a) Master in Public Health (MPH)

The MPH program seeks to provide students with an in depth understanding of issues in public health principles and practice, and apply this to the specific challenges in delivery, research, planning and management of health services in their national context. It is a 4 semesters program wherein 2 semesters are common to all the students of MPH. Both the semesters majorly deals with Biostatistics and Health Policies. In the 3rd semester the students go on to choose a specialization of their interest. The various specializations offered are:

- Health Management Systems
- IT & Healthcare

The 4th semester completely dedicated for a practicum thereby providing the students with relevant industry experience for about 6 months. The students would submit their dissertation to highlight their learning expertise in the Industry and viva voce whereby they defend and actualize their practical acumen earned.

The learning outcomes of the MPH program are:

- Thorough understanding of global and national public health issues
- Insight into the Health systems and their potential impacts on future public health policy directions in both developed and developing nations
- Comprehensive understanding of the tools available to systematically assess and evaluate health needs
- Critical awareness of how the research process may be applied in the study of public health

b) M Sc. Biostatistics & Epidemiology (MBE)

The curriculum of the programme focuses on the integration of major components of Epidemiology and Biostatistics and its application in Public Health. Students are expected to apply their knowledge by conducting a research study and writing a comprehensive thesis supervised by a committee.

The MBE program seeks to provide students with an in depth understanding of principles of epidemiology and biostatistics and use these subjects to characterize health of a population. The program aims at providing individuals the requisite knowledge and quantitative skills to design and conduct epidemiologic studies, manage and analyze data and use the results to recommend appropriate health interventions. With advent of modern computing facility, methods of these two subjects have been gaining increasing worldwide prominence as an important discipline of medical research.

It is a 4 semester program in that 4th semester students are completely dedicated for a practicum thereby providing the students with relevant industry experience for about 6 months. The students would submit their dissertation to highlight their learning expertise in the industry and vivo voce whereby they defend and actualize their practical acumen earned.

The learning outcomes of the MBE program are:

- Thorough understanding of advanced and emerging fields of epidemiology.
- To develop a research protocol, ethical guidelines for conducting scientific research, electronic based data management and analysis.
- To plan, design and conduct experiments efficiently and effectively, and analyze the resulting data using various statistical software to obtain objective conclusions.

c) MBA/MPH

MBA / MPH in Collaboration with faculty expertise from Haas School of Management & Berkeley School of Public Health , University of California , Berkeley. It is an accelerated full time 3 year program leading to award of both Management (MBA) and Public Health (MPH) degrees. The course gives them the leverage to specialize both in Public Health and Management to make them leaders in the Healthcare system.

d) M S Clinical Trials

The need for rigorous evaluation of components of health care is increasingly recognized worldwide. Management of Clinical Trials in a CRO is very essential. This course is suitable for both those wishing to gain an overall understanding of trials before moving into the field, and aim to broaden their role in the design, management, analysis and reporting of clinical trials.

e) Ph. D
