## A profile



Founded on August 5, 1963, Rangia College ranks among the front line colleges of Assam. Located in a serene atmosphere away from the mainstream urban life, the college provides a natural surrounding conducive to healthy academic pursuits. The college imparts education in three streams- Arts, Science and Commerce. With the commerce stream coming under the system of government financial assistance, the college has been making steady progress both academically and infrastructurally against all kinds of adversities in achieving the

avowed goals and objectives. It is worthwhile to mention that the college which was graded at the B<sup>++</sup> level in NAAC's accreditation in 2004, has successfully undergone the process of reaccreditation in September, 2010 and earned the distinction of upholding its qualitative competence by being graded at the 'B' grade with CGPA of 2.80 on four point scale.

Physically and infrastructurally, the college has achieved quite significantly during all these years even though much has yet to be done. That the college has the potential to contribute towards excellence has been recognised by the department of Science and Technology, Government of India by selecting our college for a grant of the DST special package for the North-East. It is worth mentioning that renovation of the existing science laboratory structure has been going on with the release of phase wise instalment of the grant. Further, a sophisticated, full-fledged computer laboratory has also been setup. Steps have been taken to up grade classrooms with the provision of modern equipments, teaching aids and different software by the financial assistance provided from University Grants Commossion. All the departments will be computerised shortly with net connectivity. Further, BSNL has provided twenty numbers of internet connection which will benefit the students in net accessibility. Rangia College campus will be well connected by wi-fi

system for greater interest of students community and acedemic fraternity. Keeping in view the diversified needs of students, Institute of Distance and Open Learning (IDOL) Centre, Rangia College also offers certain subjects at degree level for Arts and Commerce Stream. College is going to introduce Commerce Stream at Higher Secondary Level including Computer Science & Application as one of the optional subjects approved by AHSEC from this current session with a view to cater the emerging needs of students. Rangia College has established an Institutional Bio-tech HUB sponsered by Department of Biotechnology (DBT), New Delhi with the aim of research in field of biotechnology and introduction of this subject later on. Accordingly, a special package has already been released as first instalment and project is going on. This must indeed be regarded as a significant leap forward to be a stepping stone to further development. The Career-Oriented Certificate course and PGDCA course under the Gauhati University syllabus have been introduced from the session 2009-2010 with the financial support of the U.G.C. With a view to providing wider flexibility to the degree-level science students, Computer Science as a subsidiary subject was introduced in Three year Degree Course [TDC (1+1+1)] Science stream with effect from the 2010-11 academic year.

The journey of the college towards achieving the avowed goal of attaining quality and excellence goes on and on under the able stewardship of a dignified Management with the unstinted sense of commitment from an extremely dedicated faculty and ably supported by a diligent and sincere staff. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell established a few years back, has been providing all the impetus and fillip in the direction of maintenance of internal quality in all the spheres of the college. Needless to mention, the vibrant presence of various units— the N.C.C., Youth Red Cross, the Bharat Scouts and Guides, the N.S.S. etc. have been the embodiment of a notable feature of the corporate life that has gone a long way towards building a congenial atmosphere.

The collegehas followed to the Semester System as introduced by the Gauhati University at degree level from the 2011-12 academic year.

## IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR TDC (THREE YEAR DEGREE COURSE) UNDER SEMESTER SYSTEM, SESSION 2012-2013

1. A TDC shall be of Six Semesters covering three Calendar Years. The schedule for Semester System shall be as follows:

(a)	First, Third and Fifth Semester (Odd Semester)	June 1 - Dec.16
	(including examination)	
(b)	Second, Fourth and Sixth Semester (Even Semester)	Dec. 17 - May 31
	(including examination)	
(c)	Summer Vacation	July 1- July 31

2. Students' performance will be monitored throughout the semester by continuous assessment in the theory and practical courses. Evaluation of the students' performance in each of the theory and practical paper will be based on the following:

Internal Evaluation : 20% External Evaluation : 80%

- 3. Internal evaluation will be based on sessional examination, home assignments, group discussion, seminar presentation and library work in each semester.
- 4. External evaluation will be done through a Final examination at the end of the semester.
- 5. The pass marks in each theory paper is 30% and that in each practical paper is 40%.
- 6. In each paper, students must secure pass marks in both the internal as well as the external evaluation separately.
- 7. A student who could not appear or failed in any semester examination will be allowed to clear the same as follows:
  - (a) First Semester with the regular Third Semester examination.
  - (b) Second Semester with the regular Fourth Semester examination.
  - (c) Third Semester with regular Fifth Semester examination.
  - (d) Fourth Semester with regular Sixth Semester examination.
- 8. A student may be allowed to repeat any one of the theory paper in the First, Second, Third and Fourth Semester and may be allowed for betterment of marks in one paper in the Fifth Semester, provied the student secures less than 45% marks in that paper.
- 9. No repeat / betterment will be allowed in the Practical examination in any semester.

- 10. A student must pass all his Semester examinations, including "Repeat" and "Betterment" chances within five years from the date of admission of the First Semester course. A student will get a maximum of three chances to clear a particular semester.
- 11. In Semester system, there is no scope for a student to appear as a Private candidate in any subject.
- 12. The existing rules that govern the Semester system are subject to change / modification as per Gauhati University notification from time to time.
- N.B.: Any confusion regarding general guidelines, a student get clear it from the concerned authority of the college.

Prospectus and Application Forms are available in the College Office on payment of Rs
150.00/- (Rupees One hundred and fifty) only.
Admission to the college is strictly on merit basis and subject to the approval of the Principal.
Students who have passed HSSLC Examination from Rangia College, they will get preference in the
admission of degree course.
There is reservation of seats for ST, SC, OBC, MOBC and Physically Handicapped as per Govt.
rules. A few seats are reserved for the students having outstanding performances in co-curricular
activities. These seats are allotted on merit cum proficiency in the concerned field. Candidates have
to mention in the Admission Form for the category of reservation for which admission is desired.
Candidates have to submit valid documents from the competent authority if apply under these category.
Candidates are required to produce original Mark sheet of last qualifying examination, Admit
Card and original Pass Certificate from the Head of the institution last attended and Caste
Certificate (if applicable) at the time of interview. Physically Handicapped students must
produce the necessary certificate from the competent authority to that effect. Students, who
passed qualifying examination earlier than the current year, must have to submit a gap
certificate regarding their activities during this period to the satisfaction of the authority.
Admission to the College takes place on the day of the interview on payment of the necessary dues.

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENT:**

#### 1. Admission to H.S. 1st year Course for Arts, Science & Commerce Stream :

All admission is provisional and subject to the approval of G.U./AHSEC.

For admission to the Higher Secondary 1st year Course for Arts, Science & Commerce, a student must pass HSLC conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Assam or any other equivalent examination recognized by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC).

2. Admission to TDC 1st year (1st and 2nd Semester):

Regular classes start as per notification by the Principal.

- A. Arts Admission to the TDC 1st yar(1st and 2nd Semester) Course shall be open to those students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination in Arts / Science / Commerce of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) or any other equivalent examination recognized by Gauhati University.
- **B. Science -** Admission to the TDC 1st year (1st and 2nd Semester) Course shall be open to those students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination in Science to the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) or any other equivalent examination recognized by Gauhati University.
- C. Commerce Admission to the TDC 1st year (1st and 2nd Semester) Course shall be open to those students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination in Commerce/ Science / Arts of the

#### INSTRUCTION FOR FILLING UP THE ADMISSION FORM

Before filling admission form, students should read carefully the following instructions for selection of combination of subjects.

#### 1. For Higher Secondary Course:

#### A. Arts and Science

- (i) MIL / Alt. English and English are compulsory for all students.
- (ii) In the Admission Form, the students will have to indicate one MIL subject. (see TABLE: III).
- (iii) A candidate will select four other subjets (one of them will be fourth elective subject as per AHSEC rule) from the TABLE : III

#### **B.** Commerce:

- (i) MIL / Alt. English and English are compulsory for all students.
- (ii) Business Studies and Accountancy are two compulsory elective subjects.
- (iii) In the Admission Form, the students will have to mention one MIL Subject from the TABLE: III
- (iv) A candidates will select two other elective subjects (one of them will be fourth elective subject as per AHSEC rule) from Banking, Computer Science and Application, Mathematics or Commercial Mathematics and Statistics and Economics.

#### 2. For TDC 1st year (1st and 2nd Semester):

#### A.: Arts and Science Students:

- (i) English is compulorry for students of B.A./ B.Sc. (Major / General) Course, but students having Major in English will have to take a different English paper in lieu of compulsory English Paper.
- (ii) MIL includes Assamese, Bodo and Bengali subjects.
- (iii) MIL/AltE. is compulsory for students of B.A. with General course and the course having Major in Non-language subject.
- (iv) There is no MIL / Alt. English for B.Sc. students.
- (v) For B.A. Major/ General Course, a student shall have to choose two subjects (at least one subjet must be Non-Language) in addition to English & MIL/ AltE. Out of the two, one subject may be taken as Major subject. Then other subject will be considered as 1st subsidiary subject and MIL/ AltE. is taken as 2nd subsidiary subject. Again, in case of General Course the two subjects (other than English & MIL/ AltE.) will be considered as 1st Elective and 2nd Elective subject. See TABLE:
- (vi) Students offering Major in B.A. Course will have to mention two Major subjects in order of preference. Along with the two Major subjects, one set of subjects [one set contains 1st subsidiary subject and MIL/AltE.(see the point Vii)] must be mentioned against each preference.
- (vii) In case of MIL/AltE. (2nd subsidiary subject) for B.A. Major Course -
  - (a) Student with Language major will take a Non-Language or a Language subject other than the subject he / she is majoring. Fo example, English Major student will take other than AltE. / English (Elective) and Assamese Major student will take other than Assamese. To choose the subject combination follow the TABLE: V
  - (b) Student with Non-Language major will take MIL (Assamese / Bodo/ Bengali)/ AltE.
- (viii) Students offering Major Course in B.Sc. will have to select one combination consist of two elective (subsidiary) subjects against 1<sup>st</sup> preference and the 2<sup>nd</sup> preference of major subject from the TABLE: VI.

- (ix) Students offering General Course in B.Sc. will have to select one combination consist of three elective (subsidiary) subjects from the TABLE : VII
- (x) Computer Literacy Course will be compulsory for all Major Students of B.A. and B.Sc. Course excluding the students offering Computer Science as a subsidiary (Elective) subject.
- (xi) A student wants to offer subjects in column- I must have passed the corresponding subjects shown in column-II on the TABLE NO. IV in (10+2) or equivalent examination.
