



## **8 CENTRE FOR ADVANCED STUDIES**

### **8.1 INTRODUCTION**

The Centre was established in order to cater to the need of research in the area of Physical Education/Sports and Allied areas and to serve as a nodal agency for research in Physical Education & Sports. In addition, the Centre also orients the scholars in utilizing various scientific equipments.

### **8.3 PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION TO MASTER OF PHILOSOPHY (M.Phil) IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

### **8.4 COURSE WORK**

Admission to M.Phil shall be through an Entrance Test. The recipient of JRF from UGC shall be awarded 10% marks as Bonus in entrance test. After Interview of the M.Phil scholar, only the best selected on merit shall be admitted to course work.

The course work commences from July 20, 2012 and will be over by the end of February 2013. The course work shall be flexible however focus would be on Research Methodology, Applied Statistics, and computer application along with orientation in instrumentation. The scholars shall have to appear in final Exam in February/March 2013 and upon clearing the course with minimum 55% marks, the admission will be confirmed to M.Phil Course.

## **8.6 ELIGIBILITY**

The candidate should have obtained M.P.Ed. (Master of Physical Education of two years duration) or any other equivalent degree from a recognized University, recognized by this University. Further the candidates seeking admission to M.Phil should have scored minimum 55% marks (50% for SC/ST candidates) in M.P.Ed or equivalent examinations.

## **8.7 ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- (i) **Duration of the test** : **2 Hrs.**
- (a) Research Methodology & Applied Statistics : 60 min.
- (b) Specialization : 60 min

**Note:** The written test shall have questions upto the level of M.P.Ed with specific focus on proposed area of specialization, Research Methods & Applied Statistics. The test shall have objective type questions. (Multiple choice questions).

(ii) **The break-up of marks shall be as follows:**

- (a) Research Methods : 30 Marks
- (b) Applied Statistics : 30 Marks
- (c) Specialization : 40 Marks

## **8.8 QUALIFYING MARKS**

Proposed Minimum 55% marks (50% for SC/ST) shall be mandatory to qualify the RET.

**8.12 AWARD OF M.PHIL. DEGREE**

A candidate must obtain at least 50% marks in each theory paper, and dissertation separately. After the submission, the dissertation shall be sent to outside examiners. Viva-voce examinations will be conducted and successful candidates will be awarded M.Phil Degree.
