

TriColour Venture Fund

DRAWS ALUMNI SUPPORT AND UNLEASHES STUDENT VENTURE CAPITALISTS

Canada's first student-advised venture capital fund debuted at the School in 2006. The TriColour Venture Fund enables students from the Commerce and full-time MBA programs to gain hands-on experience in managing a multi-million dollar fund. Students meet directly with potential portfolio companies, assess the opportunities, conduct due diligence and make recommendations to the Investment Advisory Board, a committee of seasoned entrepreneurs, angel investors and venture capitalists.

"It's a hands-on translation of theory into practice," explains **Elsbeth Murray**, Director of Queen's School of Business Centre for Business Venturing that manages the program. "It's real money, it's real business and it's serious business."

The Fund is seeded with contributions from alumni and friends of Queen's, and all proceeds from the Fund are reinvested into maintaining and expanding this innovative educational program. This unique investment vehicle was established in partnership with PARTEQ Innovations, the technology transfer office of Queen's.

"The opportunities created by this fund benefit both parties," Elspeth continues. "Students get access to the inner workings of an early stage company, and new ventures receive high-calibre scrutiny of their business strategy. Successful candidates are rewarded with investment funding, and this can sometimes have a multiplier effect, with these new ventures going on to attract matching or follow-on investments."

The MBA Class of '84 was so impressed with the program that its members agreed to designate the proceeds of their 25th anniversary class gift campaign to the Fund. Classmates **Shauneen Bruder**, Executive VP, Operations, Canadian Banking, at RBC, and **Ray Richardson**, owner of Motorcity Mitsubishi in Whitby, ON, led the campaign which surpassed its \$100,000 goal by more than \$4,000.

"We were very pleased to support a program that provides real-world learning opportunities to students, while helping to create the next generation of entrepreneurs and support new ventures," explains Shauneen. "Who knows? Maybe one of these start-ups could become the next Research in Motion or create an innovative way to green our planet. It is important to foster entrepreneurship – it's the lifeblood of our economy."

The Fund had also piqued the imagination of another Queen's alumna, **Sylvia Morawetz, BCom'75**, who passed away in April 2009. Sylvia was principal of her own Toronto-based healthcare and information technology firm, S.A.M. Solutions and was a long-time supporter of Queen's. She contributed to her class' 30th anniversary gift that was directed to the Centre for Business Venturing and

made a bequest to the Centre in support of the TriColour Venture Fund prior to losing her battle with cancer.

Sylvia's entrepreneurial spirit was evident in a profile published in the School's alumni magazine in 2006. "You can be very successful in the small and medium-sized business market in this country," she said, explaining her support for the Centre. "Be open to opportunities, to where life can take you." Sylvia certainly practised what she preached: her obituary spoke of her "creativity and spontaneity, as she dedicated herself to the arts, children, music, travel and charities."

Her support, and that of the MBA Class of '84, definitely made a difference to this year's group of TVF student investors, including **Erin Borgfjord Ayres, MBA'10**. "It was as real-world as it gets, with my team-mates and I getting an insider's view of the challenges facing start-ups as well as an introduction to the Canadian venture community," Erin recalls. "I've stayed in touch with the professional mentors from the program, and I hope one day to be able to contribute my own skills and capital back to the Fund."

It's a ringing endorsement of the program that is music to the ears of Elspeth Murray. "The skills and insights that our

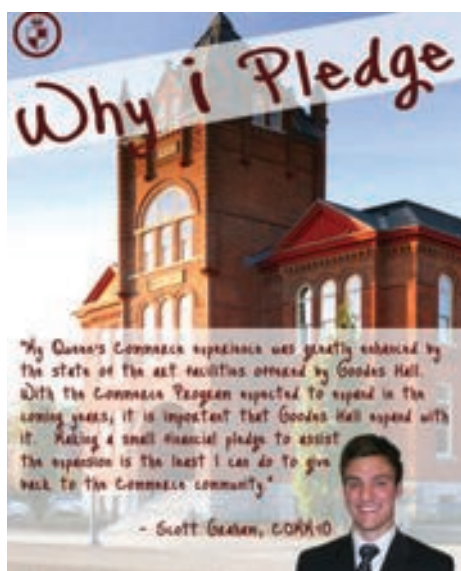
