2.4.1 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- 2.4.1.1 Candidates who have obtained at least 55% Marks in the B.P.Ed. Degree/B.P.Ed. four years Integrated professional Degree are eligible for admission.
- 2.4.1.2 The reservation in seats and relaxation in the qualifying marks for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Govt. of India.
- 2.4.1.3 Candidates placed in compartment / supplementary in the qualifying examination are ineligible for admission.

NOTE: Candidates are to note that no call letter for the entrance test shall be sent to them by post. Candidates who are sure that they fulfill eligibility conditions may report for admission test as per the stipulated programme at LNUPE, Gwalior.

2.4.2 WOMEN CANDIDATES

Married Women are also eligible for admission to M.P.Ed. course. In case, a women candidate conceives during the course, she will have to discontinue her studies for a minimum period of one year. She can join back afresh from the beginning of the semester keeping the guidelines pertaining to the maximum duration of the course in mind.

2.4.3 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission shall be made on merit, on the basis of Marks obtained in the entrance test as per the policy of the University.

2.4.4 ADMISSION TEST (200 MARKS)

The admission test includes the following areas:

- 2.4.4.1 **Physical Fitness** : **25 Marks**
- 2.4.4.2 **Sports proficiency** : **25 Marks**
 (For Sports Proficiency, a candidate may select any one the following sports)
 Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Cricket
 Football, Gymnastics, Hockey, Judo, Swimming,
 Tennis, Volleyball, Yoga & Weightlifting
- 2.4.4.3 **Written Test** : **150 Marks**
 - 2.4.4.3.1 General Knowledge & Reasoning : 25 Marks
 - 2.4.4.3.2 Professional Competence : 100 Marks
 - 2.4.4.3.3 Sports Knowledge in a desired area of Specialization : 25 Marks



2.4.5 PROCEDURE FOR CONDUCTING TESTS

2.4.5.1 Physical Fitness: The Marks will be awarded in Physical Fitness on the basis of performance in 50 meters sprint, standing broad jump, over head back throw (medicine ball) and 1000 meters run/walk. The norms are given in **ANNEXURE –III (A) to III (D)**.

2.4.5.2 Written Test: The Duration of Written Test will be **3 hours** and shall comprise of Sport Knowledge, General Knowledge & Reasoning, Professional Competence and Knowledge in the area of Sport Specialization. For sports knowledge test, the candidate should select one sport/ game from the option mentioned at 2.4.4.2. The Syllabus for Sports knowledge and professional competence is placed at **ANNEXURE – XIII (A) & XIII (B)** respectively. The questions of written test will be objective and subjective (short answer) in nature.

2.4.6 Award of Bonus Marks

All those candidates who have won positions at the Junior/Senior Nationals (organized by respective federation) and All India/Inter-Zonal Inter-University Tournament will receive Bonus Marks as per the criteria given below:

2.4.6.1 Represented India in any game/sport
Sponsored by IOA/Federation and in
games and sports. 10 Marks

2.4.6.2 Position holders at Inter-State
Championship Organized by Association/ Federation

1 st Place	10 Marks
2 nd Place	09 Marks
3 rd Place	08 Marks

2.4.6.3 Position Holder at All India Inter-University
Competitions/ Junior National Competitions

1 st Place	08 Marks
2 nd Place	07 Marks
3 rd Place	06 Marks

Note:

1. The bonus marks will be provided in only those games/sports, which are in the competition list of Association of Indian Universities (AIU).
2. The obtained position must be during last four academic sessions. (i.e. July 2008 to April- 2012).

2.4.8 UNIFORM

Students of M.P.Ed.-I Semester will be required to possess the Uniform as per University rules, which are mentioned at **ANNEXURE - X** during the semester. The University will provide Uniform to the students on actual cost basis.

2.4.11 A candidate should complete the requirement for obtaining the degree within a period of 4 years from the date of admission to M.P.Ed.-I Semester.

Note:

1. Thesis in lieu of one optional paper may be opted by those who secure at least 60% Marks in aggregate in M.P.Ed.-I and II Semester and subject to approval by the competent committee.
2. Optional papers shall be offered depending upon the administrative feasibility.
3. Game/Sports chosen for Sports Specialization in M.P.Ed.-I Semester shall continue up to M.P.Ed.-IV Semester.
4. For Part-B (Sports Specialization), the student will be offered specialization only in the game, which he/she has opted during admission test.
