- Chancellor Mr. Kumar Mangalam Birla on his visit to BITS Pilani on 12-14 Nov 2011, announced a Rs. 400 crore modernization plan for BITS Pilani, Pilani campus which is the largest single infrastructural modernization plan in the history of India.
- This ambitious plan will include the construction of an underground academic block designed by a world's leading architect and construction of new hostels, new staff flats, recreational zones, pedestrian bridges, sunken zones, an amphitheatre with 4500 sitting capacity and renovation of existing infrastructure and lots more...
- BITS Strategic plan is working towards making BITS Pilani one of the top 3 colleges in India and top 25 in Asia !!



Project Parivartan



- Architects were appointed in January 2011,
- Master Plan has been finalised.
- Targeted completion dates are:
 - Oct 2014 for the New Academic Building (130,000 sqft),
 - Dec 2015 for the Modernisation and Re-architecture of the existing facilities (Academic Buildings; Student, Faculty, Staff Housing; Recreation and other facilities; Roadways and Infrastructure)

Project Parivartan aims at a complete transformation of the Pilani Campus while retaining the legacy "look and feel".

Internal accruals and Bridge Loans will happen over the next 10 years




