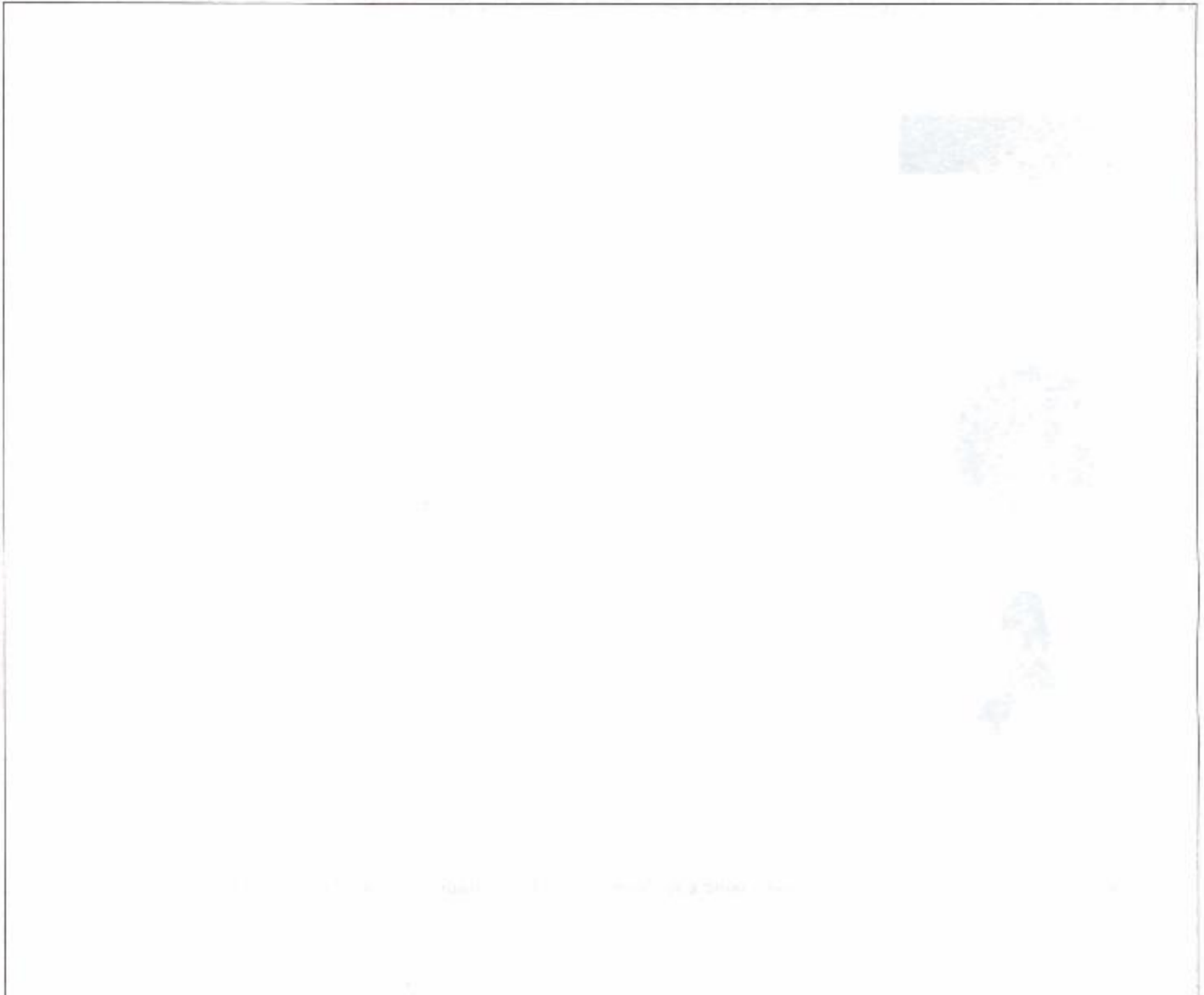
Q.3.2B: Divide and fill up each circle creatively using **any three harmonious colours** and not more than **three divisions**.
