REFUND POLICY (INCLUDES ON-LINE CCSU COURSES):**Full-time Matriculated Students**

Full-time students who change their status after the start of classes to part-time and then withdraw during the first week of classes will be assessed a 10% withdrawal penalty.

January 13, 2013 - Last day to withdraw from University with 100% refund.

January 22, 2013 - Last day to withdraw from University with 90% refund.

January 28, 2013 - Last day to withdraw from University with 60% refund.

February 4, 2013 - Last day to change status to part time.

February 11, 2013 - Last day to withdraw from University with 40% refund.

Part-time Matriculated Students

January 22, 2013 - Last day to change status to full time.

**Courses meeting for a full semester
(includes on-line courses):**

January 22 - Last day to drop with 100% refund.

January 28 - Last day to drop with 60% refund.

February 11 - Last day to withdraw with 40% refund.

No refund after February 11.

Courses meeting for eight weeks:

100% of tuition and general university fee prior to the second class meeting.

60% of tuition and general university fee prior to the third class meeting.

40% of tuition and general university fee prior to the fourth class meeting.

No refund after the beginning of the fourth class meeting.

NOTE: The registration fee is non-refundable.

Please allow approximately 2 to 4 weeks for processing of refund checks. Credit card adjustments are credited to the cardholder's account.

**CSU BOARD OF TRUSTEES PROFICIENCY
REQUIREMENT - REMEDIATION COURSES**

MATH 099 (Elementary Algebra) and ENG 099 (Remedial English) are not conventional credit-bearing courses. Although a letter grade that affects the GPA is awarded, the credits do not count toward the number of credits required for graduation. These courses are designed to provide proficiency in English and mathematics to undertake college-level courses.

Students must successfully complete these courses within the first 24 attempted academic credits at CCSU or they will not be allowed to register for courses at CCSU or any other CSU institution. This policy applies to undergraduate matriculated students only.
