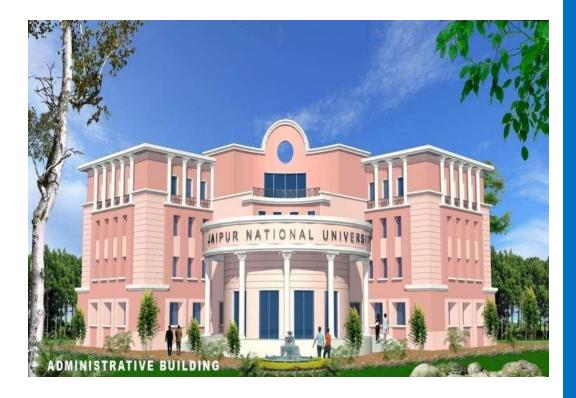

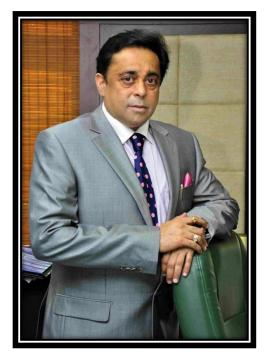

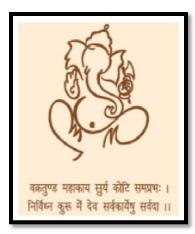

UNIVERSITY AT A GLANCE

Jaipur National University, Jaipur came into existence in the year 2007. Two professional institutes of the Seedling Group, established in 2002, with several technical & professional programmes of studies, were merged to form the University. In 2008, the University was visited by an expert panel of UGC members which accorded approval to our programmes under clause 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956. JNU has been rated by India Today amongst the countrys Top 30 Universities. The University became the first private University in Rajasthan to have prestigious NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) Accreditation in the year 2015. After starting 1000 beded hospital under Institute for Medical Sciences and Research Center approved by State Government of Rajasthan, JNU also started its Medical College approved by MCI.

In such a short span, JNU has carved a niche for itself in the country for its commitment to providing quality education and offering a conducive learning environment. The University is becoming a preferred choice for professional and technical education, as well as lovers of quality academic pursuits.

JNU is a premier centre of learning, providing various integrated and interdisciplinary programmes of study and research in the country.

With the opening of the School of Distance Education and Learning, JNU has taken education to the doorsteps of those aspirants who, for some reason, could not be a part of regular stream of education.

The University programmes have approval from all National Regulatory Bodies namely UGC/AICTE/PCI/NCTE/BCI/MCI and nursing council of India for regular courses and from the Joint Committee of UGC-AICTE-DEC for Distance Education courses.

The University has undertaken Government funded research projects and has forged National and International tie- ups and collaborations for research.

The Campus Infrastructure is of International Standard, Faculty of International Repute, Wellstocked libraries with latest reference books, Journals, and Periodicals, Open Air Theatre, Auditoria and Seminar halls, Innovative integration of interdisciplinary streams with special focus on personality development, Advisory System, Personal Monitoring and Mentor Assistance.



JNU is the only private University in the state to hold five Convocations- 16 Jan 2010, 16 October 2010, 11 February 2012, 30 March 2013 and 19 September 2015 in which degrees have been conferred upon students of various disciplines. JNU played host to the 80th Annual Symposium of the National Academy of Sciences, India (NASI) on Climate Change. The year 2011 proved to be a milestone year in the history of JNU. The University along with the Department of Science & Technology, State of Rajasthan and GOI,

jointly hosted the 19th National Childrens' Science Congress (NCSC) on the theme "Land Resources: Use for prosperity and Serve for prosperity.

The focus is not just on education, but also on the development of necessary skills to confront the challenges of life. Keeping in view the philanthropic ori entation of the Sponsoring Body and the policies of the State, the University is fulfilling its social responsibility by awarding scholarships, freeships, arranging remedial add-on courses and other necessary facilities for the needy students.

Pro-Chancellor Prof. K.L. Sharma



Prof. K.L. Sharma is Pro-Chancellor of Jaipur National University. He was formerly Professor of Sociology and Rector (Pro-Vice-Chancellor) at Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. He was also Vice-Chancellor of Rajasthan University, Jaipur, during 2003-2005. Between 1991 to 2006, he was a visiting Professor, five times at College de France, Paris. His main areas of study and research are Social Stratification, Tribal and Peasant Movements Sociology of Legal Profession, etc. He has authored and edited twenty three books and published more than Eighty papers.

Prof. Sharma has supervised thirty five doctoral students. His students are highly placed in academia and reputed organizations. In 2002, the UGC honored him with Swami Pranavanand Saraswati Award for his contributions to the discipline of Sociology. He has also been honoured with Life Time Achievement Award by the Indian Sociological Society (2012)

Vice-Chancellor Prof. H.N. Verma



Prof. H.N. Verma is the Vice-Chancellor at Jaipur National University. Earlier he was the Professor of Botany, Dean and Pro-Vice-Chancellor at Lucknow University. His main teaching/research interests are Microbiology, Molecular biology, Biotechnology including plant tissue culture.

Prof.Verma has lectured in Germany, France,USA and China. He has done extensive work on Diagnosis, Characterisation and Management of various diseases of economically important plants. Prof. Verma has been a member of various academic bodies. He is author of more than 150 research papers, published in national and international journals of

repute. Prof. Verma has also authored three books. He is a Fellow of the National Academy of Science (F. N.A.Sc.). Prof. Verma has supervised more than fifty Ph.D students, who presently hold high positions in Universities and Research Organizations. He is recipient of Birbal Sahni Gold Medal and was honoured with the 'Vigyan Vibhushan Award' in 2013, the 'Lifetime Achievement Award' in 2012 and the 'Best Citizens of India' award in 2013.

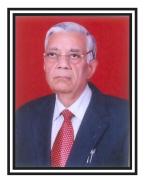
Director, School of Business & Management Prof. Rajesh Mehrotra,
