- Part A –objective MCQ written examination for selection of Senior Residents (HS) will be held on Sunday 06th December, 2009 from 10.30 AM to 12.00 Noon at BSNV PG College, Charbagh, Lucknow. Based on result of Part-A examination, candidates will be called for Part –B departmental objective test examination. Interview for PDF will be held on 15.01.2010 at 10.00 AM in respective departments.
- 2. The number of Senior Resident (Hospital Services)/PDF posts advertised may increase or decrease.
- 3. Reservation for SR (HS) will apply as per rule. Reservation will be admissible only to candidates having Domicile in the state of Uttar Pradesh. Candidates having Domicile other than Uttar Pradesh will be treated as General category candidates for all purposes.
