

SCHEME OF CAREER AWARD FOR YOUNG TEACHERS

OBJECTIVE

The purpose of the scheme is to identify young talented teachers who have established competence in their area of specialization. The scheme helps them in promoting their professional growth by enabling them to devote maximum time in research and study with minimum teaching responsibilities.

ELIGIBILITY

The Awards are offered to the teachers working in the Institutions/Universities/Colleges of Technical Education (TE) specially Engineering & Technology, Architecture, Town Planning, Management, Pharmacy, Applied Arts & Crafts and such other subject under the definition of TE as per the specially Engineering & Technology, Architecture, Town Planning, Management, Pharmacy, Applied Arts & Crafts and such other subjects under the definition of TE as per the AICTE Act, 1987. The awardee can also work at an institution other than his/her parent institution.

Teachers having post graduate degree as minimum with consistently good academic career and a demonstrated aptitude with commitment to research work, shall be eligible for the award. The age limit for the award is 35 years as on 1st July of the year of award. Relaxation in age upto 5 years for women, handicapped and weaker section may be made by AICTE consistent with national policies.

TENURE

The award is for a period of three years and this period should be devoted to work on the project only with a teaching load of minimum of 6 hours and maximum of 10 hours either in the parent institution or host institution. The Council shall pay to the awardee his/her full salary and allowances and the parent institution shall utilize the fund, they would have spent on salary and allowances of the awardee, for strengthening the research facilities except to the extent it is spent on adhoc appointments needed for relieving of his/her teaching load. The awardee shall be treated as on duty and therefore shall continue to earn normal increments and maintain his/her seniority in his/her institution/university/college.

HONORARIUM & RESEARCH GRANT

The award shall include full salary plus other allowances. In addition of the full salary and other allowances of the awardee, a research grant of upto Rs. 3.00 lakhs (Rupees three lakhs only) will be given for purchase of equipment including personal computer/informatics services, books/journals, field work, travel in India and securing necessary technical services as per University/College/Institution rules, during the period of the award.

EQUIPMENT, BOOKS & JOURNALS

The above grant will be released by AICTE through University/Institution/College. Any equipment, books, journals purchased under the scheme shall be the property of the Institution/University/College. The books and journals can be retained by the awardee, if he/she so desires.

SERVICE PRIVILEGES

The awardee is entitled for holidays and to such other service privileges from the Institution as per his/her entitlement in the University/College/Institution.

FEEDBACK

The awardee shall submit a report on the prescribed proforma, each year on the project through the Head of the Department/Institution which would be reviewed by an Expert Committee, to which AICTE calls 'Mid

Term Appraisal'. The suggestions and views of the experts of 'Mid Term Appraisal' would be conveyed to the awardee for effective implementation of the project.

The final report of the project should be submitted by the awardee through the Head of the Department/Institution to the AICTE.

Only 20 career awards are available per year. If the awardee works at an institution other than his/her parent institution, all arrangements and conditions shall be agreed to among host and parent institution and awardee.
