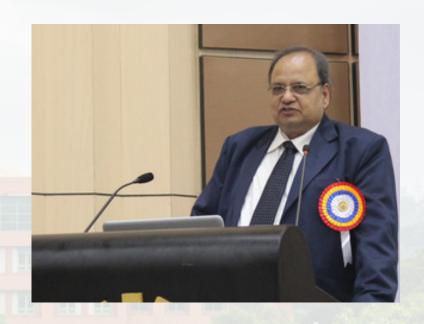
#### MESSAGE FROM DEAN

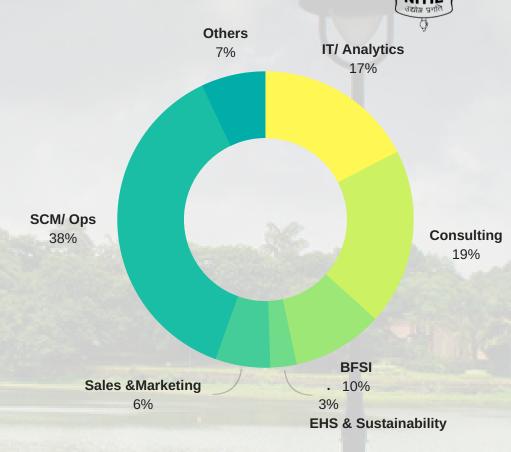
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#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

This year has seen a substantial increase in the number of first time recruiters visiting the campus. The average compensation has remained at 15.83 LPA this year.

This season saw the continuing Strong hold of the institute in the domain of Supply Chain and Operations with 130+ offers. Consulting and IT/Analytics were not far behind and their contribution remained overwhelming with 100 + Offers and 36% of the Batch opting for careers in this domain. 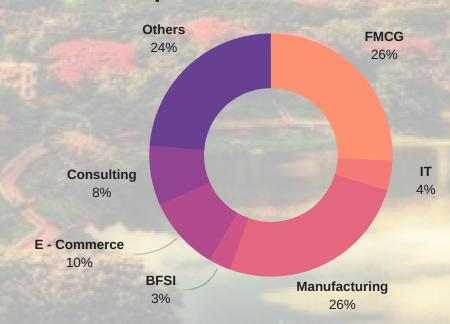

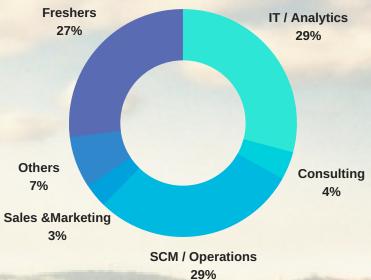

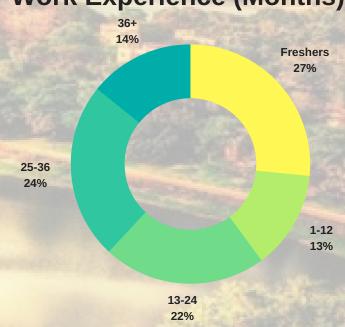
#### **Internship Statistics - Sector Wise**

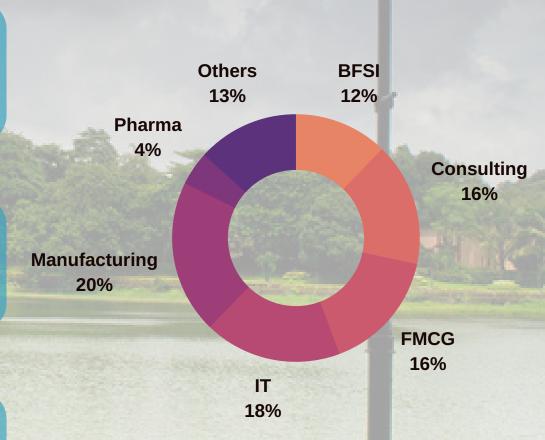

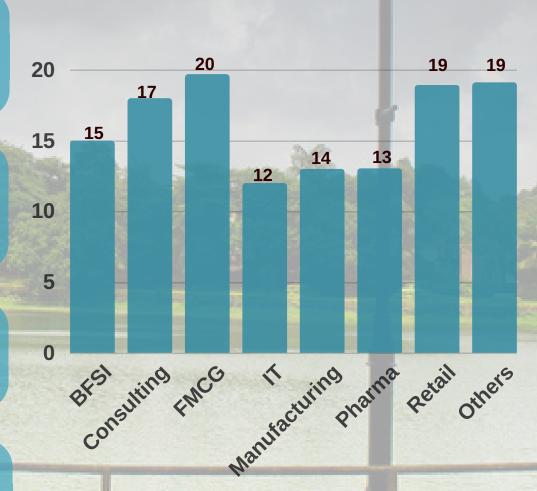
