Admission Policy for Post Graduate Programme in Management (PGP) Academic Year 2018-20

Admission criteria of Indian Institute of Management Kashipur

This document elaborates the admission criteria that have been developed at Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Kashipur for identifying the right candidates for admission to its Post Graduate Programme (PGP) in Management. The process that is being adopted for selecting the students for PGP at IIM Kashipur for the academic year 2018-20 involves two stages: Stage 1 applies to all eligible candidates who have appeared for Common Admission Test (CAT –2017) and have applied for admission to IIM Kashipur. Stage 2 applies to shortlisted candidates from Stage 1. Sufficient numbers of candidates belonging to different categories are shortlisted in Stage 1 for meeting the Government of India norms on reservation.

Stage 1: Shortlisting of candidates for Personal Appearance (WAT & PI) Process

IIM Kashipur Admission Committee will decide the number of candidates who would be called for Personal Appearance (WAT & PI) process on the basis of criteria prepared for each category. However, if the actual number of short-listed candidates were found to be less (more) than the required number of candidates to be called for Personal Appearance (WAT & PI) process category-wise, then the overall as well as section-wise minimum score would be reduced (increased) to get the desired number of candidates.

The 11 IIMs (IIM Amritsar, IIM Bodhgaya, IIM Jammu, IIM Kashipur, IIM Raipur, IIM Ranchi, IIM Rohtak, IIM Sambalpur, IIM Sirmaur, IIM Trichy and IIM Udaipur) have decided to adopt a common process of WAT & PI to be coordinated this year by IIM Rohtak.

Stage 2: Generation of Merit List

Stage 2a: Personal Appearance (WAT & PI) Process

The following weights will be assigned to the Personal Appearance (WAT & PI) process as shown in Table 2a.

The Grand Total (C) will be used to rank students according to their merit.
