PROFILE

EHESP has four missions:

- To produce graduates capable of performing the functions of administration, management, inspection, and monitoring in public health fields, including social medicine.
- To provide through partnerships advanced education in public health
- To contribute to research in public health.
- To promote international relations, particularly through exchanges with like institutions.

The ambition that led to the creation of EHESP, established under the public health law of August 2004, was to build a great institution of public health in France, one that would exert major international influence. With a permanent, full-time faculty of 80, the school also collaborates with related academic and professional circles. Some 1,800 adjunct faculty contribute to EHESP's work.

Main formations

Programs open to international students :

- **Master of Public Health (MPH):** This Master, thoroughly interdisciplinary and international purpose, is taught in English by an international faculty team trained in the world's leading public health institutions. Admission is open to holders of a French licence (or equivalent) in any field: social science, economics, law, health sciences, or engineering. The program requires 2 years of study (120 ECTS credits), but holders of a 1-year master's degree may apply to be admitted directly into the second year. www.mph.ehesp.fr
- **Europubhealth:** A 2-year program, recognized by the Erasmus Mundus program. The program is a joint effort of 6 European universities and schools of public health (including 2 in France). Enrollment is open to holders of a licence or equivalent. www.europubhealth.org
- **Sanitary engineer:** A 1-year program designed chiefly for graduates of French engineering programs (or the equivalent) who wish to specialize in environmental health.
- **Executive Health MBA:** Combining basic education in public health with management, EHESP's Executive Health MBA teaches participants to develop institutional policies and strategies that advance and protect public health. The program is designed for deputy directors and managers in the health sector who have had some professional experience.

• Other degrees: EHESP confers six master's degrees in cooperation with other institutions:

- Master in law, health, and ethics (M2)
- Master in leadership of public health policies and initiatives
- Master in health education for children, adolescents, and young adults
- Master in health assessment
- Master in analysis and management of health institutions
- Master in clinical nursing sciences
- Master in public health and environmental risks
- Mastère spécialisé (specialized master) in environmental health challenges for localities and firms

Interdisciplinary doctoral program for health professionals: Authorized to grant degrees in 2008, the public health doctoral program coordinated by EHESP brings together doctoral departments from nine institutions in complementary fields—among them public health, law, epidemiology, social sciences, and management.

Research

Research at EHESP occurs within 6 departments of education and research and of 6 interdisciplinary centers that operate in partnership with other institutions. Priority topics include the analysis of public health policies; risk and risk management; long-term care, vulnerability, and Alzheimer's disease; biodiversity, climate change, and infectious diseases; evidence-based health care; and international and humanitarian health.

Strengths

As a reference in public health sector, EHESP provides traditional degree programs in all facets of public health and sanitation. Its graduate programs (master, doctorate) are strengthened by high-level international partnerships.
