Scientist across the world have also focused the possibility of reduction of main species of

animals particularly rodents, amphibians and fish for teaching and research activities.

Many countries, including United States, Canada, European Member States and others have already begun search for possible alternatives to face the challenges involving animals in research. The search for alternative strategies such as computer based simulations / modeling / in-vitro techniques are certainly an attractive option in animal experiments to mitigate the pain and distress of these animal species.

The main intent of this seminar-cumworkshop is to create spark and interest in the teaching community dealing with animal experimentation and testing to become active and independent learners in using technology more effectively in an inexpensive manner. The target group for this seminar-cumworkshop include selected group of faculty members who have an exposure to IT to make them modern in their outlook, thinking and behavior. Through invited presentations and Hands-on, this seminar-cum-workshop would address issues that would promote cross fertilization of ideas which also tends to promote the standards of laboratory experiments.
