- a) All the candidates shall bring crossed demand draft of any bank of Rs.14,500/- drawn in favour of Director, Directorate of Distance Education, University of Jammu, Jammu payable at Jammu along with all requisite documents in original at the time of counselling failing which their counseling shall not be conducted.
- b) List of the documents required at the time of counselling cum admission (original as well as two photocopies of each document).

  2. B.A/B.Sc/B.Com Part Ist, IInd and IIIrd marks card.
  3. B.A/B.Sc/B.Com degree.
  4. M.A/M.Sc./M.Com Mark sheet
  5. M.A/M.Sc./M.Com Degree
  6. Service certificate duly countersigned.
  7. Fresh School Recognition Order.
  8. Provisional certificate or degree of last qualifying examination.
  9. Category Certificate
  10. State Subject Certificate
- d) The merit of candidates is subject to authentication of the original documents at the time of counselling. School recognition certificate and Service certificate shall be subjected to further scrutiny during the counselling. Admission shall be made subject to authentication of the above mentioned documents and other requisite documents.
- e) If any candidate remains absent for counselling on his/her turn as per the merit, he/she will be considered for admission on the subsequent day/days of counselling subject to the availability of seats.
- f) Invitation to counselling shall not guarantee the right to admission.**
- g) Admission is subject to availability of seats.**

## Criteria for Determination of Merit

Admission shall be made on the basis of academic merit of the candidate to be determined out of 100 points in the following manner:

- |    |   |           |
|----|---|-----------|
| a) | In the case of candidates having passed B.A/ B.Sc./B.Com examination under, 10+1+3 or 10+2+2 pattern of Education                         | 80 Points |
| b) | In the case of candidates having passed B.A/ B.Sc./B.Com examination under, 10+2+3/ 10+2+2 with Bridge course/ 10+1+3 with bridge course; | 90 Points |
| c) | In the case of candidates having passed M.A/ M.Sc./M.Com after Bachelors' Degree<br>At (a) or (b) above.                                  | 10 Points |

### NOTE

- (i) The weight age of Post Graduation shall only be given if the candidate has completed M.A/M.Sc./ M.Com.
- (ii) Aggregate marks obtained by a candidate in the examinations mentioned at a, b & c above, as the case may be shall be reduced to the base of the number of points mentioned against each.

### Illustration

If a candidate has obtained 400 marks out of 550 marks, he will have secured 58.18 points out of 80 points as per formula ( $400/550$ ) X 80 = 58.18), likewise 65.45 out of 90 points and 7.27 out of 10 points.

Credit for Master's Degree examination shall be given to a candidate in one subject only to his best advantage.
