- I. Seeds and planting materials would be supplied against advance payment depending upon the availability at CIMAP Headquarter/Research Centers.
- II. Before placing order, kindly ensure the availability of the material and obtain the Performa invoice for the same.
- III. Packing and postage will be charged extra.
- IV. Tax/surcharge as applicable will be charged extra.
- V. Payment will be accepted either in cash payable with cashier CIMAP or through demand draft drawn in favor of the Director, CIMAP, Lucknow.
- VI. Above rates are applicable for the planting material to be sold to the Indian buyers for use in India only.
- VII. It is advisable to collect the planting material personally. The seeds/planting material can be dispatched on request on the responsibility of the buyers only.
- VIII. Organic planting material/seeds will be 1.5 times more than normal rates.
- IX. The buyer of the seeds/planting material will be requested to sign the undertaking in the request of the requisition form and bill, a copy of which will be supplied along with the seeds/planting material.
- X. The seeds of the Opium Poppy will be supplied only against the submission of a copy of the permission/license of cultivation.
- XI. If the live material is not lifted in the specified period, the maintenance charges will be charged extra.
- XII. Bulk requirement of the planting material of improved varieties can be met in a project mode under separate terms and conditions to be approved by Director.
