various basic infrastructural projects identified for execution through DRDA. These projects covered 19 out of 45 Village Panchayaths within the 16 Km radius of KKNPP in Radhapuram Taluk. In consultation with state government, 125 of these infrastructural and educational projects were taken up for execution under Self Sufficient Scheme of the government. Under this scheme, 2/3 amount is contributed by the state government and only 1/3 amount of ₹ 197.75 lakh was contributed under KKNPP CSR programme. Out of the total 125 projects, 54 projects have been completed and the rest are in different advanced stages of completion. In addition to the above, 19 more project were taken-up by KKNPP for implementation by itself or through appropriate agencies. Most of these projects are also completed. Highlights of some of the major projects are given below.

6.7.1. Replacement of water purification (RO) plant at Sri Kanya Gurukulam Asharam at Pazhavor, Tirunelveli

Sri Kanya Gurukulam Asharam at Pazhavor, Tirunelveli is a charitable organization. It was established in 1952. Presently there are about 130 orphan/destitute children staying and getting education from LKG to professional courses. The existing RO plant was not functioning due to aging and deterioration. It was replaced with a new RO plant to provide clean and safe drinking water to the beneficiaries.

6.7.2 Cement benches at college

Tirunelveli Dakshina Mara Nadar Sangam College is located at T. Kallikulam, Tirunelveli. The college was established in 1971. It has a total strength of 1,552 students. Under CSR programme of KKNPP 16 nos. of cement benches for use of students were installed at the college.

6.7.3. Distribution of notebooks and protective shed for diesel generator

With a view to promote education and reduce school dropout cases, all students at Sri Kanya Gurukulam Asharam at Palzavoor, Tirunelveli were provided with notebooks. About 130 orphans/destitute children are presently staying and getting their educated form LKG to the professional courses at this Asharam.

A 62 KVA diesel generator available with the Asharam was located in open area. Under CSR programme of KKNPP, it was also provided a protective shed.

6.7.4. Development at RTO Vallioor

Facilities were augmented for convenience of local people at Regional Transport Office (RTO), Vallioor. Around 150 persons are expected to be benefited everyday by using these facilities.

6.7.5. Strengthening and black topping of Kaduthula road in Vijayapathi Village Panchayath

One layer of WBM (Water Bound Macadam) and black topping of the approach road of 3.75m width for a length of 350m was laid at Kaduthula village located in Vijayapathi Panchayath through DRDA (Tamil Nadu State Government) under Self Sufficient Scheme (SSS). Around 350 villagers will be benefited by improved access to the village.

6.7.6. Cement concrete road at Arasarkulam in Vijayapathi Village Panchayath

The cement concrete road with 4m width and 180m length was laid at Arasarkulam village located in Vijayapathi Panchayath. This was executed through DRDA (Tamil Nadu State Government) under Self Sufficient Scheme (SSS). Around 560 villagers are expected to be benefited from project.

6.7.7. Cement concrete road at Pandarakudi in Udayathoor Village Panchayath

The cement concrete road with 3.0m width and 300m length was laid at Pandarakudi village located in Udayathoor Panchayath. This was executed through DRDA (Tamil Nadu State Government) under Self Sufficient Scheme (SSS). Around 300 villagers will be benefited by improved access provided by this project.

6.7.8. Compound wall, bore well and hand pump to Burial Ground in Parameswarapuram Village Panchayath

Concrete compound wall of 120m length and 1.5m height was constructed at burial ground in Parameswarapuram Village Panchayath. A 6" bore well with the depth of 125m along with hand pump was also installed at the burial ground for ready supply of water to the users. This project was of the executed through DRDA (Tamil Nadu State Government) under Self Sufficient Scheme (SSS). Around 1,725 persons are expected to be benefited by this project.

6.7.9. Construction of Drainage in Chidambarapuram Village Panchayath

A concrete drainage system of 0.60m width and 130m length was constructed at Athukurichi village in Chidambarapuram Panchayath. This project was executed through DRDA (Tamil Nadu State Government) under Self Sufficient Scheme (SSS). Around 380 villagers of Athukurichi village will be benefited by using this drainage facility.

6.7.10. Bore well based water supply system with Syntex tank at Ammaiappa Nagar in Chidambarapuram-Yacoopuram Panchayath

Bore well of 6" dia width and 150m depth with pump room including 1000 litre capacity syntex water tank was constructed. Also, 700m long supply line of 3" dia was laid for the supply of drinking at Ammaiappa Nagar located in Chidambarapuram – Yacoopuram, Panchayath. About 186 persons of Ammaiappa Nagar will be benefited by the water supply system.

6.7.11. Construction of Retaining wall at Theppakulam in T. Karunkulam Village Panchayath

To prevent flooding of water inside the village the retaining wall of 3.5m height and 80m length was constructed at Theppakulam in T. Karunkulam village located in T. Karunkulam Panchayath. Around 1,310 villagers of T. Karunkulam village will be benefited by this facility.

7 Monitoring and Audit

The CSR projects of the units were monitored on quarterly basis during the year. An internal audit committee was constituted to independently audit the work of CSR committees at different sites. The committee has since completed audit and submitted its report. In addition to this, senior officials had visited several units and the nearby villages to interact with villagers and to assess the CSR works. Independent evaluation of CSR programme of the Corporation is being planned to be started shortly.

8 Result / Impact

A comprehensive assessment of the impact the CSR programme has made on the quality of life of the local people is being planned. Meanwhile, the interactions of CSR teams and senior executives with the local population indicate that they have a feeling of being taken care of, they have expressed happiness over better medical facilities and they are now more open to request facilities they need. The CSR projects have also helped in establishing a channel of effective communication with the local population near the units of NPCIL. Skill development initiatives to help generate income for the village people are being emphasised in the future CSR programme of NPCIL for significant economic betterment of villagers.

9 Challenges

For winning over the sceptics and opponents of nuclear power as well as for making a meaningful impact on quality of life of local population, the CSR programme needs to be implemented at a faster speed. Although monetary resources are available, dedicated manpower at units may help for effective and expeditious implementation. In certain localities near the units, the people have unrealistic expectations and thus they are resisting CSR projects being undertaken by NPCIL. On some occasion lack of consensus was also found among the village representatives due to difference in opinions. Better public awareness and communication can help resolve such situations. Also, interfaces with state government agencies, NGOs and Gram Panchayats need to be strengthened.

10 Conclusion

There has been a significant increase in the number of CSR projects as well as resources earmarked for them during the year. These projects adequately cover the needs of the local population around the units. The number of completed CSR projects was 70 out of 306 projects initiated. Remaining CSR projects are in progress. As a result, fund utilization of CSR works for the financial year 2012-2013 was about 20%. The CSR project implementation needs to be speeded up by all the sites so that funds can be utilized. Towards this end, brisk project implementation will be required in the next financial year and accordingly measures are planned to be taken up. NPCIL has planned to take-up baseline surveys around all the sites. Skill development projects are also planned to be implement around all the sites for economic betterment of the local population.


