The Ambedkar University Delhi invite online applications from the eligible candidates for the post of Assistant Director of Physical Education/Sports in the Academic Pay Level 10 with the initial pay of Rs.57700 and other admissible allowances as per norms.

About us:

Ambedkar University Delhi (AUD) is a unitary University established in 2008 by the Government of the National Capital Territory of Delhi. The University is mandated to focus on research and higher learning in the Social Sciences, Humanities and Liberal Studies. AUD is recognized under Section 12B of the UGC Act and has been accredited by NAAC with an 'A' grade. We are currently functioning from three campuses in Delhi, at Kashmere Gate, Karampura and Lodhi Road Campus, and are in the process of setting up permanent campuses at Dheerpur and Rohini.

AUD offers undergraduate, postgraduate and research degree programmes. AUD has a special interest in interdisciplinary areas of studies. We follow a system of appointing teachers to the University and deploying their services concurrently in more than one School / Centre / Programme / Campus according to their expertise and interests as well as the needs of the University. Every teacher of the University, no matter in which School s/he is deployed, is concurrently also on the faculty of the School of Undergraduate Studies.

Eligibility

The Minimum Qualification for the post of Assistant Director of Physical Education/Sports are as under: -

A.

- i) A Master's Degree in Physical Education and Sports or Physical Education or Sports Science with 55% marks(or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, whatever the grading system is followed).
- ii) Record of having represented the university/college at the inter-university/inter-collegiate competitions or the State and/or national championships.
- iii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test(NET) conducted by the UGC or CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET, or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in Physical Education or Physical Education and Sports or Sports Science, in accordance with the University Grants Commission(Minimum Standards Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be:

Provided that, candidates registered for the Ph.D. degree prior to July,11,2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-Laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. degree holders shall be exempted from the requirement of NET /SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- a) The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode;
- b) The Ph. D thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) Open Ph. D viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph. D work out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers in conference/seminar, based on his/her Ph. D work

The fulfilment of these conditions (a) to (e) is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean(Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

v) Passed the physical fitness conducted in accordance with these Regulations.

B. An Asian game or commonwealth games medal winner which has a degree at least at Post-Graduation level.

Mandatory Physical Fitness Test Norms as per UGC Regulations for Director/Deputy Director/Assistant Director of Physical Education

Physical Fitness Test Norms

- (a) Subject to the provisions of the UGC Regulations, 2018, all candidates who are required to undertake the physical fitness test are required to produce a medical certificate certifying that he/she is medically fit before undertaking such tests.
- (b) On the production of such certificate mentioned in sub-Clause (a) above, the candidate would be required to undertake the physical fitness test in accordance with the following norms:

Guidelines, Instructions and Important Information:

1. AUD follows the norms of appointment and regulations issued by the UGC (UGC Minimum Regulations 2018) and adopted by the Board of Management of AUD from time to time. Reservations will be in accordance with the rules of the Government of NCT of Delhi. Conditions of service, incentives and allowances are similar to those at Central Universities.
2. Applications must be submitted online using the AUD online Job portal which can be accessed at this address: aud.ac.in/careers.
3. There is no application fee. Separate application must be submitted against each position. Specify the position for which you wish to be considered and clearly identify your area(s) of research specialization.
4. Before filling the online application, please read the instructions carefully and get the copies of documents and published work ready for uploading along with the form.
5. The prescribed qualifications and experience shall be the minimum, and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same shall not entitle him/her to be called for interview. The University shall have the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable level on the basis of better or higher qualifications and experience than the minimum prescribed, and on the basis of other relevant factors.

6. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes(OBC-Delhi)(Non Creamy Layer)/Differently abled(Physically(LD) and visually differently abled) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks(or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based on the qualifying marks without any grace mark procedure.
7. OBC reservation benefit shall be given to only those candidates who are in possession of OBC Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi for the caste recognized as OBC by the Government of NCT of Delhi. Candidates belonging to OBC category would be required to submit the non-creamy layer (NCL) certificate issued from the Competent Authority of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi in case his/her Caste Certificate was issued in the previous financial year(s). The NCL certificate should have been issued in current financial year 2019-2020, i.e., between 01.04.2019 and 31.03.2020 by the Competent Authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi, which has issued the OBC Caste Certificate.
8. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D Degree holder who have obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September,1991.
9. A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall be considered valid.
10. The University shall have the right to:
 - a. Request candidates to present seminars, participate in interaction sessions and/or any other such activities as a part of the selection process;
 - b. Consider *in absentia* the candidature of those who may not have applied;
 - c. Consider in absentia or through use of communication technologies those who may have applied but are not able to appear for the interview;
 - d. Relax any of the qualifications/experience at its discretion;
 - e. Draw reserve panel(s) against the possible vacancies in the near future;
 - f. Offer the post at a level lower than the advertised depending upon the qualifications, experience and performance of the candidate; and
 - g. Not to fill any of the advertised positions.
11. The candidate shall attend the interview at the designated place and time at his own expenses. However, the outstation candidates shall be reimbursed to and fro rail fare (Sleeper Class) for self only by the shortest route on production of valid tickets.

12. Canvassing in any form on behalf of any candidate will lead to disqualification for the current recruitment as well as future recruitment processes to be conducted by the Ambedkar University Delhi.
13. The Selection Committee may decide its own method of evaluating the performance of the candidates in interview.
14. The in-service candidates should apply **through proper channel or submit No Objection Certificate** at the time of interview failing which they will not be allowed to appear in the interview.
15. Incomplete applications in any respect shall not be considered at all.
16. No interim queries regarding interview/selection will be entertained.
17. University will not be responsible for any postal delay at any stage.
18. New Pension Scheme as introduced by the Government of India with effect from 1st January, 2004 shall be applicable to fresh recruits.
19. Selected Candidate shall be liable to be posted at any Campus of the Ambedkar University Delhi depending upon the requirements and exigencies of services.
