6.7.2 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- 6.7.2.1 The aspirants should have obtained minimum 45% (40% for SC/ST) Marks in Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) or Bachelor Degree in any discipline from a recognized University and also recognized by the University.
- 6.7.2.2 Married women shall be eligible for admission to the course. (In case, a woman candidate admitted to the course gets pregnant and reaches the stage of expectancy during the course, she will have to discontinue her studies for a minimum period of the one year).



6.7.3 ADMISSION PROCEUDURE/TESTINGAREAS

6.7.3.1 **Practical Skills**

50 Marks

The applicants will be tested for their basic fitness in relation to yogic practices and Marks will be awarded by a panel of teachers on the basis of their performance.

6.7.3.2 General Awareness (Written Test & Interview) : 50 Marks

Basic awareness in the field of yoga will be tested in objective type written test having a weightage of 40 Marks. Interview shall have a weightage of 10 Marks.

NOTE:

LNUPE

- (I) **Candidates are to note that no call letter for the entrance test shall be sent to them by post.** Candidates who are sure that they fulfill eligibility conditions, may report for admission test as per the stipulated programme at the test center opted by them.
- (II) Seats will be filled according to the merit of Admission Test.
- (III) The candidate must secure minimum of 45% i.e. the qualifying mark in the Admission Test.
