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1. INTRODUCTION

All India Post Graduate Medical Entrance Test 2013 (AIPGMET 2013) will be conducted for admission to various Post Graduate Courses conducted at Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Nerul, Navi Mumbai 400706, a constituent college of Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil Vidyapeeth on Thursday, 31st January, 2013 from 12.00 Noon to 3.30 PM.

The college was established in 1989 and is recognized by the Medical Council of India, New Delhi. The college is associated with a 1271 bed teaching hospital in its campus having state of the art facilities for healthcare and treatment

The Admission committee of the Vidyapeeth will be responsible for conduct of the entrance test, declaration of results, counseling and final admission to the courses.

2.2 Approval of some courses/ increase in intake from Government of India & Medical Council of India is expected. Admission to these courses will also be based on the performance of the candidates at the AIPGMET 2013.

2.3 a. General Category: 50 % Seats are in this

- category . Admission to this category will be made on the basis of inter-se-merit of the candidates at AIPGMET 2013
 b. NRI Seats: 50 % of the seats are reserved for NRI quota. Admission to this category will be also on the basis of inter-semerit of the candidates at AIPGMET 2013.

 The candidate desirous of getting
 - admission under this category will have to apply separately on a prescribed form made available on the web site.
- 2.4. Candidate who secures minimum 50% marks at AIPGMET 2013 and satisfies the eligibility norms laid down by respective council shall be eligible for admission to MD/MS/PG Diploma courses
- 2.5 MD and MS courses duration is 3 years and Diploma is 2 years

MODE OF ENTRANCE TEST

- 3.1 The AIPGMET 2013 will be of three and Half hours duration containing 300 multiple choice questions (MCQs). Questions will be single best response objective type with four answer options. Each correct answer will be awarded one mark. There shall be no negative marking for incorrect answers.
- **3.2** The examinations will be conducted in English

3.3 The entrance Test shall be of the standard of M.B.B.S. examinations and shall cover all the subjects of the M.B.B.S. course. The subject wise distribution of MCQs will be as follows

3.4 There is no provision for revaluation of answer books.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1 The candidate must be an Indian National. Nationality Certificate issued by District Magistrate or Additional District Magistrate or Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Valid Passport shall constitute proof of nationality.
- The candidate must have passed M.B.B.S Examinations from recognized Medical College and should have obtained final registration either from the Medical Council of India, New Delhi or Maharshtra state Medical Council after completion of one year rotating internship training.
- The candidate undergoing one year rotating internship training and likely to obtain final registration certificate from Medical Council of India, New Delhi or Maharshtra on or before 15th April 2013 can also appear for the entrance test. Such candidates will be required to submit a certificate from the Principal / Dean of the college regarding the likely date completion of their rotating internship training, failing which their application will be treated as incomplete and shall be rejected.

5. RAGGING

It must be noted that the Institute consider ragging a cognizable offence and will not hesitate to take strong action against the offenders.

Here are extract from the UGC's Committee Report.

Guidelines given by the Vidyapeeth Grants Commission to curb the Menace of Ragging in Universities / Educational Institutions.

The word RAGGING means the act of teasing taunting, playing a practical joke upon someone or holding comic parade and other activities during certain period of a college term to raise money for charity.

Forms of Ragging

Ragging is found to take the following forms (the list is only indicatives and not exhaustive).

Crisp Orders

- · To address seniors as 'Sir';
- To perform mass drill;
- To copy class notes for the seniors;
- · To server various errands;
- To do menial jobs for the same;
- To ask / answer vulgar questions;
- To look at pornographic pictures to shock; the fresher out of their innocence;
- To force to drink alcohol, scalding tea, etc:
- To force to do act with sexual overtones, including homosexual acts;
- To force to do acts which can lead to physical injury / mental torture or death;
- To strip, Kiss ,etc;
- To do other obscenities;

Punishments

The following could be the possible punishments for those who are found guilty of participation in or abetment of ragging. The quantum of punishment shall naturally , depend upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Disciplinary Committee or Court of Law.

- 1. Cancellation of admission.
- 2. Suspension from attending classes.
- 3. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellow ship and other benefits.
- 4. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process.
- 5. Withholding results.
- 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- 7. Expulsion from Hostel.
- 8. Rustication from Institution for period varying from 1to 2 semesters.
- Expulsion from Institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- 10. Fine up to Rs.25,000/-.
- 11. Rigorous imprisonment up to three years.

While the first 10 types of punishments can be awarded by the appropriate authority of the institution itself, the last punishment can be awarded only by court of law. Students / Parents should sign declaration from at the time of counseling given in **Annexure I and Annexure II.**

6. CENTERS FOR ENTRANCE TEST

The Entrance test will be conducted at Mumbai, Navi Mumbai, Pune .
