The Christian Medical College, Ludhiana Society (Regd.) is a Christian Educational and Research Institution established, maintained and administered by Christian Churches and Christian agencies in India.

In 1953 the college started the MBBS program affiliated with Panjab University, Chandigarh admitting men and women students. Since July 1999 the college has been affiliated with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot. The Post-graduate program started in the Sixties. The college offers Post-graduate Diploma, Degree, Super specialty and Doctoral courses.

PHILOSOPHY AND OBJECTIVES OF THE INSTITUTION

The candidate must have a certificate to this effect from the authorized signatory of the member body. (The format of certificate is given in Format A in this prospectus).
B. OPEN GENERAL CATEGORY	Open General seats are open to all eligible candidates
NRI CATEGORY	For NRI Applicants Only. Proof of NRI and Eligibility certificate (to be obtained from Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot) has to be submitted.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

FOR ALL CANDIDATES

- 1) The candidate must be an Indian National (*For NRI Candidates, with reference to Nationality, refer to section on Page 10*)
- 2) A candidate who holds MBBS degree from a medical college recognized by MCI or a foreign medical degree included in the schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and who has obtained full registration from the Medical Council of India or any of the State Medical Councils after completing compulsory rotating internship shall be eligible for admission to Christian Medical College, Ludhiana.

- Candidates who have obtained their MBBS from colleges which are not recognized by Medical Council of India will not be granted admission.
- 4) An Indian National who qualified from a Foreign University/School must produce an eligibility certificate recognizing the qualifying examination as equivalent to MBBS as recognized by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences and the Medical Council of India. This may be obtained from the

- 5) A candidate who after passing the final qualifying examination (MBBS or the foreign Medical degree recognized by MCI) is undergoing 12 month compulsory internship / practical training and is likely to complete the same by 31.03.2013 can take the examination but he/ she shall not be eligible for admission unless he / she has completed the compulsory rotating internship and obtained full registration on or before 31.03.2013 or the candidate produces a certificate from the head of institution that he / she will be completing internship by 31.03.2013.
- 6) No condonation of compulsory rotating internship shall be accepted unless approved by the Medical Council of India along with necessary proof of the approval of the Medical Council of India. The condonation of compulsory rotating internship shall be restricted to the period up to 31.03.2013 and not beyond that date.
- 7) Registration with the MCI / State Medical council is necessary and its documentary proof shall be furnished at the time of counselling.
- 8) PG Diploma candidates currently registered for a diploma course under any university including Baba Farid University of Health Sciences may only be considered as per the existing rules and regulations of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences.
- 9) Service obligation: An applicant, who is expected to complete the service obligation in lieu of Sponsorship (for MBBS/PG-Diploma) by 31.03.2013, may apply. A letter to this effect must be provided along with the application, from the Principal of the concerned Medical College or authorized representative of the sponsoring Body/ Church or any other appropriate authority. Applicants should have completed a minimum of 2 years of service obligation by 31.03.2013, allowing for adjustment of unavailed leave, if any.
- 10) The primary aim of the Christian Medical College, Ludhiana is to make a significant contribution to the health standards of all communities of our nation with a special emphasis on health care in the rural underserved and unreached areas/communities in India. This mandate is fulfilled by graduates who fulfill their sponsorship obligation by serving in such areas, participating in preventive and curative medicine and understanding the needs of the society.

CANDIDATES WHO HAVE NOT COMPLETED THEIR SERVICE OBLIGATION OF TWO YEARS, AS REQUIRED FOR CANDIDATES OF CMC LUDHIANA, FOR ANY REASON AND THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN RELEASED FROM THE SERVICE OBLIGATION PREMATURELY WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR POST GRADUATION IN CMC LUDHIANA, IN ANY CATEGORY.

11) NRI Candidates interested in applying to the NRI Category should indicate on the application form and ensure all eligibility criteria are fulfilled (before applying), as per guidelines of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, before applying. Such candidates should submit Proof of NRI and the Eligibility Certificate obtained from Baba Farid University of Health Sciences.

FOR SPONSORED CANDIDATES (Category A)

Candidates in category A (i) and (ii) <u>but have not submitted relevant documents</u> for verification along with the application form will be considered in category B. No enquiries regarding change of categories will be entertained after 10.01.2013.

Candidates who have applied under Category A (i) and (ii) should be sponsored and have to apply to one of the sponsoring agencies of the Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society. The list of members of the society is given in annexure A. The sponsorship letter, duly signed by the authorized signatory of the sponsoring agency should mandatorily reach the office of the Registrar, CMC Ludhiana by 8th January 2013.

Sponsored Christian candidates are required to submit photocopies of church membership certificate, baptism certificate, confirmation certificate (if applicable) and 'affidavit of service (Format C) along with application form to be considered in this category. If he/she does not do so then he/she will be considered in category B.

SERVICE AGREEMENT

All candidates who have opted for and are selected in category A are required to enter into a service agreement with the respective member body of the Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society without which admission will not be granted. Service Agreement is for a minimum period of two years for diploma & three years for degree after completion of the course in a hospital or in an institution prescribed by Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society or the Supporting Body/Church. Candidates who have a service commitment are eligible for further financial assistance.

FOR OPEN CANDIDATES (CATEGORY B)

Following applicants are also eligible to apply for the Open General seats (without service agreement) - Category B

i) Sponsored MBBS graduates of CMC Ludhiana and CMC Vellore who have completed at least 2 years of the service, as per agreement for sponsorship made with the sponsoring body/ church at the time of MBBS admission. Such applicants must produce a detailed certificate showing the period of service rendered by the applicant, mentioning the dates and the place(s) where the applicant worked in this connection. This must be issued by the authorized person of the sponsoring body/church to this effect and stating that the sponsoring body/church has no objection for the applicant to apply.

ii) CMC Ludhiana graduates having original Service Agreement with the Christian Medical College, Ludhiana who are pursuing the service and who will complete minimum 2 years of the service by 31-03-2013 as per agreement with Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society (Regd.), at the time of MBBS admission.

Such applicants must produce a letter to this effect from the Principal of Christian Medical College, Ludhiana mentioning the period of service rendered with dates and areas of service along with a no-objection certificate.

- For MBBS graduates of other colleges, a no-objection certificate from the Principal or appropriate authority along with a certificate for completion of any agreement or obligation for MBBS program, if applicable, should be provided at time of counselling.
- **Uncompleted Service Obligation:** Unfulfilled service obligation, for any reason, violates the spirit of sponsorship.

Candidates who have had a service obligation and have not completed 2 years of satisfactory service obligation by 31.03.2013 will not be eligible for admission.

FOR NRI CANDIDATES

• NON-RESIDENT INDIAN (NRI)

An Indian Citizen who stays abroad for employment/carrying on business, to pursue a vocation outside India or under circumstances indicating an intention for an uncertain duration of stay abroad is a non-resident. (Persons posted in U.N. organizations and officials deputed abroad by Central/State Governments and Public Sector undertakings on temporary assignments are also treated as non-residents). Non-resident foreign citizens of Indian Origin are treated on par with non-resident Indian citizens (NRIs) for the purpose of certain facilities.

• PERSON OF INDIAN ORIGIN (PIO)

For the purposes of availing of the facilities of opening and maintenance of bank accounts and investments in shares/securities in India, Person of Indian Origin means a citizen of any country other than Pakistan or Bangladesh if,

- 1) He at any time, held an Indian passport
- 2) He or either of his parents or any of his grandparents was a citizen of India by virtue of the Constitution of India or Citizenship Act, 1955 (57 of 1995)
- 3) The person is a spouse of an Indian citizen

- 4) For investments in immovable properties, Person of Indian Origin means an individual (not being a citizen of Pakistan or Bangladesh or Afghanistan or Bhutan or Sri Lanka or Nepal or China or Iran)
 - a) Who at any time, held an Indian passport
 - b) Who or either of whose father or whose grandfather was a citizen of India by virtue of the Constitution of India or the Citizenship Act, 1955 (57 of 1955)
 - **Proof of NRI** (as given below and as may be applicable) must be submitted:
 - a. Passport with appropriate Visa
 - b. PIO card
 - c. Certificate from Employer proving NRI status of Parent
 - d. Certificate attesting the NRI status from Indian Embassy / Consulate
 - e. Citizenship of another country with proof of origin in India for parents

HOW TO APPLY

- The Prospectus and Application form will be available from 18th December 2012 till 2nd January 2013.
- 2. The Prospectus and Application form can be downloaded from <u>www.cmcludhiana.in</u> The Online application form, duly completed, should be first submitted online. Application form (Form 100) and Form 99 should subsequently be printed, filled and sent along with enclosures and fee (Application number generated on submission of online form must be quoted on the Form 100).
- 3. All candidates have to submit a fee of Rs.3300/- (inclusive of prospectus fee and application fee) as demand draft in favor of "Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society" payable at Ludhiana.
- Completed application forms are to be sent to 'The Registrar', Christian Medical College, Ludhiana-141008 by 3rd January 2013.

HOW TO SUBMIT APPLICATION

Every candidate will be required to log on to 'Admissions 2013' on the institutional website <u>www.cmcludhiana.in</u>. Click on link "PG 2013 - MD/MS/PG Diploma", register yourself as a new user and login. Please note your application number and follow the instructions given there.

1. The online application form must be filled and submitted online (mandatory).

A recent passport size photograph (preferably of a minimum size of 295 x 356 pixels) should be uploaded in the space provided. On submission of this form, an application number will be assigned which must be quoted in all future correspondence.

2. Form 100 (Application form) and Form 99 (Application for additional Marks, if applicable), must be downloaded, printed and filled. This along with relevant enclosures and requisite fee must be posted to 'The Registrar', Christian Medical College Ludhiana-141008, Punjab.

Acknowledgement of online submission alone does not indicate acceptance of application and has no bearing on the admission. Acceptance follows receipt of Application form, enclosures and demand draft (by post/courier/hand delivery) in the office of the Registrar before the last date of submission and subsequent verification. In the event the application form with enclosures and demand draft does not reach the office of the Registrar before 3rd January 2013, the application stands cancelled.

<u>Receipt of Admit Card does not mean that the applicant has met all the eligibility</u> <u>criteria for admission but indicates only eligibility to appear in the examination.</u>

A completed application for the postgraduate program consists of the following:

a. Online submission of application, as mentioned above.

b. Application form (Form 100), downloaded from website completely filled with a photograph attached and signed by the applicant with half signature on the Photograph and half on the Application form. Mention the application number (automatically generated on submission of the online form) on this form.

c. **Two passport size photographs** stapled to application form with name written on the back of the Photograph. The candidate should be recognizable by the photograph and any change in face structure due to change in hair style and beard style etc may be a reason for the invigilator to refuse the applicant's entry into the examination hall. Such case will be the sole responsibility of the candidate.

d. Form 99 (if applicable) - Fill in the relevant areas.

*Leave the spaces marked as official use only.

*It is the responsibility of the candidate to enclose photocopies of all relevant documents as per requirement for 'additional marks' given on Pg.15 to be considered for marks applied for in Form 99.

- k. For NRI applicants only Proof of NRI and Eligibility Certificate from Baba Farid University of Health Sciences (if this has been obtained before application).
- I. Application fee A bank demand draft for Rs. 3300/- (Rupees Three Thousand Three Hundred Only) drawn in favor of "Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society" on any scheduled bank payable at Ludhiana (This is inclusive of Prospectus fee, Application and Examination fee). Please quote name and application number behind the demand draft.

Admit card with Photograph will be generated through the online application after verification of application form and enclosures. The admit card will be available for print from <u>www.cmcludhiana.in</u> on 'login' using valid user id and password. Kindly ensure a valid email id is submitted. The institution will not be responsible for invalid email i.d's.

In the event the admit card is not received by 7th January 2013, candidates are requested to contact the office of the Registrar.

APPLICATION FEE ONCE PAID IS NOT REFUNDABLE

Acknowledgement of application forms sent will usually not be given separately and ADMIT CARD will be considered as the acknowledgement. Admit cards will be issued to all applicants, after verification.

Receipt of Admit Card does not mean that the applicant has met all the eligibility criteria.

A candidate registered for one center as given in the Admit Card shall not be allowed to appear for the test at another centre. Time table, address of the AWT centre and other relevant information will be given in the Admit Card.

It is the responsibility of the candidate to check the schedule of the AWT-2013; discrepancies, if any, must be brought to the notice of the office of the Registrar immediately.

DECLARATION FORM:

A declaration form regarding rules and regulations and information on admission procedure etc. is required to be signed by the applicant and submitted at the time of claiming the seat on admission.

ADMISSION WRITTEN TEST CENTERS:

The Admission Written Test will to be held on 10th January 2013 (Thursday) from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm at KOCHI, LUDHIANA and NEW DELHI.

POST GRADUATE ADMISSION TEST

An eligible applicant will be evaluated as per the schedule given below and the cumulative result will be the basis of admission. The Total marks will be 200.

ADMISSION WRITTEN TEST (AWT):

Maximum marks: 200

TIME: 1:00PM TO 4:00PM

This will be a common written examination for postgraduate diploma and degree courses, consisting of 200 multiple-choice questions from the MBBS syllabus, carrying one mark each. <u>There is no negative marking</u>. A candidate will be required to score 50% marks in the Written Test in order to gualify.

Important: Candidates are advised NOT TO BRING their own pens to the Examination Centre. BLACK BALL POINT PENS will be provided. No candidate should carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any other material except the Admit Card (without envelope) inside the hall. If a candidate is found to be copying/conversing with other candidates/to have in his/her possession papers, notes or books, he / she shall be disqualified from taking this Examination.

Candidates shall maintain silence and attend to their papers only. Any disturbance in the examination hall shall be deemed as misbehavior and the candidate shall forfeit the right to continue to write the examination. The decision of the Centre Superintendent shall be final and conclusive.

Do not carry cellular phones, pagers, calculators or any other electronic / communication devices while coming to the Examination Centre; these are strictly prohibited in the Examination Centre.

Three merit lists will be prepared as per the categories a candidate has opted for (A, B or NRI). Each merit list will be based on the total marks scored by a candidate and additional marks, if any.

The merit lists will be declared once final orders are received from the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The merit lists will be displayed <u>on the notice board of the Office of the Registrar and the website- www.cmcludhiana.in</u>. No separate letters/communication will be sent to any candidate.

There will be no separate Viva voce or Interview.

- iii) Age of the candidate in favor of the older candidate

F. DECLARATION OF MERIT LIST

The merit list will be displayed once final orders are received from the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. It will be displayed <u>on the notice board of the Office of the Registrar</u>, Christian Medical College, Ludhiana <u>and the website- www.cmcludhiana.in</u>.

No separate information regarding the result will be sent to the candidates.

ALLOTMENT OF SEATS BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE (COUNSELLING)

Admissions to PG courses are purely on merit.

For Candidates applying in the NRI Category:

- q. Eligibility certificate from Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- 6. The number of seats available in each category and in each subject will be displayed and updated as the counselling proceeds. The primary list will also be available on the website **www.cmcludhiana.in.**
- 7. The candidates will have the right to choose any one of the available seats at his / her rank and the same will be allotted to him / her.

* In addition to the course fee, Registration Fee (upto 15% of fee as prescribed by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences) for NRI Candidates will apply to candidates selected under this category and has to be deposited at the time of counselling.

Students with a Service Obligation are eligible for further financial assistance. Please enquire at Registrar Office for details.

Candidates have to pay the Annual fees of the subsequent years by February 28th.

If any P.G. resident/P.G. demonstrator fails to complete the training program and /or fails to appear in the P.G. examination at the end of the stipulated period of the training for the course, he/she will have to pay college fees as tuition fee for the additional period as applicable.

REFUND RULES

Generally no refund of fee is permitted on account of withdrawal/absence from college or other reasons once a student is admitted to any course of study. A refund claim may, however, be admitted on merits after due consideration of the request by the institution.

- 1. Anytime upto 30.05.2013, full refund except administrative fee and any expenses incurred by the institution towards the candidate
- 2. On the last date of admission (31.05.2013), full fees <u>except the administrative fees and any</u> other expenses incurred by the institution towards the candidate, will be refunded, provided the seat is filled. MEDICAL EXAMINATION

In compliance to MCI time schedule for various courses, No admission will be made to this college after 31st May 2013 for the session starting April 2013.

DEGREE / DIPLOMA STUDENTS-TRAINING PROGRAMME

Orientation

All post graduates admitted in the institution will undergo an orientation program. This will consist of introduction to the working of the various hospital areas like pharmacy, medical records, and laboratories including blood bank. A basic life support course will also be conducted. All post graduates are expected to attend the complete orientation program.

Postgraduate Training:

All Postgraduate students are expected to register themselves with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences. They must present a thesis research plan within 6 to 9 months of registration. The Thesis work must be adequately supervised and a half yearly report submitted to the principal's office. The final thesis submission must be completed at least 6 months before the final examination. The postgraduate training is structured to rotate through all subject related specialties. The students must maintain a logbook of their training and submit it to the principal's office. The academic training should include adequate participation in seminars, conferences, journal clubs and other academic fora.

All training courses are in service training and all candidates once admitted will have to abide by the rules of this institution as would be explained to them on admission. Failure to do so will draw necessary action which may include discontinuation of training for a period of time as may be deemed fit by the administration.

The appointments are done as follows:

1. P.G. Resident- For clinical subjects-appointed by the Medical Superintendent.

2. P.G. Demonstrator- For Para clinical & pre clinical subjects appointed by the Principal.

Stipend for P.G. trainees *

A P.G. Resident/P.G. Demonstrator is entitled to receive a stipend every month during the course of the training;

1st year: Rs.14,000/-

2nd year: Rs.15,000/-

3rd year: Rs.16,000/-

Leave

A P.G. Resident / Demonstrator will be entitled to following leave per year:

Annual Leave	:	21 days
Casual Leave	:	7 days
Sick Leave	:	10 days
Conference Leave	e:	14 days during the full course

Maternity leave during the training period of P.G. Diploma/Degree course will prolong the period of training by a minimum of six months.

Accommodation and Fees:

a) Partially furnished shared institutional accommodation is provided to P.G. Residents, on request, near the hospital premises, subject to availability. Preference will be given to Residents in clinical departments.

b) Fees: Electricity charges will be as per institutional rules.

Identity Card:

All P.G. Resident/Demonstrator once appointed must get Identity card made through the office of the Principal/Medical Superintendent as the case may be within 10 days of appointment. Identity cards must be displayed at all times within hospital premises.
