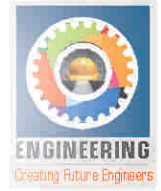

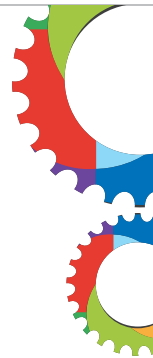

Session-1: Class IX

After completion of class IX syllabus, from November 2019 syllabus of class X will start and continue till 31st January, 2020 and then the students will be made free to writing their class IX final exam.

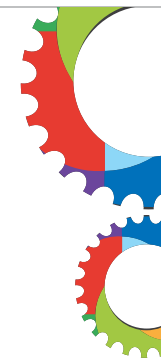

5. For the Purpose of Calculation of Refund;

- The date of commencement of the batch shall be considered and not the date of joining of any student in the institute.
- The date of batch commencement at the branch / centre and submission of application for withdrawal and refund shall be considered for the purpose of calculation and refund, instead of date of student joining and date of last class attended by the student.
- The refund of tuition fee shall be calculated based on the amount of fee installment mentioned in prospectus regardless of scholarship granted to any student / availed by any student.
- If any student from Foundation Courses (Class IX & X studying students) who has been given iTutor Video Lecture SD card, wishes to leave the course before December, an additional amount equivalent to ₹ 2500/-, over and above the applicable amount to be deducted in terms of the Refund Policy- shall be deducted from his/her refund payout.
