The community college will develop curriculum and arrange for skill intensive training / teaching for the learners belonging to the category-2 and 3 as above during the first six months who will be assessed and certified for NSQF Level 4 of skill competency by concerned SSC at the end of first semester. However, learners <br> belonging to category-1 will not require such certification as they <br> already have NSQF level 4 certificates in same industry sector/ job role required for specified skill credits. All the learners continuing to Diploma courses or further will be treated at par from second semester onwards. Students may exit after six months with a CC Certificate (NSQF Level 4) or may continue for diploma or advanced diploma level courses. An academic progression for the students in vocational stream is illustrated below: <br> Category-4: Students who have qualified equivalent examination from ITI in the same field may also be considered eligible. <br> Equal weightage, at par with other subjects, would be given to vocational subjects at +2 level while considering candidates for admission |
