4. **Objectives of the course:**

5. **Eligibility for B.Ed admission**

- A citizen of India who has passed B.A/B.Sc degree examination of Bangalore University or any university in India or abroad recognized as equivalent through 10+2+3 pattern of education obtaining 50% of marks in aggregate of all the subjects he / she has studied for 3 years is eligible for admission to B.Ed course provided.
- He /She has studied at least any **ONE** of the following languages 1. English, 2. Kannada 3. Hindi 4. Urdu 5. Marathi 6. Sanskrit.
- Any **TWO** of the following electives:
 - 1. History 2. Political science 3. Sociology 4. Geography 5. Economics 6. Philosophy 7. Psychology 8. Physics 9. Chemistry 10. Botany 11. Zoology 12. Geology 13. Mathematics 14. English 15. Kannada 16. Hindi 17 Urdu 18 Marathi 19 Sanskrit 20 Micro Biology 21 Bio-Technology 22 Computer Science 23 Electronics 24 Statistics
- In the case of SC / ST, category – I and physically Handicapped students shall be 45% in the aggregate of 3 years of their degree course.

Duration of the course & medium of Instructions:

- The duration of study for B.Ed semester course shall extend over a period of one academic year of **TWO** semester.
- Minimum duration for practice teaching shall be of **06** weeks (Six weeks) which excludes programmes like micro teaching and practice of communication skills.
- The college shall provide instructions in both English and Kannada mediums.
- Student teachers shall opt English or Kannada medium for teaching practice irrespective of their medium of instruction opted for theory papers in our college.
- Student teachers shall opt either English or Kannada medium to write their 1st semester and IInd semester examinations irrespective of their medium selected for theory classes and teaching practice.

METHODS OF TEACHING

The following content cum methods of teaching school subjects can be provided in the college:

1. Kannada, English, Hindi, Sanskrit, History & Civics, Geography, physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biological sciences.
2. Each student teacher shall take two CCM's of teaching shall subjects as per the combination is given below:
 - a) English, History & Civics
 - b) Kannada, History & Civics
 - c) Hindi, History & Civics
 - d) Sanskrit, History & Civics
 - e) Geography, History & Civics
 - f) English & Geography
 - g) Kannada & Geography
 - h) Hindi & Geography
 - i) Sanskrit & Geography
 - j) English & Biological Sciences
 - k) English & Mathematics
 - l) Physics & Mathematics
 - m) Chemistry & Mathematics'
 - n) English & Chemistry
 - o) English & Physics
 - p) Physics
 - q) Biological sciences & Chemistry

ATTENDANCE

1. A student teacher must have 80% of attendance in each semester in all theory papers and practicum
2. A Student teacher must submit all assignments I & II to qualify himself/ herself for appearing 2nd semester examination. Those who do not submit are not eligible to take up examinations.
3. Submissions of assignments, appearing for class tests and participation in practical activities conducted by the college, participation in C L C and excursion are compulsory. Those who fail to do so are not eligible for appearing I & 2nd semester examination.

TEACHING PRACTICE

Every student teacher shall prepare 12+1 lesson plans in each C C M subject which are to be guided and approved by the concerned method master. Minimum duration of practice teaching is 6 weeks followed by lessons & practical examination.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

Bangalore University may or may not coordinating board for inspection of the B.Ed trainees work done during the academic year.

DECLARATION OF RESULTS

A student teacher should obtain minimum 50% of the marks in the aggregate of all core and CCM subjects in the 1st & 2nd Sem. Examination separately to pass the examination. There is no third class in this semester scheme.

He / She has to secure 60% and above of marks in the aggregate of all core and CCM subjects together with 1 & 2nd Sem. To declare the result as first class.

A Candidate who fails in the first and / or second semester examination has to clear in 3 subsequent attempts to have the passing certificate in B.Ed sem. Course provided he / she has secured minimum 50 % of marks in aggregate of core and CCM subjects.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Students should remit the fees within the due dates noted against each. They are informed that their names will be removed from the rolls n the fees are not paid within the due dates.
2. Students are informed that their examination application forms will be registered only if they have remitted the tuition fees or any other fee in full within the prescribed times.
3. If the students get admission through bogus / forged certificates their admission will be cancelled. Criminal action will be taken and fees paid will not be refunded
4. If it is found that any student admitted does not fulfill the conditions If the eligibility for the particular course in which he / she is admitted his / her admission will be cancelled.
5. The students are advise to pay fees to the Secretary SJES Educational Institutions Medahalli Bangalore.
6. Fees once paid shall neither be refunded nor adjusted under any circumstances.

COMMUNITY LIVING CAMP & EXCURSION:

Each student teacher has to compulsorily participate and submit a report on his participation in a 4 days community living camp exclusively conducted at a rural place by the college. The CLC should aim at fostering qualities like collective work, cooperative living fellow feeling, like minded towards rural culture etc., among student teachers. Student teacher must compulsorily participate in CLC which is conducted during first semester.

SJES college of Education shall conduct an excursion in the 2nd semester for a minimum period of 3 days to visit places of educational historical cultural and technical importance each student teacher must compulsorily take part in the excursion and submit a report to the college.
